HATCHER COLLECTS FIVE HITS IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 12-7 on Sunday evening from Arvest Ballpark. Frisco (32-25, 76-50) jumped out to an early lead in the top of the first inning against Northwest Arkansas (27-29, 62-63) starter Cruz Noriega (6-4). Abimelec Ortiz launched his third homer of the series, a three-run shot to give the Riders an early 3-0 lead. The RoughRiders added four runs in the top of the second as they sent eight batters to the plate. Alejandro Osuna drove in two runs with an RBI single, plating Cooper Johnson and Keyber Rodriguez. Josh Hatcher added a pair of runs on an RBI double, extending his hit streak to seven consecutive at bats and giving the Riders a 7-0 advantage. In the bottom of the second, the Naturals found the run column against Kohl Drake (2-1) on a solo homer by Diego Hernandez. Northwest Arkansas struck again in the bottom of the third, using a Luca Tresh RBI double to cut the Riders lead to 7-2. The Riders sent eight batters to the plate in the top of the fourth, manufacturing three more runs. Cody Freeman plated a pair of runs with an RBI single before Aaron Zavala pushed the Riders lead to 10-2. Frisco added a run on Maximo Acosta's sixth homer of the season to make it an 11-2 lead in the fifth. Drake exited after 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits and two walks while fanning three. Dane Acker worked a pair of scoreless frames, surrendering just one hit while striking out three before handing the ball to Seth Clark. The lefty spun a scoreless eighth inning, but allowed a sacrifice fly to Josh Lester in the bottom of the ninth. Down to their final out, Carter Jensen belted a grand slam, cutting the Riders lead to 12-7 before picking up the final out. Offensively, the Riders collected 12 hits. Acosta, Freeman, Hatcher and Zavala snagged multi-hit affairs. Acosta reached in all five of his plate appearances, working three walks for the first time in his career and scoring five times. Zavala extended his hit streak to 11 games.

THOSE ROUGHRIDERS ARE SO HOT RIGHT NOW:

The RoughRiders have been playing well recently, winning eight of their last 11 games. In the 11 games, Frisco is first in the Texas League in runs per game (6.7) and second in OPS (.834) while hitting 15 home runs in the 11 games.

Josh Hatcher has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .355/.417/.508/.925 over his last 31 games with seven doubles, four home runs and 19 RBIs. In a four-game hitting streak, he is hitting .588 (10-for-17)/.632/.941/1.573 with three doubles, one home run, five RBIs, five runs scored.

DOUBLE-A RON TAKING DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala has been swinging the bat well as of late, hitting in 11 games in a row. Over that streak, he is batting .390 (16-for-41)/.447/.439/.886 with two doubles and 12 RBIs. The hitting streak is the longest for the RoughRiders this season and the second-longest active streak in the Texas League (13 games by Andy Weber, Amarillo). Over his last 37 games, he is hitting .286/.381/.353/.734.

HOMER HAPPY

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 21 home runs in the last 15 games, with those 21 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 15 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 97 across their 124 games (on pace for 108, which would be for the 10th in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 36-28 with a 3.46 ERA, but a +28 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .659 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .314/.406/.543/.949 at home as opposed to .147/.223/.253/.476 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and significant in the side of the property of the and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.X.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
