Last Night: Whitecaps 6, Lugnuts 3. One rough inning – specifically, one five-run 3rd inning against **Stevie Emanuels** – was all that West Michigan needed to dispatch the Nuts on Friday night at LMCU Ballpark. In the loss, **Lawrence Butler** and **Matt Cross** each collected two hits and **Brayan Buevas** delivered a two-run single to halt a 1-for-17 season-opening slump.

Meanwhile, at Jackson Field: While Lansing was losing on the road, Michigan State was getting trounced, 18-6, by the Michigan Wolverines in the 2022 Capital Clash on the Nuts' home diamond. Wolverines leadoff hitter **Clark Elliott** finished 4-for-5 with a walk, three home runs, five runs scored and eight RBIs; seven home runs in total were hit in the game.

LUG•NOTES

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buevas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 21) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 22).

In Search of Power, Not Offense: The Lugnuts are one of five teams in High-A – joining Brooklyn, Jersey Shore, Spokane and Tri-City – with just one home run this year, though the Lugnuts have outscored 15 High-A teams and each of those other teams and have 17 more runs than Midwest League rival Beloit (32-15).

Impaler: 2017 Lugnuts star **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** slugged his MLB-leading 5th home run of the season last night. The 2021 All-Star Game MVP is second in baseball with 27 total bases, though he only has one extra-base hit that isn't a home run.

No. 162: Reliever **Zach Jackson**, a member of the 2017 Lugnuts pen, made his MLB debut on April 9 for the Oakland Athletics. In doing so, he became the 162nd all-time Nut to reach the Majors. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, totaling 31 players, including four (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Kirby Sneed** and **Kevin Smith**) on the A's and one (**Drew Hutchison**) on the Detroit Tigers.

No. 163? 2018 Nuts pitcher **Zach Logue** was called up to the Major Leagues yesterday by the Oakland Athletics just in time to play a series at old parent club Toronto.

Record-Breaking: On April 10, reliever **Jordan Romano**, a member of the 2016 Lugnuts starting rotation, broke Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save, closing out the Yankees in a 3-0 Blue Jays win.

Welcome Back: The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maeli** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman **Matt Olson** on March 14, 2022; Angeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher **Sean Manaea** on April 3, 2022; and Maeli was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

International Appeal: In addition to 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the 2022 Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Down the Ladder: Outfielder **Denzel Clarke** (2021 4th-rounder) enjoyed another massive game, going 3-for-5 with two homers, four RBIs and a stolen base; in the last two games, Clarke is 7-for-10 with three homers, two steals, eight runs scored and seven RBIs. Shortstop **Max Muncy** (2021 1st-rounder) and catcher **CJ Rodriguez** (2021 5th-rounder) also added home runs in Stockton's 14-10 victory over Modesto.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Personal: Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up “but I didn’t have any serious musical talent, that’s probably why I took the career path I did”... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A’s in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today’s West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff’s mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff’s sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game’s No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan’s Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

Prospecting: Criswell is currently Keith Law’s No. 12 overall A’s prospect, MLB.com’s No. 9 A’s pitching prospect and No. 22 overall prospect, and Fangraphs’ No. 15 A’s prospect... MLB Pipeline’s grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, “Criswell’s success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A’s as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league’s top strikeout leaders.... He’s been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds.”

2021 Pro Debut: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugsnuts’ Opening Day roster: Keith Law’s No. 5 overall A’s prospect, MLB.com’s No. 3 A’s pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America’s No. 14 A’s prospect. Wrote Law, “Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he’d had before the shutdown. Criswell’s slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it’s gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too.” ... started the fifth game of the Lugsnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for the Arizona Fall League champion Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

2022: Debuted as Lugsnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... gave up two third-inning runs, but that was all in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep.
