LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox walked off the Akron RubberDucks for the second game in a row on Friday night for their fourth-consecutive win. Following a lengthy battle of pitching staffs, Zach Watson raced from first base to home on a line drive single by Dylan Harris, mixed with an error, in the bottom of the ninth to break the 1-1 tie. Bowie's pitching remained steady throughout, and Gunnar Henderson provided an early spark by homering in his first at bat of the night. Brandon Young fired four innings of one-run ball to start the night, while Cameron Bishop and Ryan Conroy pitched zeros across the final five innings.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has relied heavily on their pitching staff to bounce back from their own 2-3 start to open this series with a 5-4 record. Ending their homestand with a doubleheader against Reading, Akron allowed only one run in the 14 innings to sweep the twin bill. Entering this series, Akron's 3.17 ERA as a staff is the third-best in the Eastern League, and their 109 strikeouts lead the league. Offensively, Akron sits in the bottom half of the league in multiple categories, including only three home runs and 86 total bases, fewer than ten per game.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Daniel Espino enters the season as the Guardians' second-ranked prospect. The 2019 first-round draft pick pitched to a 3.73 ERA last season in 20 starts between Class-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County, finishing with a 14.92 K/9. This season, he has started two games for the RubberDucks, allowing two earned runs and striking out 16 batters in 8 2/3 innings pitched. Last time out against Reading, Espino pitched 4 2/3 innings of hitless ball, walking three batters. He last pitched against an Oriole affiliate on June 30th, 2021. He gave up the most runs of his professional career, pitching 5 1/3 innings of six-run ball.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson ripped a solo home run to right field, clocked at a 112 MPH exit velocity, in the first inning of Bowie's win over Akron on Friday, the first of his Double-A career. Henderson did hit a home run against Akron in 2021, but during the Double-A Northeast Championship series. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

DYLAN DOES IT ALL

Utility outfielder Dylan Harris has made an immediate impact with the Baysox after just three games in his Double-A career. Brought up from the complex on April 16 to replace the injured Toby Welk, Harris has already gone 7-for-12 at the plate with a home run and a pair of RBI. Harris has been critical in both of Bowie's walk-off wins this season, scoring the winning run on April 21 against Akron, avoiding a tag at home in the tenth inning, and collecting the game-winning hit on April 22 against Akron, allowing Zach Watson to score from first base on the hit and an error.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie's win on Friday was their first of the season while scoring fewer than three runs. In 2021, the Baysox collected seven wins while scoring two or fewer runs. Bowie is already 3-0 this season in games decided by one run, which is good for the best record in the Eastern League, and the only team without a loss.

YOUNG GUNS

The Baysox have the fourth-youngest roster in the Eastern League, with the combination of their full roster averaging 23.9 years old. Their youth does not hurt the, as Bowie has a better record than the two teams younger than them, Altoona and New Hampshire. The oldest team in the Eastern League, Harrisburg, also owns the League's best record. Harrisburg's roster, on average, is 25.4 years old.

BACKED TO THE WALL

Bowie has not been afraid to make some noise when down to their final out. Over the three games of this series, Bowie has scored 23 of their 32 runs with two outs. The Baysox 36 runs driven in with two outs is more than any team outside of Triple-A (which has played four more games) and more than any Major League team. The Baysox also lead the Eastern League with an .856 OPS with two outs, after only managing a .696 OPS with two outs in 2021, among the bottom half in the League.

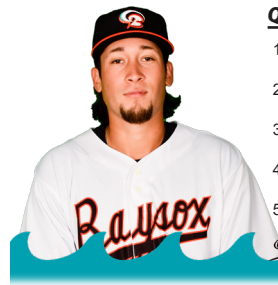

- Full trade: Orioles trade RHP Cole Sulser and LHP Tanner Scott to Miami in exchange for OF Kevin Guerrero, LHP Antonio Velez, and a Competitive Balance Round B draft selection

- Earned his promotion to Double-A after silencing opponent for High-A Beloit. Fired 26 innings in four starts, allowing only one run, a solo home run, while striking out 20 batters and only walking two.

- Apr 17 @ BNG Struck out the side in the first inning (including an auto-strike three on the leadoff batter) When Bowie had jumped to a 4-0 lead, Velez allowed a solo home run in the second inning before tossing a perfect third. Was chased in the fifth inning after allowing five consecutive batters to reach base, as well as four runs, with a two-run home run mixed in by top Mets prospect Francisco Alvarez. All four runs were scored with two outs.

He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
