Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the opener of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, the first of 24 meetings between the two clubs this season. The Nuts are coming off a home series split vs. Beloit, winning both games over the weekend after losing three in a row.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 4, Sky Carp 1. Beloit committed three costly errors, each leading to an unearned run, and Lansing eased to the Sunday matinee victory and a second straigth win over the Sky Carp. Grant Judkins tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings in the winning cause and Mark Adamiak recorded his league-leading ninth save.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Dragons through Sunday, enjoy a day off on June 9, and then return to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series at Jackson Field from June 10 - June 15.

Transaction: Entering play today, catcher Cole Conn was promoted to Double-A Midland, replaced on the roster (and in uniform No. 4) by catcher/infielder Davis Diaz from Stockton. Diaz becomes the 966th all-time Lugnut in franchise history.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Congratulations! Athletics shortstop Jacob Wilson was named the American League Rookie of the Month for May, leading all rookies in batting average (.368) and OPS (.975) while notching 14 multi-hit games, which tied with Freddie Freeman for the most in the Major Leagues. Wilson is 1st among all rookies in hits (81), batting average (.355), OBP (.393), slugging (.504), OPS (.898) and multi-hit games (24), and appears on track to join Carlos Beltran (1996 Lugnut, 1999 A.L. Rookie of the Year) as the only Lugnuts in franchise history to win the Rookie of the Year award. Drafted 6th overall in 2023, Wilson played 23 games with the Lugnuts in August 2023, batting .318/.378/.455 with nine doubles, one home run and four steals.

Congratulations, Part II: On Sunday, the Lugnuts' Booster Club honored T.J. Schofield-Sam as its May Player of the Month. Schofield-Sam batted .350/.409/.544 in May, wrapping it up with a go-ahead seventh-inning grand slam off the right field fair pole to beat Beloit on May 31. He currently leads the Midwest League in batting average (.357) and base hits (60) and is tied for 2nd in total bases (88) and tied for 3rd in runs scored (35).

Lugnuts on the Leaderboard: In addition to T.J. Schofield-Sam's excellence, Tommy White is 2nd in the league in slugging (.570), tied for 2nd in OPS (.970) and 3rd in batting average (.320). Joshua Kuroda-Grauer is tied for 3rd in doubles (13). Mark Adamiak is 1st in saves (9) and tied with Blaze Pontes for 1st in appearances (18). Grant Judkins is 2nd in innings pitched (52), tied for 1st in starts (10) and is one of only four pitchers in the league with a complete game.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.262), 2nd in base hits (438), 2nd in doubles (100), 3rd in on-base percentage (.360), 3rd in total bases (634) and are the toughest team to strike out (354).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (25), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (16), 1st in fewest balks (3), 2nd in fewest walks (182) and tied for 3rd in saves (14).

Anything is Possible: Infielder Joshua "KG" Kuroda-Grauer has reached base 14 times in his last five games: 10-21, 4 BB, .476/.560/.524 with four steals.

Yama at the Bat: Infielder Casey Yamauchi was exceptional against Beloit, batting .476/.560/.714 in six games (10-21, 3 BB).

Streaking: Outfielder Nate Nankil has reached base in 21 consecutive games dating back to May 7, batting .279/.375/.382 with 19 hits, nine walks and two HBPs over that stretch.

Welcome to the Show: Five former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in the Majors this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Marlins to players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23) and Jack Winkler (May 31), increasing the overall total to 197 Nuts who've worked their way from Lansing to MLB.

The Nuts are 223-182 all-time vs. the Dragons, 115-93 in Lansing and 108-89 in the Water St. District. In 2025, Lansing went 10-11 vs. Dayton, with a 4-5 record at Day Air Ballpark

### JUNE 3RD IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2006:** The Lugnuts won a 17-inning marathon for the second time, pulling out a 5-3 victory at South Bend. The score was tied at 2-2 through seven innings, with both teams scoring in the 15th. Nuts manager Ken Joyce was ejected in the 11th and center fielder Luke Hetherington was ejected in the 17th. The game took four hours and 36 minutes to complete, decided by a two-out, two-run triple from Jacob Butler.

**2010:** The Lugnuts committed five errors and lost to Cedar Rapids, 11-5. Starter Dave Sever gave up nine runs in two innings plus three batters, but only one of the runs was earned. A ninth unearned run came in against reliever Scott Gracey. Mike Trout went 1-for-4 to lower his batting average to .373, scored three runs and stole his 29th base; Jean Segura went 3-for-4 with two runs scored and three RBIs;

2017: 19-year-old Bo Bichette went 4-for-5 with two singles, a double and a triple, to raise his batting average to .390 in a 7-3 loss at West Michigan.



Aggieville: Majored in Kinesiology at Texas A&M... "plans to become a baseball coach," according to A&M bio... as a freshman in 2021: 17 G, 12 GS, 3-2, 4.37, 55 2/3, 27 BB, 49 K... sophomore: 19 GS, 6-3, 4.99, 92 IP, 25 BB, 82 K... junior: 17 GS, 1-4, 6.32, 72 2/3, 42 BB, 65 K... Aggies' Friday starter as both a sophomore and junior... A&M has had at least two players drafted in every draft since 1984 and at least three players drafted in every draft since 2001, both the longest streaks in the country.

Bananas: Spent the 2021 summer with the Savannah Bananas in the Coastal Plain League, going 6-0 with a 1.63 ERA in eight games, six starts: 27 2/3 innings, 6 runs (5 earned), 0 HR, 7 walks, 24 K... called it one of the most fun summers of his life, learning the importance of connecting with the fans when not between the white lines... teammates with Great Lakes reliever Livan Reinoso, who was then the Bananas' leading hitter, and West Michigan's Joe Miller... the Bananas finished the season 35-8 and won the league championship over the Morehead City Marlins, 2 games to 1.

Pro Ball: Selected by the A's with the second pick of the 5th round in 2023, the same round as Lake County's Christian Knapczyk, and signed for \$425,000... joins Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022), Will Johnston (13th round, 2023), and Ali Camarillo (12th round, 2024) as Aggies drafted by the A's in the last three years... sidelined in 2024 after the first month of the season due to bone spurs in his elbow... returned in 2025 as the Stockton Ports' Opening Day starter (5 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 4 K)... earned California League Pitcher of the Week after remarkable second start (4 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 2 BB, 11 K on April 10 vs. Rancho Cucamonga)... limiting righties to .197 avg.
