#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

THRESHERS CRUSHERS: The Marauders enter their three-game series with Clearwater leading the season-series 8-7. Throughout their 15 meetings, they've scored 91 runs (6.1 per game) and have powered 17 homers, the most of against any opponent this season. The last time the two faced, the Marauders finished the series red hot, producing double-digit run outputs in their last three games. In the process, they scored 36 runs. Over 23 games since the beginning of the second half, the Threshers have pitched to the fifth highest ERA in Single-A (4.87), are tied for the second most home runs allowed (21) and fourth highest slugging percentage (.387). Wyatt Sanford was stellar in the series, finishing 8-for-22 with three homers and 10 RBI.

AGER DAY: Right hander Matt Ager will toe the rubber in the series opener versus Clearwater tonight. After consecutive bulk relief outings behind big-league rehabber Johan Oviedo, Ager enters play with a 4.41 ERA over 49 frames. After a difficult May where he allowed 14 runs over 12.1 innings, Ager has

bounced back, posting a 2.98 ERA over his last seven starts (27.2 IP). Tonight marks his first outing in eleven days when he tossed a career-high 4.2 innings of two-run ball versus St. Lucie. He's tossed four innings or more in five of his six five starts. The right hander has cut down on his walks after averaging a free pass an inning in May. He mixes in a four seamer (90 mph), slider (82.4 mph, 37.3% Whiff), changeup (83.9 mph) and curveball (74 mph). He has been stellar against right-handed batters, limiting them to a .206 average and .299 slugging percentage

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 72 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second-most throughout the entire level. 110 of their 424 total runs have been generated via the long ball (25.9%). They're 25-20 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-27 when not homering at all. They've seen three players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin)

FINDING A WAY: While the Marauders have been very relient on the longball this season, they haven't left the yard in six consecutive games - their longest such stretch of the season. It marks just the second time they've gone five or more contests without a homer (4/19-4/24). Instead, they've been dominating the running game, and have manufactured their runs. Since their last home on 7/10 vs St. Lucie, the Marauders lead the Florida State League with 18 stolen bases and are 20-74 with runners in scoring position - good for the league's second best clip (.317). Moreover, in those spots, they've blasted seven doubles and slugged .429.

SECOND-HALF TRENDS: Bradenton is off to a 12-11 start in the second half, currently holding a 0.5 game lead over Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 43 games to go, the  $Marauders \ are eyeing \ their \ first postseason appearance since 2021 \ when \ they \ won \ their second \ FSL \ title. Entering \ the \ week, \ Bradenton \ has been \ stellar \ on \ the \ mound \ in \ the \ second \ half, posting \ they \ the$ a 3.36 ERA over 200.2 innings - the eighth best mark in Class-A and the third best in the Florida State League. In the process, their starters have been dominant, posting a 1.73 ERA to lead all Single-A clubs over the stretch (LAK - 2.55, 2nd). In the process they've limited opponents to a .197 average and have only allowed one homer. Moreover, as an offense, they're 64-for-215 (.298) with runners in scoring position, good for the second highest clip in Single-A in run-scoring opportunities. They've also swiped 62 bases, the second most in Single-A.

WELCOME TONY: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 and and collected his first Single-A hit and RBI on a first-inning single and fourth-inning sacrfice fly. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: Last Sunday, the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.11P, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best preparm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed  $change up, curve ball and slider. Other notable selections included C {\color{red} \textbf{Easton Carmichael}} (3 rd Rd., Oklahoma), SS {\color{red} \textbf{Gustavo Melendez}} (4 rd Rd., HS) and 1B {\color{red} \textbf{Jared Jones}} (9 rd Rd., LSU) among others.$ 

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Pirates No. 23 prospect Edward Florentino was named Florida State League Player of the Week on 7/7 for his dominant stretch from June 30 - July 6. He became the first Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Florentino finished the week 8-for-23 (.348), with three home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles and three stolen bases. He blasted his first Single-A longball on Tuesday and capped the week with the first multi-homer performance of his professional career by launching two against Fort Myers on Sunday Florentino's eight hits and three homers were tied for the most among FSL hitters throughout the week. His 20 total bases were also the most of any player around the league, and second in all of Single-A. Florentino is the Pirates No. 23 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21. In 29 games with the Florida Complex League Pirates,  $he powered six home runs and drove in 23 runs. His .642 slugging percentage and 1.084 OPS led the FCL before his promotion. \\ In 23 games with the Marauders, he is slashing .299/.434/.558$ with 12 extra-base-hits and 18 walks. He recently was named the Pirates No. 9 prospect in Baseball America's updated rankings, marking one of the largest jumps in MiLB.
