SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

TRIPLING UP ON THE ACTION: With a fourth-inning triple on Friday, INF Tyler Black tallied his eighth of the season, setting a new single-season franchise record... Black's eight triples broke the previous record, set by INF Orlando Arcia in 2015 and tied by **OF Corey Ray** in 2018... Entering today, Black's eight triples are the most out of any player in Double-A, and tied for the fifth-most in Minor League Baseball.

STARRING SINCE THE BREAK: Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have won 10 of their last 13 games, tied with four other teams for the second-best record since the break in full-season Minor League Baseball.

- Solver those 13 games, the Shuckers lead all teams in Double-A with a .294 average and an .888 OPS... The .888 OPS is fourth-best out of the 120 full-season MiLB teams.
- Solution of the charge over the stretch, leading all qualified Double-A hitters with a 1.302 OPS and is tied for fourth with eight stolen bases.

THEY HAVE THE POWER: INF Zavier Warren hit the Shuckers' 35th home run in July with a 416-foot shot on Friday, the second-most in any month in franchise history, and the most since they hit 43 in July of 2018... Biloxi's 35 home runs are the third-most in Double-A and the fifth-most in Minor League Baseball.

TIME FOR JACKSON TO BLAST OFF: OF Jackson Chourio hit his team-leading 15th home run of the year on Thursday, becoming one of three teenagers with at least 15 home runs in 2023, and the only one to do so in Double-A and Triple-A.

- Shourio is the first teenager to tally at least 15 home runs in a season in the high minors since INF Fernando Tatis Jr. did so in 2018 with the Double-A San Antonio Missions... Six players have reached the mark since 2005.
- Sometimes Chourio enters today five home runs away from becoming the first teenager to record a 20/20 season in the high minors since **OF Delmon Young** reached the mark with the Montgomery Biscuits in 2005.

SWIPING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: With four stolen bases on Tuesday, the Shuckers broke the franchise single-season record for stolen bases in a season... The Shuckers' 169 stolen bases have blown past their previous record of 162, set

- The Shuckers are currently on pace to tally 248 stolen bases, the most by any Double-A team since 2005.
- Soft Jackson Choruio (31) has combined with INF Tyler Black (45) to reach become the first Shuckers' pair to steal at least 30 in a year since 2017... The pair have combined to steal more bases (76) than 11 different full-season MiLB teams.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS (5-3, 5.86): RHP Tobias Myers is set to make his first start against the Barons since June 11, 2023 at Riverwalk Stadium as a member of the Montgomery Biscuits... Over two starts last week against the Biscuits, Myers struck out 19 in 10.2 innings... Myers has thrown at least five innings in each of his last three starts, and in five of his last six.
