Tonight, Reading and Binghamton continue this week's series with game three. The current series is tied at one-game a piece.

Reading and Binghamton split yesterday's "double-header," with the Ponies winning game on 5-3 and Reading the second contest 2-1. The R-Phils win came on a walk-off walk in the bottom of the eighth inning. Carlos De La Cruz had a strong day, going a combined four-for-eight with three doubles. Cam Cannon also homered twice in the first game.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just seven wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (39).

Cam Cannon's two home runs yesterday marked the first multi-homer game of his career. It also marks the fifth time this season a member of the R-Phils have blasted two home runs in a game.

Remember Me for Centuries

Yesterday, Carlos De La Cruz became the first player in the Eastern League to record 100 hits in 2023. He now has 103 after four hits last night and sits at first in the league in hits.

On the Move

Three former R-Phils were promoted to triple-A Lehigh Valley yesterday in Tyler Phillips, Braden Zarbnisky and Brett Schulze. Tommy McCollum joined the team fron high-A Jersey Shore and Max Kuhns also re-joined Reading yesterday.

Reading's catchers have combined to be very difficult to run against as of late. Over the last 15 games, the group of Max McDowell, Cody Roberts and Herbert Iser have thrown out 20 of 47 would-be base stealers. That's good for a 43% clip.

Around the Organization

The Phillies defeated the Baltimore Orioles to win the series against the best team in the AL. Lehigh Valley powered their way to a 14-11 win over Syracuse as Weston Wilson homered again. Jersey Shore split a doubleheader with Aberdeen, winning the second game. Finally, Clearwater also split a two-gamer, winning the first contest over Jupiter.

Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with a 8-14 record in the second half and 43-48 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Brandon McIlwain leads the team offensively with a .264 average and 44 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .225 average and is 10th with a 4.44 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Tyler Stuart will be on the bump tonight for Binghamton. This is just Staurt's third start for Binghamton and he has a 2.08 ERA over 13 innings (13 H, 1 BB, 6 SO). He was called up from high-A Brooklyn on July 14. With Brookyln, Stuart was excellent, going 4-0 with a 1.55 ERA over 14 starts (75.2 IP, 56 H, 23 BB, 84 SO). Stuart started his pro career in 2022. making three total appearences with the Rookie Mets (1) and single-A St. Lucie (2). He was selected by the Mets in the sixth round in 2022 out of Southern Mississippi. He pitched mainly as a reliever in college, starting just four-of-35 games. Shined in high school football (2,064 career rec. yards/793&10 TD SR) and basketball (14 PPG, led in REB/AST as senior).

2022: Split season between high-A Jersey Shore and double-A Reading. Started 18 games for Blue Claws, going 7-8 with a 4.01 ERA. Had 103 strikeouts over 85.1 innings and just 38 walks. Struck out 10.9 hitters per nine innings. Promoted to double-A Reading on August 20. Made five starts for Reading, going 1-3 with a 3.52 ERA. Formed rotation with Phillies' top-prospects Andrew Painter and Griff McGarry. Struck out season-high ten hitters on July 29 at Wilmington, while still with Jersey Shore.

Career: Began pro career with single-A Clearwater in 2021. Made 14 starts for Threshers and went 1-3 with 4.43 ERA. Struck out 66 hitters over 44.2 innings (13.3 K/9) and hel opposing hitters to a .174 average. Made debut on May 5 and threw last game of 2021 on July 21. Was placed on 7-day IL on August 3 and would miss rest of season with shoulder troubles.

Abel was ranked as the top high school pitcher in the 2020 Draft class. Barely pitched at Jesuit, but showcased on summer showcase circuit in high school. Growing up, helped Cedar Mill Little League Team win a state title. Played 1B and pitcher for Jesuit High School. Sophomore season cut short due to injury to non-throwing shoulder that required surgery. Junior Year, went 10-0 with 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts over 72.1 innings. Led team to State Title and was named Oregon Gatorage Player of the Year ajd Junior All-American by Max Preps in 2019. Also in 2019, was selected for U-18 USA Team and going into 2020. Abel was selected a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America. Ranked as fourth-best collegiate prospect in nation. Committed to Oregon State after Freshman Year of high school.

Scouting Report: With a tall frame, Abel projects as a right-handed starter. Has a quick arm and fastball sits in mid-to-upper 90s. Also showcases a mid-80s slider, which is a plus pitch for Abel. Has a slower curveball and changeup. As Abel develops, scouts look for him to hone in on his command and improve strike throwing. Growing in that area could help him reach ceiling as front-half of the roation big league starter.
