INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Seth Beer bashed a solo home run in the fifth inning to extend his recent hot streak, but the Omaha Storm Chasers rallied behind a grand slam to slide past the Indianapolis Indians 7-4 on Saturday night at Werner Park. With the Indians leading 4-2 in the sixth after an Alika Williams double, Beer's solo blast and back-to-back RBI singles from Henry Davis and Jake Lamb, the Storm Chasers responded in grand fashion. In the bottom half of the inning, Rodolfo Durán crushed a grand slam off Ryan Borucki to put Omaha out in front. The Storm Chasers capped their scoring in the eighth after Brian O'KeeTe smacked a solo blast for Omaha's final run of the contest.

THE BEER KEEPS FLOWING: Seth Beer continued his hot streak last night, launching a go-ahead home run in the fifth inning to kick off a three-run frame. The solo blast extended his hitting streak to each of his last six games, and he has now hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games dating back to June 27 (2). In that time, he is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with 10 runs, three doubles, four home runs and 15 RBI. Beer has been a road warrior in his time with Indianapolis, hitting safely in each of his nine games on the road with a .353 batting average (12-for-34), five extra-base hits, 13 RBI, three walks and just six strikeouts. At Victory Field, he is hitting .242 (8-for-33) with three runs, two extra-base hits, two RBI and 11 strikeouts in nine games.

HANK ON BASE: Henry Davis went 2-for-4 last night with an RBI single in the three-run fifth inning last night as one of three Indians to put up multiple hits in the loss. The two-hit performance was his eighth with the Indians this season. It was also his third consecutive game with a hit after launching home runs in consecutive games from July 13-14 vs. Columbus, marking his first stretch of consecutive games with a home run since hitting three total in back-to-back contests on April 23 and April 26, 2023. In 31 total games with the Indians this season across two stints, he is hitting .297 (33-for-111) with 24 runs, nine doubles, nine home runs, 22 RBI, a .622 slugging percentage and 1.040 OPS.

RAKE LAMB: Jake Lamb extended his hitting streak to four games with an RBI single in the Indians three-run fifth inning last night. He has hit safely in eight of his last nine games since July 4 and 10 of 12 games since being rejoining the Indians lineup on June 30 after requesting his release and re-signing with Pittsburgh. He has been an on-base machine with the Indians this season, hitting .283 (68-for-240) with 30 runs, 20 extra-base hits, 30 walks and just 54 strikeouts in 67 total games.

WELCOME TO INDIANAPOLIS: Edward Olivares joined Henry Davis with two hits in last night's loss at Omaha and swiped a pair of bases, marking his second consecutive multi-hit game after going 2-for-4 with a run and double on July 14 vs. Columbus. They were his first hits in an Indians uniform after joining the lineup on July 2 (1). Olivares is no stranger to Omaha, playing in 100 games with the Storm Chasers from 2021-23. In those games, he hit .311 (1/20-for-386) with 77 runs, 24 doubles, three triples, 19 home runs, 59 RBI and 18 stolen bases.

CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD): Jake Woodford continued his dominant stretch for the Indians last night, tossing 5.0 two-run innings last night, exiting the contest with a 4-2 lead. Since making his Pirates organization debut on June 14 at Jacksonville, he is 0-2 with a 2.37 ERA (8er/30.1ip) and 30 strikeouts in six starts. He ranks among International League qualifiers with a 1.23 WHIP (3rd) and .249 batting average against (9th) for the season between Charlotte and Indy. Woodford has now logged at least 5.0 innings in 11 of his last 12 starts dating back to April 24 with Charlotte at Lehigh Valley and 13 of his 16 starts this season between teams.

MATT'S BACK TO MASHING: Matt Gorski went 0-for-1 as a pinch hitter last night after he launched his 16th home run and second in as many games in the third inning on Friday night, following Jake Lamb's two-run homer to give Indianapolis a 4-1 lead. He homered in the ninth inning vs. Columbus on Saturday, marking his first home run in 17 games since June 18 vs. lowa. That 17-games trisch was this longest without a home run since going 22 games from April 7-May 12. He then homered 10 times in his next 18 games through June 2. Gorski is getting hot at the right time as the Indians play seven more games at the homer-heavy Werner Park and Principal Park, home of the Iowa Cubs. Gorski homered four times — including a two-homer game on May 21 — in six games at Iowa's Principal Park earlier this season.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a nine-game road trip at Omaha and Iowa tonight at 6:05 PM ET with the final of three games at Werner Park in Papillion, Neb. The Indians traveled to Omaha from May 23-28, a six-game series shortened to just three games as the Midwest underwent challenging weather over the weekend. In 12 total games this season, the Storm Chasers lead the Indians 9-3. Closing out the series for Indianapolis today is former Storm Chaser RHP Luis Cessa (3-4, 4.61), who began the season in Omaha's starting rotation. Countering for the Storm Chasers is LHP Daniel Lynch IV (6-0, 3.89) for his second start against the Indians this season and fifth in his career since 2021. In those games, he is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (5er/19.1ip) and 25 strikeouts.

FRIENDS TO FOES: Indianapolis' starting pitcher in the series finale tonight, RHP Luis Cessa, began the season with Omaha after being signed by Kansas City as a minor league free agent on Nov. 18, 2023. In his tenure with the Storm Chasers, he went 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA (17er/39.1ip) and 29 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts) before being granted his release on June 1. He was then signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10 and is 1-2 with a 6.46 ERA (11er/15.1ip) and 10 strikeouts in five games (four starts).

THIS DATE IN 1976: After hitting a foul ball off his foot on the previous pitch, pinch-hitter Danny Godby hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning vs. Evansville to give Indy a 5-4 win. Ray Knight tied the game at 3-3 in the ninth with his second home run of the night, and both teams traded runs in the 10th before Godby's heroics
