To Keep The Streak Alive

The Fightin Phils remain on the road for a season-long two week, and 13-game road trip, at New Hampshire and Portland. At this moment, Reading is yet to drop a series of six or more games. The trip starts in New Hampshire for a seven-game series, finishing on Sunday. Al Pedrique's squad can also climb two games above .500 for the first time in the 2026 season. It is the 11th-of-18 match ups between the teams this season and sixth-and-seventh-of-seven at Delta Dental Stadium in Manchester, New Hampshire. Reading holds a 3-2 series advantage and leads the season tilt 6-4. Following this week, the Fisher Cats return to Reading from June 30-July 5 to finish the season series.

Fightin' Their Way To The History Books

Reading set some new watermarks in its 20-0 blowout victory over New Hampshire yesterday. The scoring outburst was the Fightins' first 20-run performance since downing Bowie 21-4 on July 8, 2016. It's also the third 20+ run showing since at least 2005 (21-4 win vs. New Britain on July 2, 2007). In all, this is the largest positive run differential since at least the 2005 season as well. The pitching delivered its first shutout of 2026 and has now allowed three runs or less in four consecutive contests.

The Murr-acle On Dirt

Austin Murr tallied four hits, four runs and clubbed his sixth home run of the season in yesterday's victory. This is Rule 5 (Triple-A Phase) draft acquisition's third four-hit game of his career, with the last instance coming on June 13, 2025 as a member of the West Michigan Whitecaps (vs. Lansing). This was also his second career four-run game, with the first occurrence happening on July 4, 2022, also for West Michigan (against Dayton). Yesterday marked the first time in Murr's professional baseball career that he logged four hits and four runs in a game.

Money McFarlane

It was another stellar week for Phillies' No. 17 prospect Alex McFarlane against Somerset, as the 24-year old did not allow a run over three appearances and three innings of work. McFarlane has not allowed a run over his last eight outings (8.0 IP) and has not allowed a run in 13-of-14 appearances this season. He has also allowed one or zero hits in every appearance he's made this year. Amongst Eastern League pitchers with at least 10 appearances this season, McFarlane (2-1) is second in ERA at 0.68 (1 ER, 12.1 IP), trailing only former Fightin Phil Levi Stoudt. He features an upper-90s fastball and a wipeout slider.

Toeing The Rubber With Confidence

The Fightin Phils' pitching staff has allowed just four runs over the last 23 innings (three games) following yesterday's 20-0 shutout win. Six of the last seven Reading starters have provided at least five innings of work. Since May 9, the pitching staff as a whole holds a 5-2 record with the best earned run average in Double-A at 2.62. The R-Phils arms have struck out 46 and walked just 14 (also a Double-A best) in that timespan. The Fightins have allowed the least amount of walks (117) of any Eastern League team this season by a margin of 22 (Portland has 139). They are also second in the league in WHIP (1.34) and third in earned run average (4.61).

Binelas The Basher

Alex Binelas logged his fourth career four-hit performance in yesterday's triumph while also logging one run and three runs driven in. It is his first four-hit game with Reading and the fourth of his career since having his name called in the 2021 MLB Draft. The first baseman's most recent four-hit showing was on June 11, 2024, when he was a member of the Portland Sea Dogs who faced Reading that day. Binelas currently leads the Fightin Phils in AVG (.311), HR (10), RBI (30), OBP (.419), SLG (.632) and OPS (1.051). The 25-year-old also has more home runs this season than he had in 68 contests (eight) in a Reading uniform back in 2025.

Bring it Bryan

Bryan Rincon's excellent month of May continued on Saturday with the second four-run game of his career and the second in this month alone (May 1 vs. Hartford was his first showing). Over 14 games in May, Rincon is slashing .365/.459/.769 (1.228 OPS), along with 17 runs, four doubles, one triple, five home runs and 13 RBI. This came after he hit .222 (16-72) over 21 games in April. For the month of May, Rincon holds the following Eastern League rankings: 9th AVG (.365), T-3rd HR (5), T-4th RBI (13), 7th OBP (.459), 4th SLG (.769), 3rd OPS (1.228), T-7th hits (19), T-2nd XBH (10), T-2nd TB (40) and 1st Runs (17). He is also hitting a team-best .419 (13-for-31) against New Hampshire.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 17, 2019: At Reading, Mickey Moniak has three hits and Tom Eshelman allows just one run over 6.2 innings as the Fightin Phils use two runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to beat Portland 3-1.

Calling the Cats

New Hampshire enters play today with a 21-14 record, which leads Reading in the Northeast Division standings by three games. The Fisher Cats finished off a five-game series with Portland last week, winning four-of-five; as they were victorious in the first-four games and dropped the season-finale on Sunday. After this week, they remain at home next week and welcome Hartford for a six-game series. The Fisher Cats roster features eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Arjun Nimmala (3), Gage Stanifer (6), Victor Arias (12), Fernando Perez (16), Sean Keys (17), Javen Coleman (23), Cutter Coffey (25) and Adrian Pinto (29).

On the Bump for New Hampshire

New Hampshire righty Chris McElvain will get the start for the Fisher Cats in game six of this seven-game series. McElvain is 2-0 with a 3.90 earned run average through six starts. In a pair of appearances against Reading, the 25-year-old righty is 1-0 with five earned runs allowed and 11 strikeouts to three walks over 10 innings of work. McElvain was originally a 2022 eighth round draft pick, as the Cincinnati Reds selected him out of Vanderbilt at 243rd overall.
