Matt Osterberg was solid on the mound, going five innings and allowing just one-earned run, with five strikeouts. Friday was Reading's first time shutout this season, after being shutout five times last season. Reading has already lost two games by 10+ runs this season, after losing by 10 or more runs three times all of last season.

The Fightin Phils begin the back half of this week's six-game series with Portland with a doubleheader today. Reading holds the 2-1 edge in both the season series and this week. #### Unfamiliar Territory

Last night, Casey Martin played center field in the ninth inning. It marked the first time in Martin's professional career he played an outfield position. The usual infiedler made a nice tumbling catch on the first ball hit his way.

#### **Taylor Rakes**

Carson Taylor crushed two home runs Tuesday night, including the game winning in the bottom of the seventh inning. It was the second-straight game Taylor has homered and his third overall this season, in five games. The last R-Phil with two home runs in a game was Nick Ward on Aug. 10, 2023 at New Hampshire. Tuesday night marked the third two-home run game for Taylor, with the last coming on July 3, 2023. It is the second time in Taylor's career that he hit home runs in back-to-back games, with the other coming on July 23-24, 2021, where he also hit three homers in two games.

#### **Rodriguez Rolling**

Jose Rodriguez had an impressive first two starts at home. He homered on Tuesday night in a big spot, and added three hits, an RBI and run scored last night. He was acquired from the White Sox last Friday and is a part of the Phillies 40-man roster.

#### **Odds and Ends**

Fightin Phils outfielder Marcus Lee Sang has had an impressive start to the season as he has reached base in all six games he's played in this season. Last season, Lee Sang's longest on-base streak was six games, from Aug. 15-22. Additionally, opposing teams have scored first in five of the six games the Fightin Phils have played this season, with Reading holding a 3-2 records in such games.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

April 13, 2023: At Reading, new R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique picked up his first win in a Fightin Phils uniform. It was an all-around effort in a 4-2 win, one in which the offense had timely hits and bullpen threw five innings, allowing just one run.

#### What's Up Dogs

Portland Enters tonight's game with a 1-3 record, after playing just one game last weekend, on Sunday, at home against Hartford. The first two games of the Sea Dogs season were postponned due to a snowstorm that hit Portland last week. Last season, the Sea Dogs with a 73-63 overall record, which was the third best in the Eastern League Northeast. They also narrowly missed the postseason, after finishing 2.5 games back of Somerset in the first-half standings. Portland's roster has nine of Boston's top-30 prospects, including: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (6), Nick Yorke (7), Blaze Jordan (20), Eddison Paulino (23), Hunter Dobbins (26) and Angel Bastardo (27).

#### Throw a Dog a Ball

On the mound today for Portland are lefty Helcris Olivarez and righty Hunter Dobbins. Olivarez is making his Double-A, and Red Sox organizational, debut today. He has not pitched since 2022, where he only threw one game. His last full season was for Rockies' High-A Spokane in 2021, where he went 4-9 with a 6.05 ERA. He missed most of 2022, and all of 2023, with injury. Olivarez signed with Boston last offseason and is from the same hometown as Johan Rojas. Hunter Dobbins returns to Portland after 13 appearances for the Sea Dogs in 2023. Overall last season, he went 9-6, with a 3.67 ERA over 20 appearances between High-A Greenville and Portland. He made his pro debut in 2022 with Single-A Salem. The Red Sox drafted Dobbins in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech.


