## Sacramento River Cats (33-23) vs. Tacoma Rainiers (24-34)

**RAIN(IERS) ON OUR PARADE:** The Sacramento River Cats lost tonight's game 1-6...they are now 16-10 at home, 22-18 in night games, 22-13 against right-handed starters and 25-11 when scoring first...did not homer for the 22nd time this season; are 5-17 in such games...recorded two double plays; marked their fifth multi-double play game of the season, four of which have occurred within their last 12 games...Blade Tidwell was the starter and was dealt his first loss of the season...allowed two runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts in a season-high 5.0 innings of work...Tidwell has allowed at least one run in each of his last six outings for the first time since May 16-July 8 last season (10-straight outings)...threw two wild pitches, the second time in his career giving up two wild pitches in a game...also happened May 4, 2023 with High-A Brooklyn, both came in the same inning in that game as well.

▶ Jesús Rodríguez went 1-for-2 with a double, his first since his last game with Sacramento on May 2 as he did not double with San Francisco...rejoined the River Cats after being optioned on June 1 following a 14-game, 28-day stint with the Giants...has reached safely in every game except his first this season, extending his on-base streak to 24 games, the second-longest active on-base streak in the PCL, behind Chad Stevens' 39-game streak.

▶ Will Brennan went 1-for-4, rejoined the River Cats after being optioned four the fourth time from San Francisco...he has hit safely in all but two games with the River Cats, batting .333 (29-for-87) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, 16 RBI, four walks, one stolen base, a .365 on-base percentage and a .802 OPS in 21 games with Sacramento this season.

**ACE UP OUR SLEEVE:** The River Cats won Sunday's game, 13-11...marked their third time scoring 13-or-more runs in a game; they are 3-0 in such games...three hours and 29 minutes marked their longest nine-inning game since May 13, 2022 at El Paso which took three hours and 53 minutes (excluding April 1, 3:30 with :17 delay)...Carson Whisenhunt was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed a five runs on seven hits, with three walks (1 IBB) and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings...was his most runs allowed and shortest outing since April 22 (4.2 innings, 6 ER)...the intentional walk in the fifth marked the first of Whisenhunt's career...Trent Harris earned his second win of the season...allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and no strikeouts in 1.0 inning...Seth Lonsway made his third relief appearance of the season and earned the save...threw 0.1 hitless innings with just three pitches...marked the fourth save of Lonsway's career, and first since 2023 with High-A Eugene.

▶ Nate Furman (1-for-4) recorded his fifth home run of the season in the first inning, a 415-foot, two-run shot to right field...marked the second-longest recorded home run of his career (422 feet, May 19)...was his second homer hit in the first inning this season (also, April 25 vs. ABQ)...extended his hitting streak to nine games, T-6th longest in the PCL.

▶ Drew Cavanaugh (2-for-5) knocked his fifth homer of the season in the first inning, immediately following Furman's longball in the first...the ball traveled 447 feet, the second-longest home run by a River Cat this season (Bericoto, 459)...was his eighth multi-hit game with Sacramento.

▶ The River Cats recorded their second back-to-back home runs this season with Furman and Cavanaugh's longballs in the first (also, Daniel Susac and Buddy Kennedy, May 7 vs. Reno)...was the Cats first time with back-to-back home runs in the first inning since August 14, 2021 at Salt Lake (Heliot Ramos and Mike Tauchman)...was the 15th time this season Sacramento has knocked multiple home runs in a game, they are 15-0 in such games.

**WHAT UP I'M JARED:** Jared Oliva (2-for-2) began his major league rehab assignment on Saturday...joined the River Cats on rehab after being placed on the 10-day IL on April 15, and transferred to the 60-day IL on April 29 due to a left wrist hamate fracture...on Sunday, he went 1-for-3 with a leadoff double in the first...was the 14th leadoff extra-base-hit of his career, and first since he hit a leadoff homer on May 3, 2019 with Double-A Altoona...marked his first back-to-back games with an extra-base-hit since August 24 and 26 last season.

▶ In three games with Sacramento so far he has gone 3-for-8 with two doubles, one RBI, two stolen bases, and a .958 OPS.

**WHO'S THE NEW GUY?:** Drew Cavanaugh (4-for-4) recorded his second multi-homer game of the season of the season on May 27...the only River Cat to have multiple multi-homer games last season was Marco Luciano (3 two-HR games)...two of Luciano's multi-HR games were just six days apart; Cavanaugh's multi-HR games were seven days apart.

▶ He has knocked 10 extra-base-hits in his last 10 games since May 20, second in Triple-A in that span (Joshua Báez, 13 XBH, 12 games)...he is batting .462 (18-for-39) with five doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, four walks, two stolen bases, a .974 slugging percentage and a 1.497 OPS in that time.

**TUGBOAT TIME:** Southpaw Matt Wilkinson is set to take the mound tonight against Tacoma for his Triple-A debut...he becomes the eighth player and second pitcher to make their Triple-A debut with Sacramento this season...was acquired on May 9 from Cleveland in exchange for catcher Patrick Bailey...was promoted to the River Cats on June 2...today marks his Triple-A debut.

▶ Last pitched on May 27 at Akron, his former club, where he earned his second win as a Flying Squirrel...threw a career-high-tying 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and one walk, and fanning three batters.

▶ In nine starts at Double-A between the Akron RubberDucks and Richmond Flying Squirrels, Wilkinson has gone 3-2, posting a 1.87 ERA (43.1 IP, 9 ER) with two home runs, 13 walks and 49 strikeouts.

**BOYS IN THE BIGS:** RHP Wilkin Ramos and IF Buddy Kennedy had their contracts selected by San Francisco on June 1...Kennedy went 0-for-1 and Ramos allowed two runs on three hits, with two walks and one strikeout in 2.0 innings of work, following Landon Roupp...Dylan Smith was recalled today for the second time...five Cats batters and three pitchers are current on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats:
