History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 213-190 all-time vs. the Cubs, 103-90 at home and 110-10 in South Bend.

This is Lansing's first trip to South Bend since 2023, when the Nuts won three of five. On September 4, 2022, the Lugnuts threw a combined no-hitter in the road season finale vs. the Cubs.

Today is the 4,000th all-time Lugnuts regular season game! And it's also the second of a six-game series between the Lugnuts and the South Bend Cubs, with South Bend winning the opener in a runaway last night.

Yesterday: South Bend 9, Lansing 1. Kane Kepley led off the 1st and 3rd innings with triples, scoring a pair of runs, and South Bend tacked on five more runs via a piranha offense of five singles in the 4th to knock out Steven Echavarria and seize the series opener. In the loss, Ali Camarillo and Davis Diaz went 2-for-4 with a double.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler has the call on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, while the great **Brendan King** and **Tyler Reidy** deliver the action on Bally Sports Live and MiLB TV.

On Deck: The Nuts and Cubs play tomorrow night and Friday night before wrapping up the series with a pair of weekend matinees. Then the Lugnuts return home to welcome in the Quad Cities River Bandits next week, Tuesday, May 12, through Sunday, May 17.

LUG-NOTES

Milestone Watch: Lansing is five wins away from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history, plus three players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts five players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**).

Starting Spotlight: While Lansing right-hander **Samuel Dutton** makes his first professional appearance against the Cubs' organization, South Bend starter **Koen Moreno** enters today with experience against the Nuts. On May 3, 2024, Moreno tossed three scoreless one-hit innings in relief to earn the win in a 3-0 Cubs victory. (2026 Lugnuts reliever **Jake Garland** fired three scoreless innings in the losing cause.) Moreno did not face Lansing during his four-game stint for South Bend last year.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Devin Taylor** ranks 2nd in hits (32), 3rd in RBIs (21), 6th in walks (24) and 7th in total bases (50).
- **Davis Diaz** is 3rd in doubles (10), 7th in batting average (.321) and 9th in OBP (.452).
- **Zane Taylor** is 2nd in ERA (1.50) and 6th in innings (24.0).
- **Steven Echavarria** is 3rd in innings (26 1/3).

The Hotel Life: Lansing's offense ranks 12th out of the 12-team Midwest League in road OPS (.694), with only 21 doubles and eight home runs in 13 games away from Michigan's state capital. In contrast, the Nuts are 4th in home OPS (.788), with 28 doubles, one triple and 15 home runs in 15 home games.

The Outliers: **Davis Diaz**, who singled and doubled in four at-bats yesterday, is batting .450/.569/.650 on the road this year with five doubles, one home run and 10 walks (compared to five strikeouts) in 12 games. **Justin Riemer** is slashing .321/.556/.464, drawing 16 walks in 11 road games.

Quite the Contrast: The Lugnuts are also last in the MWL in hitting against starting pitching this season (.213 avg., .645 OPS), but rank first against relief pitching (.283 avg., .816 OPS). **Davis Diaz** (.375 avg., 1.120 OPS), **Bobby Boser** (.362 avg., 1.043 OPS) and **Justin Riemer** (.333 avg., 1.085 OPS) lead the way against opposition relief.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with the Giants before landing on the Injured List on April 21. The 202nd Lugnut to reach the Majors was 2024 southpaw **Eduardo Rivera**, who was called up for emergency relief purposes and tossed 3 1/3 scoreless innings against the Yankees on April 22.

Player of the Week, April 7-12: The first Midwest League Player of the Week was 23-year-old Lansing C/3B **Davis Diaz**, who batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing.

MAY 6 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2010: South Bend C Errol Hollinger's single leading off the 5th was the Silver Hawks' only hit in a 5-0 Lugnuts shutout victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, thanks to the combined efforts of Evan Crawford (5 IP), Matt Wright (2 IP) and Dustin Antolin (2 IP). Leadoff hitter Ryan Schimpf went 4-for-5 for the Nuts in the win.

2016: On his 21st birthday, Francisco Rios set a career high with 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, and the Lugnuts blanked the Quad Cities River Bandits, 6-0, in front of 9,816. Rios was promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin three days later.

In a Nutshell: In first full season in pro ball after getting drafted last year in the 10th round... debuted in relief on Opening Day (took loss in 8-7 defeat to Dayton), then tossed five scoreless innings in 2-1 loss at Fort Wayne, April 9... enjoys fishing.

Last Game: started vs. Dayton on April 30: scoreless 1st, scoreless 2nd, allowed four runs in the 3rd (erasing 3-0 lead), scoreless 4th inning, left one batter into the 5th (who scored)... in total: 4 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 2 K, 82 pitches, 50 strikes... Lugnuts went on to win 9-8 in 10 innings.

Before College: Batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI as a senior at Westbrook Christian High School, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K... Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American... pitched for 2019 USA Baseball 16U National Team Development Program.

College: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.

Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 as the 290th pick in 2025, the fifth pick of the 10th round... one of seven Tigers drafted, led by Orioles first-rounder Ike Irish... made pro debut on August 21, 2025, vs. Lake Elsinore with one hitless innings, one walk, two strikeouts... after two scoreless relief appearances, finished the year with three short starts, fanning five in 1 2/3 innings vs. Visalia on September 7 in final appearance... right-handers were 3-for-17 (.176) with eight strikeouts, lefties went 4-for-12 (.333) with five strikeouts.
