SHOREBIRDS HAUNTED BY SEVEN-RUN SIXTH INNING: The Delmarva Shorebirds fell in the final game of the series against the Salem Red Sox on Sunday by a score of 8-6. Delmarva grabbed the lead in the fourth on a successful first-and-third steal by Matthew Etzel and Anderson De Los Santos. De Los Santos then scored on a double by **Noelberth Romero** to give the Shorebirds a 2-0 edge. However, the Red Sox would snatch the lead away and then some in the sixth as they scored seven runs with the bulk of the damage coming on a two-run homer by Luis Ravelo and a three-run shot by Albert Feliz to put Delmarva behind 7-2. They'd score again in the top of the sixth to make it an 8-2 game. The Shorebirds would fight back in the bottom half of the inning as **Randy Florentino** hit a two-run homer, and they'd score again in the ninth on a sacrifice fly by Florentino and infield hit by **Enrique Bradfield Jr.**, but Delmarva would fall just short as they lost 8-6.

LHP ADAM TULLOCH (4~5, 5.33)

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan Rojas gets the call in the series opener against the Lynchburg Hillcats as he makes his third start in a Shorebirds uniform. He'll face the reigning, Carolina League Pitcher of the Week in **Adam Tulloch** who is coming off a five inning start where he no-hit the Fayetteville Woodpeckers and struck out eight in a 4-0 shutout win. This will be the fourth time Tulloch will start against the Shorebirds and is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA with 18 strikeouts, 8 walks in 10.2 innings.

SPEED, I AM SPEED: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has made his presence felt since he's joined the Shorebirds as the 1st round pick from Vanderbilt has 13 steals in his starts as a Shorebird. He swiped 4 bases against the Carolina Mudcats on August 13 the most by a Delmarva player in a single game this season. More impressively, Brad-field has reached base at a .581 clip so far thanks to 13 walks he's drawn in his brief Single-A tenure. Bradfield has reached base in all 9 games a Shorebirds and is currently riding a 6 game hitting streak.

DRIVING THEM HOME IN BUNCHES: Anderson De Los Santos has gained steam as a key run producer for the Shorebirds as of late as he drove him six in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox and is the current leader on the team in RBI amongst active members with 41. De Los Santos has reached base 7 straight games and is on a 5 game hitting streak.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 43 steals in the month of August, which is second most in the league in that span (Augusta).

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 278. They are top five in the league doubles (169), triples (30), and home runs (79). The Shorebirds produced 17 extra-base hits in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox.

FINAL ROAD TRIP OF THE SEASON: The Shorebirds embark on a 12 game road trip before returning home for the final series of the regular season. The first half of their two city trips is to Lynchburg against the Hillcats where the Shorebirds won four out of six from June 28 - July 3. Delmarva was won the first two series against Lynchburg and split their most previous one in Salisbury and currently hold an 11-7 record against the Guardians affiliate this season.

TODAY'S STARTER: Juan Rojas takes the mound as the starter for the series opener against the Lynchburg Hillcats, making his third start in a Shorebirds uniform.

LAST OUTING (8/16 vs SAL): Rojas did not factor into the decision in his last start on Wednesday against the Salem Red Sox as he threw three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while striking out four. The Shorebirds would win the game 7-3.

vs. LYNCHBURG: This will be the second time Rojas pitches against the Hillcats and will look for a bounce back as Lynchburg handed him a loss on August 3 as they scored 6 runs (4 earned) in 2.2 innings as the starter that night and the Hillcats would get the win 12-7.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Rojas pitched the first half of last season in the FCL for the Minnesota Twins where he struck out 38 with just 4 walks in 30 innings while holding an ERA of 3.60. The left-hander was] then involved in the trade for the Orioles at the 2022 deadline that sent RHP Jorge Lopez to Minnesota. Rojas threw just 8.2 innings in 3 appearances for the Orioles FCL team where he did not allow any runs with 12 strikeouts.



MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
