



FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of los Naturales, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of los Naturales' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
5 of los Naturales' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means, Logan Porter and John

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at los Naturales' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, los Naturales are 32-7, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-49.
Los Naturales are 28-13 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-43.
Los Naturales are 39-13 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-43 when out-hit by their opponent.
When los Naturales score first, they are 27-19, whereas 15-37 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

Los Naturales are 5-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 56 losses (30.3%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- Los Naturales have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 20 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 98 games, los Naturales have stolen 128 bases in 156 attempts (average 1.31 steals/game, 82.05% success rate).

- 128 steals is second in the Texas League, sixth in Double-A and 28th in the Minors ... 82.05% success rate is 17th among 120 full-season MiLB teams.
Maikel Garcia's 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fourth in the Texas League, Nick Loftin's 23 (in 26 attempts) ranks tied seventh in the league.
The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 64 of 98 games this season (65.3%), including 32 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
Los Naturales have pulled off a double steal 16 times, meaning 32 of 128 steals this year (25.0%) have come on a double-steal.
Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... Tucker Bradley had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder Tucker Bradley has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 69 of 84 games this season (82.1%) and reached base multiple times on 44 occasions, which ranks third on los Naturales ... he has hits in 59 of 84 games and has 26 multi-hit games, as well as 12 multi-run games and eight multi-RBI games.
Bradley's .303 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters, ranks ninth in the Texas League and third among Kansas City's minor league hitters ... his .390 on-base percentage also ranks third in the system, while 90 hits are tied fifth and his .838 OPS is eighth.
The Georgia native has hit first in the order 16 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .306 hitter (19-for-62) with a .434 on-base percentage and .853 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .297 (22-for-74) with a .381 on-base percentage.
Two of his six home runs this season have been grand slams, the first two of his professional career and the Naturales' second and third of the season ... April 23 @ Frisco and May 13 vs. Wichita, both came 5th inning.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder Tyler Gentry has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining los Naturales last month.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 11th in batting average (.326) when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.326) and OPS (.970), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.417) and slugging percentage (.553) ... his 59 runs batted in are tied fifth in the system (with Naturals teammate John Rave), while 15 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals rank sixth.
Gentry has hits in 26 of his 37 games with los Naturales and has reached base in 32 of 37 games (86.5%).
Since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .317 (46-for-145) over 38 games with nine doubles, 10 home runs and 36 runs batted (0.95 RBI per game) and a .987 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 19 of 38 games, with nine multi-RBI games ... he already has 14 multi-hit games and 10 multi-run games as well, including a pair of four-run games.
Over 22 games in the month of July, Gentry hit .329 (28-for-85) with nine extra-base hits and 21 runs batted in, while he has scored 19 runs as well ... his 21 RBI last month ranked tied fourth among Texas League hitters with teammate Robbie Glendinning.
Gentry's 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July.

- Glendinning's 64 runs batted in this season rank tied sixth in the Texas League, and tied eighth among all Double-A hitters ... his 61 runs scored are tied for the eighth-most in the Texas League, 36 extra-base hits and 155 total bases are tied 10th.
He has reached base in 73 of 84 games he's played this season (86.9%), reaching multiple times in 40 games this season ... he has hits in 56 of 84 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he places third in the system with 64 runs batted in, 61 runs scored, 155 total bases and 19 doubles, while 36 extra-base hits are tied 10th.
In 20 games in July, Glendinning hit .313 (26-for-83) with 11 extra-base hits and 21 runs batted in ... his 21 runs batted were are tied for the fourth-most in the Texas League in the month of July, seven home runs were tied fourth in the league and 51 total bases ranked tied fifth.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher Logan Porter has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks SIXTH in on-base percentage (.431) ... he is third among all qualified Texas League AND Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is also eighth in OPS (.917).
Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter's .431 OBP is the highest on-base percentage in the system, while he ranks third in OPS, fourth in batting average (.297) and fifth in slugging percentage (.486) ... his 55 walks are the most in the system, ahead of River Town's 52.
Porter has reached base in 64 of 74 games he's played this season (86.5%) and has reached base multiple times on 46 occasions, with hits in 58 of 74 games and 24 multi-hit games.
Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied for the second-longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 OBP.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (4)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
July 25 to July 31: LHP Dante Biasi ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 27 @ Wichita in an eventual 5-0 shutout win ... held the Wind Surge to just one hit and three walks while striking out five, on 79 pitches, his second straight scoreless start.

#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER

- Chris Widger will manage Los Naturales after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.



#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.
