

LAST TIME OUT: RF Stanley Consuegra's fifth home run in his previous II games was not enough to propel Brooklyn into the win column on Friday night, as the Cyclones fell to the BlueClaws, 7-2...Consuegra lifted a two-run shot to left field to cut Brooklyn's deficit to 4-2, but that would be the only real offense mustered by **Gilbert Gomez's** rew...SS Erick Brito notched a three-hit game for Jersey Shore. At the same time, RHP **Eiberson Castellano** limited the 'Clones to just two runs over 5.2 innings en route to the win

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Including Saturday, 17 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season. The Cyclones are currently third in the North Division, one game back of Jersey Shore for second...Brooklyn is three games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they will not play an in-division opponent until the BlueClaws travel to North Carolina next week...So far, Greensboro has played just six games against teams with a record of .500 or better, holding a 2-4 mark.

 MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore, and followed it up with a home run to lead off the ballgame on Wednessday...Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 38 Jacob Reimer went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley...The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B Chase Esteps 4-for-5 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore... Morabito is the first Cyclone to register 4+ hits, 3+ RBI, and at least one home run in a single game 3B William Lugo was 4-for-6 with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at Shore Town Ballpark...CF Alex Ramirez (45, 1HR, 5 RBI) (di t, as well, on July 22, 2022...Morabito is tied for third in all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.359)...Former Bowling Green and current Double-A Montgomery OF Chandler Simpson and Double-A Birmingham's Brooks Baldwin are tied for the lead (.366)...He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.476) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (.24)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (.13)...Morabito is also tied for third in runs scored (B).

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory last Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames... In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (4 ER in 40.0 IP)...Tong leads all qualifiers across Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.90)...Arizona's LHP **Spencer Giesting** (0.94) at High-A Hillsboro is second...The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.4%) is sixth.

CROWN HIM!: In Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (168), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez.** The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (77), home runs (34), and RBI (11)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise rear home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominan native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SIZZLING STANLEY: Not only did OF Stanley Consuegra set the franchise hit re-cord on Wednesday afternoon, but the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old launched his fifth home run in his last 11 games in Friday's loss to Jersey Shore...Consuegra has a knock in 11 of his previous 12 games since May 17 at Bowling Green and is hitting .310/.420/.786 with a 1.206 OPS during that time... The Dominican native has scored 10 runs and added five doubles, five home runs, and 10 RBI...During the stretch, Consuegra has raised his batting average by 40 points (.171 to .211) and his OPS by 198 points (.519 to .717).

BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK: INF Wilfredo Lara and C Chris Suero are heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...In his last 11 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .297/.395/.459 with a .854 OPS, adding a double, a triple, a home run, and six RBL.Suero enters Saturday on a nine-game on-base streak since May 17...The 20-year-old has post-ed a .310/.459/.414 line with a .873 OPS, adding 10 runs scored, a home run, three RBI, seven walks, eight strikeouts, and a pair of stolen bases.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched his team-leading seventh home run in Wednesday's victory over Jersey Shore...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso is tied for third in triples (3), sixth in slugging (524), seventh in RBI (27), tied for eighth in total bases (77), and ninth in extra-base hits (19) and OPS (892)...The Connecticut native saw his season-high 11-game hitting streak end in Friday's loss but extended his on-base streak to 12...During the streak, the ninth-round selection is slashing ...and eight RBI...The 11-game hit streak was the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF Jett Williams hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF Junior Tilien is riding a team season-long 13-game on-base streak...Since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader at Bowling Green, the 21-year-old is hit-

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore pos-sess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Justin Crawford (4), SS Bry-an Rincon (7), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), and LHP Sam Aldegheri (23)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cy-BlueClaws won the season series against the Cy-clones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 51-42 (.548).

ting 255/379/340 with a .719 OPS...Tilien has scored a pair of runs and tallied two doubles, a triple, four RBI, nine walks, and two stolen bases...The 13-game stretch is the longest for a Cyclone since INF **William Lugo** reached in 18-consecutive contests from August 23, 2023, until April 6, 2024.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.72...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the cir-cuit and hold a mark 0.74 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.46)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fifth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.13).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 10-15 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the eighth-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.01) has the lowest mark at the High-A level and MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.71.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP Felipe De La Cruz put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brookiyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gseliman accomplished the fast on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play with the seventh lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68).

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley... LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF **Nick Lorusso** was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday. logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits...He is the first Brooklym pitcher to receive the honor since RHP **Luis Moreno** from July 26-31, 2022...On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/588/1286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday..Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF **Stanley Consuegra** from April 10-16, 2023... The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

DOU NOT ENTER: Even after working just 2.2 innings in Friday's loss, RHP **Douglas Orellana** still finds himself towards the top of the South Atlantic League leaderboard in numerous pitching categories...Among arms with 36.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (149) and is ninth in batting average against (191)...Across the minors, Orellana's 1.49 ERA (6 ER in 36.1 IP) is eighth among pitchers with 36.0 or more nings

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,008-851 (.542) in 1,859 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 210-220 (.488) in 430 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching ap-pearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 55 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.56 ERA (25 ER in 88.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 77.
