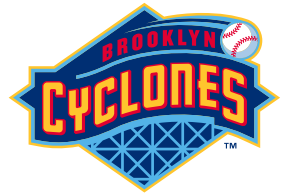

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped their second-straight to Jersey Shore, 3-2, on Wednesday afternoon...The BlueClaws won in the bottom of the 9th when a throwing error brought in the final tally...CF **Alex Ramírez** put the Cyclones ahead with a single in the 8th...3B **Jaylen Palmer** tallied a season-high 3 hits and fell a home run short of the cycle...The 22-year-old added a run-scoring triple in the 4th...CF **Jared Carr** clubbed a home run for Jersey Shore in the 3rd...RH **Cameron Foster** posted 5.2 innings of 1-run ball with a career-high 6 K's for the 'Clones...Claws LHP **Jordan Fowler** went 5+ frames with 1 run.

**THUNDERBOLT:** The Cyclones stole a season-high 6 bases on Wednesday afternoon at Jersey Shore...That was the most for Brooklyn since they stole 6 bags at Hudson Valley on April 20, 2022...3B **Jaylen Palmer** and DH/RF **Joe Suozzi** swiped bases in both contests...Coming to Wednesday, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League with 10 and Palmer is tied for 4th with 9...More importantly, both are a combined 19-for-20 on attempts...The 'Clones are tied for 4th in the league with 33 team stolen bases, but is 2nd in success rate (.892)...Only Hudson Valley (.943) has been more successful.

**SAY HEY, JAY:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** comes into Thursday on a 15-game on-base streak...That is tied with Jersey Shore's 2B **Hao Yu Lee** for the longest in the SAL in 2023...Including the end of the 2022 regular season, the 22-year-old has 20-straight affairs since August 26, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The 15-game stretch is tied for Palmer's longest in a single season since joining the Cyclones in 2021...The Canarsie native reached in 15-consecutive contests from July 10 to August 4, 2022.

**RAMÍ RAKES:** OF **Alex Ramírez** extended his team season-long hitting streak to 11 on Wednesday...The stretch is also the longest active streak in the SAL...The 20-year-old is 15-for-his-last-45 (.333) with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 10 RBI, 5 walks, and 4 stolen bases...Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.281) and is tied with teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** for the lead in triples (7)...He is also tied with former Cyclone INF **Ronny Mauricio** for the most doubles (33)...Ramírez is 2nd in on-base percentage (.345), hits (158), and OPS (.774), 3rd in slugging (.429) and total bases (241), and tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (52).

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** blasted his 4th home run of the year on Tuesday night...Consuegra enters Thursday's match on an 11-game on-base streak dated back to April 12...Since then, the right-handed swinger is slashing .310/.396/.714 with a stellar 1.110 OPS...Consuegra has 8 extra-base hits, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI in that span...He is tied for 3rd in the league in extra-base hits (9), tied for 5th in homers (4), tied for 7th in RBI (13), and 8th in total bases (33).

**WELCOME BACK, WILLIAM:** INF **William Lugo** made his season debut on Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 1-for-3 with a walk, a run scored, and a

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws claim 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...INF **Hao Yu Lee** comes in at No. 6, while RHP **Tommy McCollum** is deemed the 29th-best farmhand...The Cyclones captured 2-of-3 from Jersey Shore at Maimonides Park from April 7-9...Brooklyn dominated the 2022 season series, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones went 12-3 in 15 games at ShoreTown Ballpark last season.

stolen base...Lugo joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on April 8 last year and slashed .267/.347/.484 with a .795 OPS in 28 regular season games...He added 4 home runs and 18 RBI...The Baní, D.R. native added another solo home run in the postseason...Lugo is ranked as the Mets' No. 27 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 26 by MLB Pipeline...He joined the squad from extended spring training on Monday.

**GO DJ:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 6 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11...In 11 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 19 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach... Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 4 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision last Wednesday night vs. Wilmington...Yielded 1 unearned run on 3 hits over a career-high-tying 5.0 innings...Walked 2 and punched out 5...Hit 1 batter and induced a double play...Relieved by RHP **Cameron Foster** in the top of the 6th with Brooklyn leading, 2-1...Blue Rocks scored 4 in the 8th and defeated the Cyclones, 5-3.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by *Baseball America*... Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

**2022:** Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
