Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and continue a six-game series at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the ninth/10th-of-17 games between the teams this season and and third/fourth-of-five at Mirabito Stadium. The Rumble Ponies took four-of-six games at Reading from Apr. 15-20 and return to FirstEnergy Stadium from July 22-27. Binghamton leads the season-series 6-2.

Game 27 Recap

It was another walk off and late game comeback for Binghamton on Thursday night. Reading jumped out to a 4-0 lead thanks to four runs in the top of the third inning. The inning featured an Aidan Miller three-run home run, his third long ball of the season. Jean Cabrera was stellar on the mound as he allowed no runs on four hits over six innings, with eight strikeouts. Binghamton scored a run in the seventh thanks to a home run from Wyatt O'Neill. They then tied the game and took the lead eventually with four runs in the bottom of the eighth, going up 5-4. Robert Moore led off the ninth inning with his fifth home run of the season to tie the game at five. In the bottom of the ninth, Andrew Schultz walked the first three batters he faced to load the bases, then retired the next two he faced. With two outs, a fly ball was dropped by Cade Fergus in center field, giving Binghamton their second-straight walk-off win.

Keaton Crushing It

Keaton Anthony turned in the best game of his pro career on Wednesday night. He had four hits, one run, two doubles, a home run a and five RBI. The four hits matched a career high for the second time, with the last time being Sept. 5, 2024, at Aberdeen. The two doubles also matched a career best for the second time (8/11/24 at Wilmington). His five RBI in the game were a career-high and the second time this season a Fightin Phil had five RBI in a game (Robert Moore 4/15 vs Binghamton). Anthony's four hit game was the first time a R-Phil had four hits in a game since Carson Taylor on June 21, 2024, at New Hampshire. Anthony is currently on an 11-game hitting streak and 16-game on-base streak, which both rank as the longest active streaks in the Eastern League. Entering play today, Athony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 8th AVG (.310), T-8th RBI (17), 8th SLG (.524), 9th OPS (.892), T-1st 2B (10) and T-4th XBH (13).

Moore Please

Note: Flease Moore turned in another excellent game against Binghamton on Thursday night. He had three hits, two runs, a double, home run and two RBI. In seven games against the Rumble Ponies this season, Moore is slashing .455/.519/1.045 (1.564 OPS), along with nine runs, four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and two stolen bases.

Rolling Reyes

Felix Reyes continued his hot start to his time in Reading with another double, RBI and run scored on Wednesday night. Reyes was on a five game hitting streak from Apr. 30-May 8. Over that streak, he slashed .368/.333/.684 (1.017 OPS), with three runs, three douibles, one home run and six RBI. Since his Double-A debut on Apr. 17, Reyes is tied for seventh in the Eastern Legaue in doubles with five. He's also tied with Keaton Anthony with five doubles in that timeframe.

Double Double

The Fightin Phils turned in seven doubles and eight extra-base hits in Wednesday night's game, both of which are season highs. The eight extra-base hits are Reading's most in a game since having eight on June 28, of last season, against Bowie. It was the first time the R-Phils had seven doubles in a game since hitting eight on June 29, 2018, against Hartford.

Some Numbers

Following Thursday night's loss, the Fightin Phils are now 3-10 when scoring first in games. It was also their sixth loss this season when leading after the seventh inning. Last season, the Fightin Phils dropped eight games when leading after seven innings. The six-run blown lead on Wednesday night was also the largest lead surrendered by the R-Phils this season.

Rumbling into Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight with a 17-11 record, sitting tied for first in the Northeast Division. In 2024, the Rumble Ponies finished with a 69-67 record. Binghamton was in Erie last week and went 3-3, having to play two doubleheaders due to two games being rained out. After this week, the Rumble Ponies are back on the road and face Hartford in a seven-game series at Dunkin' Park. Six of the Mets' top-30 prospects are on Binghamton's roster: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Jonah Tong (6), Nick Morabito (17), Jonathan Pintaro (23) and Jack Wenninger (28).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Mets' No. 23 Prospect Jonathan Pintaro makes the start tonight for Binghamton. This season he is 0-2, with a 3.15 ERA over five starts (20.0 IP, 12 H, 7 BB, 28 SO). He last pitched against Erie on May 2, allowing two runs on three hits over 4.2 innings, along with six strikeouts, in a loss. Pintaro faced Reading twice this season on Apr. 15 and 20, and combined to allowed three-earned runs over seven innings on five hits, with nine strikeouts. Pintaro split last season between three levels, but mostly with Brooklyn (A+) and Binghamton, combining to go 3-6, with a 2.68 ERA over 17 games and 15 starts. The Mets signed the 27-year old during the summer of 2024 after playing in the Pioneer League in 2023 and '24. Mets' sixth-ranked prospect Jonah Tong makes the start in game two. Tong is 0-2, with a 3.38 ERA over five start this season. He lost to Reading on Apr. 16, allowing three runs on six hits over five innings of work.
