TONIGHT'S GAME

Tonight's series opener at Dell Diamond will feature the Round Rock Express playing as the Chupacabras and the Albuquerque Isotopes as the Mariachis de Nuevo México as part of Minor League Baseball's Copa de la Diversión campaign, a nationwide initiative to celebrate the culture and values of Hispanic and Latino communities. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m.

Online audio is also available at am1300thezone. iheart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Round Rock Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play while former Texas Rangers coach James Vilade provides color commentary.

LAST TIME OUT

The Sugar Land Skeeters secured a 5-1 series win over the Round Rock Express with an 11-9 victory on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. Skeeters CF Bryan De La Cruz hit a two-run homer in the first inning before Sugar Land increased its lead to 3-0 in the third as RF Jake Mevers scored on a De La Cruz single. Round Rock put its first two runs across in the fourth when SS Ryan Dorow scored thanks to a double from 3B Charles Leblanc. The third baseman later scored on a Carl Chester single, pulling the E-Train to within 3-2. Both teams scored in the fifth as the Skeeters hit two solo home runs before LF Jason Martin crossed home for the Express thanks to a Yohel Pozo double, making it a 6-3 ballgame. After Sugar Land added a run in the top of the eighth, the Express took its first lead of the night in the bottom of the frame, scoring six runs to take a 9-7 advantage. The Skeeters rallied to claim the 11-9 win thanks to four runs in ninth.

YANG GETS THE START

Round Rock LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is set to get the start up on Thursday night, up against Albuquerque LHP Ian Clarkin. Yang has amassed a 2.92 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) and 10 strikeouts over three starts since joining Round Rock on June 19.

WELCOME BACK TO ROUND ROCK

Albuquerque is returning to Round Rock for the first time since August 3-6, 2017, where the Express claimed a 3-1 series victory. Since Round Rock joined the ranks of Triple-A in 2005, the club holds an 83-81 lead over Albuquerque in the all-time series, including a 48-32 record in games played at Dell Diamond. Before becoming members of the Triple-A West League, the two faced off as members of the Pacific Coast League 164 times.

AN UNFAMILIAR FOE

Only six members of Round Rock's active roster have seen action against Albuquerque during their careers. LHP James Jones (one game) and OF Delino DeShields (four games) competed against Albuquerque during their first stints as members of the team in 2018 and 2016, respectively. Others that have seen playing time against Albuquerque include LHP Wes Benjamin (1 game), RHP Jharel Cotton (three games), OF Elier Hernandez (two games) and INF Trace Loehr (three games).

MULTI MULTI-HITTERS

Round Rock C Yohel Pozo, CF Leody Taveras and 1B Curtis Terry all recorded multiple hits in Tuesday's contest, each with two apiece. Round Rock and Sugar Land combined for a total of 18 hits in the 11-9 final and all but three E-Train hitters tallied at least one base. Pozo and Terry both recorded doubles and drove in two runs each.

A DAY OF BASEBALL

Round Rock played its longest nine-inning contest since May 20, 2019 on Tuesday night as the game time against Sugar Land clocked in at 4:10. Including three separate rain delays, it took the Express and Skeeters a combined 23 hours and 32 minutes to play their six-game series, an average of 3:55 per game.

EAST DIVISION FOES

Albuquerque is the only East Division opponent that Round Rock has not seen action against yet this season. The Chupacabras travel to the Mariachis de Nuevo México on August 26-31 for a second series. Round Rock sits at third place in the division while Albuquerque is fifth.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 15 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine (Bridge City) and INF Jax Biggers (Missouri City) are the lone Texans on the roster. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 24 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
