In the top of the ninth, Wynton Bernard drew a leadoff walk for Buffalo and advanced on a stolen base and errant throw. LI Tally worked a walk and set runners up on first and third. Nathan Lukes hit an RBI double to drive in Bernard, tying it up at 1-1. The Bisons had runners on, but could not get a groundout ended the inning.
