FISHER CATS ONE-HIT AS WINNING STREAK ENDS: The Fisher Cats only recorded one hit last night, as the seven game winning streak was snapped. Chavez Young recorded New Hampshire's only hit -- a fourth inning single -- and made a sensational catch at the wall to rob Adley Rutschman of a grand slam in the bottom of the third. Grayson Rodriguez allowed one single in five shutout innings with one walk and eight strikeouts, while the Baysox scored six runs in 2.2 innings against Woods Richardson on four hits and seven walks.

SUNDAY FUNDAY? The Fisher Cats have won their last two Sunday matinee games, scoring 17 times in the process. They are also 5-4 in day games this season.

VINNY CAPRA DOES IT ALL: Vinny Capra replaced Chris Bec at catcher in the eighth inning last night, becoming the fourth different Fisher Cat to spend time behind the plate this season. Capra, typically a shortstop or outfielder, is the only Fisher Cat position player to pitch in a game this year, meaning he has now played at both ends of the battery. Capra is hitting .397, although his career high 10-game hit streak came to an end yesterday.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: June 27, 2010- The Fisher Cats scored four times in the top of the ninth to rally past Trenton 8-6. Adam Loewen (low-in) and Jonathan Jaspe (HA-spay) each drove in two runs in the ninth—Loewen with a double, and Jaspe with a single. Tim Collins came out of the pen to set the Thunder down for his sixth save.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Vlad Guerrero Jr. hit his 26th home run, as Hyun-Jin Ryu picked up his seventh win in a 12-4 Blue Jays victory over the Orioles. Buffalo beat Syracuse in extra innings, handing former Fisher Cat Yennsy Dias his second loss of the season. Vancouver fell to Eugene 4-3 despite six strong innings from Paxton Schultz. The temperature at gametime was 100 degrees in Oregon.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats return home this coming week for games 19-24 against the Portland Sea Dogs. It is the fourth of six sets of games that the two teams will play this season.

Reilly Hovis will make his debut for the Fisher Cats this afternoon, following his arrival to the team this week. Hovis last pitched for the Gastonia Honey Hunters in the Atlantic League (Independent). He is a former 9th round selection out of UNC by Miami, and he advanced as far as AA Jacksonville (now AAA) in 2018 before his release.

For the Baysox, Ofelky Peralta will start today's game, making his second appearance in the series. His ERA is 3.91, and he only made it .2 innings in Tuesday's series opener, giving up four runs (all earned) on four hits and three walks in an inning in which the Fisher Cats batted around. His record on the season is 3-0.


