RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (14-7)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as the Quakes open a six-game home stand with game one of a six-game series against the Stockton Ports (ATH). Today is our second Education Day, presented by Verizon 5G Home Internet, with a special start time of 11am. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the seventh of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the first of six here at home. The Quakes dropped four of six in Stockton on their first road trip of 2025. Last season, the Quakes went 8-2 against the Ports, 3-1 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Quakes took advantage of 12 walks and four errors, as they routed the Inland Empire 66ers by a final of 10-3 on Sunday afternoon at San Manuel Stadium. Victor Rodrigues and Eduardo Guerrero each finished with one hit and two RBIs to help lead Rancho to their fifth straight win and five of six in the series over the 66ers. Starter Hyun-Seok Jang (three scoreless innings) and Jholbran Herder (2-0) combined to work the first seven innings, while allowing just one run. Inland Empire starter Yeferson Vargas (2-2) allowed three runs over five innings in the loss.

TURNING THE CORNER ON THE ROAD?: The Quakes are 7-2 at home and are now 7-5 on the road, after winning a fifth straight game on Sunday. They've now won seven of their last nine road games overall, after dropping the first three to start the year.

DEEP-BALL PICKIN' UP: Rancho saw their home run streak end at five straight games on Sunday, their longest streak of the year. While homers are down overall in the Cal League, Rancho has 14 in 21 games, two less than San Jose's league-leading 16. Eduardo Quintero and the now-departed Raynerd Ortega each have three to lead Rancho.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a couple of moves before this series, sending infielder Raynerd Ortega back to the Arizona Complex League. Taking his spot on the roster is outfielder Roger Lasso, who joins the team from the ACL. Lasso signed with the Dodgers in 2021 out of Panama.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his fifth start, his second against Stockton. In his last start overall, he allowed two runs on just one hit, but struck out a career-high 12 batters in a no-decision against the 66ers on April 23rd. Against the Ports in his only start, he allowed one run on just one hit, but with six walks and eight strikeouts over 3.2 innings in a no-decision at Stockton on April 11th. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

FELIX CASTRO: Right-hander Felix Castro makes his first start and second appearance of the year, his first against the Quakes. In his debut on April 25th vs Modesto, he threw 10 pitches in a perfect relief inning, taking a no-decision. Last year, he made three relief appearances for the Ports, going 0-0 with a 29.70 ERA across 3.1 innings. Castro signed with the A's in May of 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.
