INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Iowa Cubs held the Indianapolis Indians scoreless en route to a 12-0 triumph on Friday evening in the fourth game of the series at Principal Park. The I-Cubs jumped on Daulton Jefferies early in the first inning, courtesy of an Alexander Canario RBI fielder's choice and a David Bote sacrifice fly. Iowa did not look back as it exploded for 12 runs on 16 hits, which tied Indianapolis' most surrendered in a game this year. Highly-touted outfielder Pete Crow-Armstrong led the Cubs with four hits, including three doubles and a home run.

DAVIS GOES FOR EXTRA: Henry Davis doubled last night to extend his current extra-base hit streak to six games dating back to a two-homer performance on May 18 vs. Toledo. That six-game streak is tied for the International League lead this season and is one of two active six-game streaks (also: I-Cub Alexander Canario). Davis has hit safely in eight of his last nine games with a .400 batting average (14-for-35), 11 runs, five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 1.057 slugging percentage and 1.545 OPS. After going 3-for-19 in his first six games, he has raised his batting average to .315 (17-for-54) in 15 games overall with Indy. Davis has also reached base safely in 14 of his 15 games with Indianapolis since May 7 and is tied with Malcom Nuñez for the second-most home runs (6) among team leaders (trailing Matt Gorski's 7).

LOCAL KID ON A HEATER: Despite going 0-for-3 with two strikeouts last night, Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., has hit the cover off the ball in his last nine games played since May 16, batting .371 (13-for-35) with 11 runs, two doubles, two triples, six home runs, 20 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage and 1.057 slugging percentage. During that stretch, he leads all of professional baseball in RBI and is tied with teammate Henry Davis for the most home runs hit and most total bases (37) in pro ball while being tied for second in extra-base hits (10), tied for second with Davis in slugging percentage and 10th in OPS (1.457).

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb singled last night to extend his current on-base streak to 25 games since April 18. During his on-base streak – which bests Nick Gonzales' 21-game streak as the longest by an Indians batter this season and is tied for the second-longest in the International League this season – he is hitting .344 (32-for-93) with 16 runs, 11 doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, a .420 on-base percentage and .915 OPS. On Wednesday, he recorded his first four-hit game since June 21, 2023, with Triple-A Salt Lake vs. Sugar Land. He has now reached base safely in 36 of 37 games this season with a .341 batting average (45-for-132), 20 runs, 12 doubles, three homers, 23 RBI, 21 walks and .928 OPS.

MALCOM GETTIN' ON: Malcom Nuñez worked a walk in three plate appearances last night, and he has now reached base safely in 21 of his last 22 games since April 24. He has hit .263 (21-for-80) with 10 runs, one double, three home runs, 10 RBI, 12 walks and a .365 on-base percentage during that stretch.

CELLY TIME: Gilberto Celestino went 2-for-3 last night to extend his hit streak to six games. Celestino has been hot as of late, reaching base safely in each of his last 11 games and 14 of 15 overall since May 3. Since that date, he owns a .345 batting average (19-for-55) with nine runs, three extra-base hits, five RBI and three stolen bases.

HELLER BALL: Reliever Ben Heller walked one and struck out the side while pitching a scoreless eighth inning last night. Since being activated from the injured list on April 21, the right-hander has recorded at least one strikeout in all 11 of his relief appearances and multiple punchouts in eight of those outings. His 17.18 K/9 rate (28k/14.2ip), 45.2% strikeout percentage (28k/62tbf) and 37.1% strikeout-to-walk percentage (28k-5bb/62tbf) are best among International League hurlers with 10 or more innings pitched this season.

SEEN BETTER DAYS: Indy's 12-0 loss last night was its worst shutout loss in the Victory Field era (July 11, 1996-present). The previous worst was 11-0, which occurred Aug. 13, 2014, at Toledo. It was also Indy's biggest margin of defeat since the club suffered a 17-1 setback on Sept. 26, 2022, at Columbus.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their six-game series against the I-Cubs – their first of three this season – at 7:08 PM ET at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa, with a chance to guarantee at least a split. The Indians went 10-14 against Iowa last season, logging a 3-9 record in two series on the road. Continuing the series for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Domingo Germán (0-1, 7.20), who has never faced Iowa after making just four appearances (two starts) in the International League with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre from 2021-22 after the I-Cubs joined the league. RHP Julio Teheran (0-4, 10.32) will counter for Iowa. He faced the Indians three times from 2011-12 with Triple-A Gwinnett (1-0, 3.32 ERA [7er/19.0ip], 8k).

THIS DATE IN 1997: After dropping Game 1 of a doubleheader at Louisville, 4-1, three Indianapolis pitchers combined to throw the first no-hitter in the Victory Field era. Pedro Martinez (5.2ip, 3bb, 3k), Felix Rodriguez (0.1ip, 1k) and Scott Service (1.0ip, 3k) each appeared in the game and rolled through seven innings. First baseman Kevin Maas hit a solo home run in the top of the seventh inning for the only run of the game, giving Service a chance to close out the historic bid. Rodriguez earned the win and improved to 3-3 on the season, and Service earned his sixth save of the year.

TODAY'S PITCHER

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his second start of the year for Indianapolis against the Iowa, today at 7:08 PM at Principal Park.

Last Outing: Germán took the bump for his first start with Indians on 5/19 as he fanned three batters across 5.0 innings to take the loss.

Against the I-Cubs: Germán has never faced Iowa.

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
