TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints came from 5-0 and 7-3 down to tie the game at seven, but the Omaha Storm Chasers scored a run in the eighth as the Saints lost for the 11th consecutive time, 8-7. Alex Kirilloff went 3-4 with an RBI while Kevin Merrell was 2-4 with a home run and three RBI.

THE STRETCH FROM HELL - The St. Paul Saints have felt the pain over their last 11 games, going 0-11 during that span. They lost on May 8 at home to Iowa, were swept in a six-game series from May 10-15 at Columbus and have lost the first four games of the series to Omaha. It is the longest losing streak in Minor League Baseball this season and tied for the longest losing streak in all of baseball at any level (Cincinnati Reds). It is the longest losing streak in franchise history. It surpassed the seven game losing streak from August 22-31, 2021 when they lost to Iowa at home and were swept in a six-game series at Toledo.

ROCKY ROAD: The St. Paul Saints lost for the 12th consecutive times on the road Friday adding to their franchise record for most consecutive losses on the road. They have lost the first four games in Omaha, were swept in a six-game series by Columbus, and lost their last two games in Toledo on April 23 and 24. Their previous longest losing streak on the road was six when they were swept in a six game series by Toledo from August 24-29, 2021.

OFFENSIVE DEFENSE: The St. Paul Saints were one of the top defensive teams in the International League, but over the last 10 games they haven't played like it. They have committed an error in a franchise record 10 straight games, surpassing the five straight from August 26-September 1, 2021. They have committed 17 errors in the last eight games, a .953 fielding percentage, the worst in Triple-A during that time. The next closest is El Paso at .967.

NOT SO HOT CORNER: Royce Lewis played third base for the second time in his career and the first time he's started at third. He played eight innings on Friday, May 20 and four innings on September 2, 2019 when he was at Double-A Pensacola. In those 12 innings, he hasn't had one ball hit to him.

EIGHT IS TOO MUCH: The St. Paul Saints have allowed eight runs or more in four consecutive games from May 17-20. It's the second time in franchise history they've allowed eight runs or more in four consecutive games. The only other time it happened was August 26-29.

IMPRESSIVE ERRORLESS STREAK ENDS: July 1, 2018. That was the last time Mark Contreras committed an error. That streak ended with two outs in the 1st inning on Thursday, May 19. The throwing error by Contreras was his first error in 343 games, a total of 1985.1 innings played since his last error when he was at High-A Fort Myers.

CAPTAIN CAVEMAN: For the first time this season Jake Cave homered on May 18 at Omaha. Cave went 28 games to start the season without homering, the second longest of his career. The longest was his first full season in 2013 when he didn't homer in his first 42 games.

WILD THINGS: The St. Paul Saints threw four wild pitches on Wednesday night that led to three runs scoring. Jake Faria, two, and Daniel Gosset and Jordan Gore each threw one. The four wild pitches are a franchise record. Last season the Saints threw three wild pitches on three occasions, two of them in an extra inning ballgame.

WAS THAT A BUNT?: It took until game 105 last season before the Saints laid down a sacrifice bunt. On May 11, the Saints laid down their first of the season when David Bañuelos dropped one down in game 30 of the season. They surpassed their entire total from a year ago when Cole Sturgeon put down a sacrifice bunt just nine days later on May 20.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins took care of business by defeating the Kansas City Royals 6-4 on Friday night at Kauffman Stadium. Devin Smeltzer tossed 5.1 innings allowing one run on five hits and Jhoan Duran pitched 1.2 scoreless innings of relief. Jose Miranda went 2-4 with a double and two RBI while Gilberto Celestino continued his torrid pace by going 2-3.

START PRIOR: 4/26 vs. NAS...pitched 4.2 innings allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out six...did not receive a decision in a 4-1 Saints victory.

A ROSE BY ANY OTHER NAME: Going by ones middle names is a common theme with this St. Paul Saints team. Dereck Rodriguez joins the middle name club. His given name is Ivan Dereck Rodriguez.

