Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Memphis Redbirds in game two of a six-game series at First Horizon Park. Memphis won the series opener last night, 2-1. Left-hander Ethan Small starts for Nashville against left-hander Connor Thomas for Memphis.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small starts for Nashville in this evening. The left-hander is 6-4 with a 3.19 ERA (67.2 IP/24 ER) in 14 starts with the Sounds in 2022. Small had another strong start in his last outing, allowing just one run on two hits and four walks. The southpaw struck out eight in 5.0 innings on July 7 at Columbus. Small is among International League in average against (.189, 1st), ERA (3.19, 5th), wins (6, T-5th), strikeouts (77, T-6th) and WHIP (1.21, 7th). He is currently ranked as the No. 8 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Small split his 2021 campaign between Biloxi and Nashville, finishing 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in eight starts with the Shuckers and 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA in nine starts for the Sounds. Milwaukee took Small in the First Round (28th Pick) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State.

Connor Thomas: 24-year-old Connor Thomas starts for Memphis tonight. The left-hander is 4-3 with a 4.67 ERA (71.1 IP/37 ER) in 15 appearances (12 starts) for the Redbirds in 2022. Thomas is coming off a rough outing on July 7 at Durham. The Bulls tagged the lefty with three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings of work. Thomas did strike out seven in the Redbirds' 8-7 loss. Thomas is the No. 16 prospect in the Cardinals system, according to MLB Pipeline. He spent most of last season in Memphis, going 6-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 22 outings (14 starts). St. Louis took Thomas in the Fifth Round of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Tift County High School in Tifton, Ga.

Superlatives: Last night's loss dropped the Sounds to 34-5 when holding the opponent to 3 or less runs...35-19 when they do not commit an error...28-15 at First Horizon Park...8-7 in series openers...14-11 vs. LH starters.

Turang is at it Again: Shortstop Brice Turang had a pair of hits last night (2-for-4, R, BB, 2 SB), his team-leading 24th multi-hit game of the season. Turang has hit safely in five consecutive games, the fifth time he has hit safely in five or more games this year. Turang is tied for fourth in the International League with 90 hits.

Bullish Pen: Nashville's bullpen combined to toss 7.0 shutout innings last night and is now 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA (40.2 IP/8 ER) in the month of July. The relievers have issued 16 walks compared to 50 strikeouts. The Sounds bullpen was 5-3 with a 4.25 ERA (101.2 IP/48 ER) in the month of June.

It's All Otero: Reliever Andy Otero continues to throw the ball well and delivered 2.2 scoreless innings last night. Dating back to his outing on June 16 at Memphis, Otero has a scoreless innings streak of 11.1 innings. In 11 total games with Nashville, the southpaw is 0-0 with a 1.59 ERA (28.1 IP/5 ER). Opponents are hitting just .179 against him.

Home Sweet Home: The Sounds are back at First Horizon Park where they will play 11 of their next 14 games through the month of July. Nashville has the best home record in the International League at 28-14.

The Rivalry: The Sounds and Redbirds meet for the second of four series this season. Memphis holds a 4-3 series lead in 2022. Current Sounds Garrett Whitley (.417, 5-for-12) and Brice Turang (.375, 9-for-24) are hitting over .300 against the Redbirds this year.

Sweet's Managerial Watch: Rick Sweet has 199 wins as Nashville's manager, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. Sweet has 200+ wins with four different Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282). Sweet is 199-157 as the Sounds' manager.

Earn It: The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.68 ERA. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre checks in at second with a 3.81 ERA. The Sounds are tied with Rochester and Durham for the most shutouts in Triple-A with eight.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 5 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Small earned his sixth win of the year in his last start on July 7 at Columbus. He scattered two hits and four walks over 5.0 innings, allowing one run. Small totaled eight strikeouts and found the strike zone on 54 of 90 pitches.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is facing Memphis for the fourth time in his career and third time this season. In 2022, Small is 0-1 with an 8.31 ERA (8.2 IP/8 ER) in two starts on June 14 and 19. In the two starts this year, he took the loss in the series opener and ended with a no-decision in the series finale at Memphis.
