Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at home against the Harrisburg Senators. It is the third of 12 matchups between the teams this season; one series in Reading and another series in Harrisburg from Aug. 22-27. In 2022, the Fightin Phils went 4-8 against the Senators, including dropping five-of-six games at home in April and split the six-game series in Harrisburg in August.

Looking Back

Reading fell down 0-2 in this week's series with a 7-4 loss last night. Griff McGarry was strong over four innings and Matthew Kroon hit a home run. Oliver Dunn knocked in two runs, but Harrisburg put up four in the eighth thanks to a Frankie Tostado grand slam to pull away in the win.

Shutout Streak

Through 40 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-12 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching has also not yet thrown a shutout this season either.

Elite Defender

Johan Rojas continues to play elite defense in center field for the R-Phils. He has two outfield assists on the season, which leads Reading outfielders. Rojas has nine defensive runs saved this season, which is tied for the most amongst minor league center fielders.

A Look at the Bullpen

In wins, Reading's bullpen has been flat-out dominant, posting a 2.39 ERA over the Fightin Phils' 15 wins. In Reading's 25 defeats this season, the bullpen has posted a 7.21 ERA. In innings 1-5 of games, Reading has a +18 run differential, but it's -34 in innings 6-9 of contests.

Tatum's Resurgence

McCarthy Tatum has been red-hot with the bat. After a three-hit performance yesterday, Tatum now has hits in his last-six games and is hitting .455 wth eight RBI over that span. Prior to that streak, Tatum had just one hit in his his prior 23 at bats.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies had a come-from-behind walk off victory yesterday, beating Arizona 6-5. Lehigh Valley walked off Buffalo 11-9 on a Weston Wilson two-run home run in the ninth. Jersey Shore split a doubleheader at Aberdeen, winning 12-10 and losing 4-3. Clearwater won 6-2 over St. Lucie to improve to a Minor League-best 31-10 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 25, 2012: At Harrisburg, Darin Ruf swats two solo home runs and Tyson Gillies adds a third as Reading beats the Senators, 3-1. Jonathan Pettibone give up one run on 8 hits over 8 innings for his 4th victory.

Coming from the Capital

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Harrisburg, The Senators sit tied for first with Richmond in the Eastern League Southwest standings at 21-19 on the season. Last week, the Senators split a six-game series at home against Erie, winning the last two games like the R-Phils. Next week, Harrisburg stays on the road for a six-game series at Bowie.

On the Hill for Harrisburg

Lefty Alemao Hernandez gets the start tonight for Harrisburg. He is 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA this season over six games and two starts. Hernandez has 13 strikeouts and five walks over 19 innings. He was with Wilmington until May 7 and made his first appearence with Harrisburg on May 13. Hernandez came out of the bullpen for Wilmington and started for Harrisburg. He has not pitched in affiliated baseball since 2019.
