YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 4-1. Erie took a 2-0 lead in the fourth with a run scoring on a wild pitch and an RBI double by Jake Holton. Richmond scored its only run in the fifth inning on a throwing error on a double steal attempt. In the sixth, Carlos Mendoza hit an RBI single and Gage Workman added a sac fly in the eighth to open a 4-1 lead. **Ryan Murphy** started for Richmond and set a new Double-A career high with eight strikeouts over five innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the third of a six-game series at UPMC Park. Richmond and Erie have met in the Southwest Division Series each of the last two seasons. Erie has won each of those series, including en route to winning the franchise's first Eastern League championship last season. This series is the first this year between the Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for six games from May 28-June 2. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for six games from August 27-September 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped eight-of-nine dating back to April 28, including seven-of-eight in the current road trip to Akron and Erie. The lone win in that stretch came on Friday in a shutout at Akron. In the previous series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox.

THE SEAWOLVES are the defending Eastern League champions. This year, they are in third place in the Southwest Division standings. They went 2-3 in last week's series against the Baysox in Bowie, with the series finale being canceled due to rain. After starting the season 9-4, the SeaWolves have gone 6-7 in their last 13 games since April 21. Erie's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10) and 2B Hao-Yu Lee (No. 12). Three Erie players are on MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Melton (No. 11), Lee (No. 14), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his sixth start of the season and the second of his career against the SeaWolves. He last pitched last Thursday at Akron and allowed a season-high three runs over four innings in a loss. In his previous start on April 26 against the Baysox in Richmond, Birdsong worked five hitless innings as the Flying Squirrels took a combined no-hit bid into the ninth inning. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 20 IP) this season, Birdsong is ranked third in K/9 (12.84) and in strikeout percentage (34.5%). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. **For more on Birdsong, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Wilkel Hernandez makes his sixth start and seventh overall appearance of the year. Last time out, he pitched 4.2 innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision at Bowie last Thursday. Hernandez did not allow a run in his first three appearances of the season but has posted a 9.52 ERA (6 ER/5.2 IP) in his last two starts since April 26. A native of La Carlota, Venezuela, Hernandez is in his first Double-A season. Last year, he went 3-8 with a 3.65 ERA in 26 games (20 starts) for the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps. Hernandez was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent in 2015. He was traded to the Tigers along with OF Troy Montgomery on December 13, 2017 for Ian Kinsler.

AWESOME APRIL: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,453).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last 12 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .119 (8-for-67) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.1 runs per game (25 total runs). On the current road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond is batting .085 (4-for-47) with runners in scoring position and averaging 1.9 runs per game (15 total runs). In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels were shut out in the Tuesday opener and then scored their only runs on solo homers last Wednesday. Their only runs last Saturday came on a second-inning grand slam by **Grant McCray**. They did not have an at-bat with a runner in scoring position on Sunday in the finale at Akron. So far in the series in Erie, the Flying Squirrels went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night and 0-for-3 on Wednesday, scoring their only run in that game on an error.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are four relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 12 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top 12 in ERA, including **Wil Jensen** (5th - 0.93 ERA - 2 ER/19.1 IP), **Evan Gates** (6th - 1.20 ERA - 2 ER/15.0 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (7th - 1.26 ERA - 2 ER/14.1 IP) and **Nick Garcia** (12th - 1.50 ERA - 2 ER/12.0 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (19.1) and LOB% (97.3%, min. 15 IP).

WILL POWER: Over his last 13 games since April 17, **Will Wilson** is batting .333 (16-for-48) with a homer, three doubles, eight walks, six RBIs and five runs scored. He reached base in 11 straight games from April 17-May 1, tied for the longest streak this season by a Richmond batter. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 159 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **John Michael Bertrand** is fourth in ERA (1.71), sixth in innings pitched (31.2) and eighth in WHIP (1.07). **Ryan Murphy** is first in games started (7). **Carson Ragsdale** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (32).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

In 2014, the Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 7-6, in 13 innings. Richmond led, 5-2, entering the ninth, but the Erie scored three to force extras. After the SeaWolves took a 6-5 lead in the 13th, Myles Schroder won the game in the bottom of the inning with a two-run single. Richmond set a franchise record with eight stolen bases in the game. Kelby Tomlinson set the franchise single-game record with five steals and had three hits.
