TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open their lone series of the season against the Hartford Yard Goats.

LAST TIME OUT: Nick Dombkowski tossed 4 perfect innings to start and Altoona rallied for a 5-2 win over New Hampshire to complete the sweep on Sunday.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: For the first time since the adoption of the 6-game series in 2021, Altoona won all six games in a six-game series from August 25-Sept. 1 against New Hampshire. Altoona is one of three Double-A clubs (Birmingham, Springfield) to sweep a 6-game series and be swept in a 6-game series this season (vs Akron April 25-30).

LEFT-HANDED PUNCHES: Lefties Jaden Woods and Cy Nielson have racked up strikeouts since arriving from High-A Greensboro during the summer. Woods has struck out 38 batters in 27.0 innings since his Curve debut on June 22, during that time are the third-most among Eastern League relievers. Nielson has struck out 19 batters in his first 14.0 innings since being promoted from Greensboro on July 30

SEND US HOME: Altoona picked up their eighth walk-off win of the season on Friday, August 30 against New Hampshire when Matt Fraizer yanked a 3-run homer over the right field wall in the 10th inning. The Curve's 8 walk-off wins this season puts them in striking distance for the franchise record of 10, set by the 2005 Curve.

THAT BALL IS LOOOOOOONG GONE: Altoona banged three homers in their win over New Hampshire on Wednesday, August 28, the most in a game for the Curve at PNG Field since May 25, 2023 when the Curve hit four homers in a 16-0 win over Hartford.

UNCHAPPED: Emmanuel Chapman has fulfilled a critically important role on Altoona's pitching staff throughout the season. Since June 19 he's recorded a 2-1 record and a 2.14 ERA (46.1 IP / 11 ER), 45 strikeouts and a .152 BAA in his last 17 appearances (4 starts). In that time he's matched his career-long outing of 4.0 innings four times.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94). Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Frazee on Wednesday, August 28. Johnson's 83 walks this season are sixth-most in the minors this season.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (26 games), he's batting: .304/.396/.435/.831 with 5 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 4-5 SB.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 58 road games, Cheng is batting .249 with a .772 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 56 home games, Cheng is batting .170 with a .531 OPS totaling 7 2B, 1 HR, 19 RBI and 33 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .362 with a 1.111 OPS in 47 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

HARTFORD HAS IT: Manager Bobby Meacham makes another trip through the Eastern League circuit after two seasons leading the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. The Rockies Double-A affiliate is loaded with future stars including INF Adael Amador, RHP Chase Dollander, INF Ryan Ritter and LHP Sean Sullivan. To top things off, RHP Antonio Senzatela is back for a pair of rehab starts.

A GOAT HERDER: Antonio Senzatela, a 2016 Road Goat, takes the ball on rehab tonight. The 29-year-old made a rehab start last week for Hartford and is rebuilding his pitch count on his way back from Tommy John surgery. Senzatela has made 145 appearances, 119 starts for Colorado in his big league career in which he's gone 39-43 with a 4.87 ERA. A control artist, Senzatela features a fastball, sinker, slider, cutter and change-up.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2003 - First playoff game in team history, an 8-2 loss at Akron; Landon Jacobsen tabbed as starting pitcher and was bounced in the fourth inning. Curve built a 2-0 lead before three-run third by Akron.

2005 - Josh Bonifay hits a solo homer in the sixth inning at Bowie, a 3-1 win, for his 125th extra-base hit as a member of the Curve, passing Adam Hyzdu for the franchise's all-time record in that category.

2021 - Altoona narrowly avoids being no-hit for the 9th time in franchise history when Mason Martin lines an opposite field single to left field on a 3-2 pitch with 2 outs in the 9th inning at Akron.