SON OF PUDGE: If you think the name Ivan Rodriguez sounds like a baseball players name, it should. Dereck's father is Hall of Fame catcher Ivan "Pudge" Rodriguez. Pudge played 21 seasons in the Major Leagues (1991-2002, 2009 with Texas, 2003 with Florida, 2004-08 with Detroit, 2008 with the Yankees, 2009 with Houston, and 2010-11 with Washington). He was a 14x All-Star, won 13 Gold Gloves, and won a World Series with the Marlins in 2003. On top of that he caught Kenny Rogers' perfect game with the Rangers in 1997. He was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 2017.

SHOULDN'T YOU BE A CATCHER: If your Dad is a Hall of Fame Catcher one would think you would grow up being a catcher too. For Dereck, he did start off his high school career at Monsignor Edward Pace (FL) HS as a catcher. Unfortunately, he didn't love the position and transitioned to the outfield. One of the other reasons he made the transition is he had a growth spurt in high school that vaulted him to 6'1 which made it uncomfortable to crouch.

I'M BATMAN: Dereck is a huge fan of Batman. He's such a big fan that he has a Batman tattoo on his right forearm. The tattoo's didn't stop there. He has since added a tattoo of The Joker, Catwoman, and Harley Quinn

IF YOU CAN'T BEAT THEM, JOIN THEM: From starting as a catcher in high school to being a converted outfielder, Dereck Rodriguez turned that into an 6th round selection out of high school. Unfortunately, hitting became an issue for Rodriguez. He hit just .216 with six homers and 37 RBI across 2017 games between the GCL and Rookie Elizabethton from 2011-13. The Twins then transitioned him into a pitcher and his career has since taken off.

SON OF PUDGE MEET KUNG FU PANDA: Once Rodriguez became a free agent, he decided to sign with the San Francisco Giants in 2018. The greatest influence was one Pablo Sandoval. The two were working out together during the offseason in Miami and Sandoval told him signing with the Giants would be a good fit.

DIDN'T YOU USED TO BE A HITTER: From high school position player, to 6th round draft pick, to transitioning into a pitcher after three professional seasons because he struggled at the plate to...collecting a base hit in your first Major League at bat. That's right. In his Major League debut on May 29, 2018 in Colorado he promptly doubled in his second at bat off Kyle Freeland. Since then, he's collected just seven more hits and is hitting .131 (8-61) in his career.

- Has been part of four different MLB organizations (Minnesota - 2011-17, San Francisco - 2018-20, Detroit - 2020 and Colorado - 2021)
- Made his first career Opening Day roster for San Francisco in 2019
- Named to the Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team in 2018
- Made his major league debut May 29 at Colorado and finished the season second in ERA (2.81), third in opponent batting average (.223), sixth in innings pitched (118.1), eighth in starts (19) and ninth in strikeouts (89) among qualifying National League rookies
- His 2.81 ERA (118.1 IP, 37 ER) was the lowest by a Giants rookie pitcher (min. 100.0 IP) since Hall of Famer Hoyt Wilhelm (2.43) in 1952 and the seventh lowest among NL pitchers on the season (min. 100.0 IP)
- Became the first Giants pitcher since 1900 to pitch six-or-more innings and allow two-or-fewer runs in at least 13 of his first 16 career starts (June 3-Sept. 10, 2018)
- Made nine consecutive starts of six-or-more innings and two-or-fewer runs from June 14-Aug. 24, 2018...became the third rookie pitcher in major league history to make nine such starts consecutively since 1958 (also: Joe Blanton, 2005 and Mike Fiers, 2012)
- Was 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with High-A Fort Myers
- Led the Appalachian League in innings pitched (66.1 IP), while ranking fourth in strikeouts (61) and sixth in ERA (2.85)
- Named 2015 Appalachian League Pitcher of the Year and was name a Postseason All-Star
- Converted to a relief pitcher in 2014 after spending three years as an outfielder (2011-13) and didn't allow a run over his first 11 appearances (17.0 IP). Finished the season 2-2, 1.05 ERA (25.2 IP, 3 ER) with five saves, eight walks and 19 strikeouts across 17 relief appearances
