#### JUMBO SHRIMP FALL TO RED SOX 9-2

Despite an early lead courtesy of an Austin Allen home run, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp dropped Friday's series opener 9-2, to the Worcester Woo Sox in front 7,570 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Jacksonville (39-46, 8-5) got on the board first when Allen (19) notched a home run in the bottom of the second inning off starter Kyle Barraclough (4-0). Worcester added a four-spot in the top of the third and never looked back. A three-run fifth made it 7-2. The Red Sox added their two final runs in the ninth

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 31 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 53-for-131 at the plate, slashing .405/.443/.519/.962 with six doubles, three home runs, 21 RBIs and 28 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.367) and fourth in OBP (.438). Among the 267 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.7 percent). He has registered at least three hits in six of the last eight games, going 22-for-37 (.595) in that span.

#### AUSTIN POWERS

Sat., July 22

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 42 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 44-for-147 (.299/.380/.721/1.101) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 43 RBIs and 29 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season. Allen is fanning just 18.6 percent of the time in 2023.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Though Jacksonville crushed Charlotte 13-2 on Sunday, nine of Jacksonville's last 17 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 86 games played thus far in 2023, 47 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-25 (.468) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three

#### **NINTH TIME'S A CHARM!**

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. They then lost four of six at Gwinnett before splitting their series with Durham from June 28-July 3. However, by taking five of six games of their series at Charlotte, Jacksonville has finally snapped an eight-set drought without a series victory. It was the club's longest such drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

#### ON THE OFFENSIVE

Following the All-Star Break, Jacksonville continued their streak of at least five runs in 10 consecutive contests, their best such run of the season, as well as in 12 of their last 14 games. Over this 14-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 102 runs (7.3 per game), ranking third in the International League, while batting .291/.379/.498/.877, figures that respectively rank fifth, eighth, seventh and sixth. Over the season's first 73 games, Jacksonville's 347 runs (4.8 per game) ranked 19th in the 20-team circuit. The club collectively batted just .247/.331/.404/.735, which placed 18th, 20th, 18th and 20th, respectively.

#### STOCKING STUFFER

The Jumbo Shrimp welcome in the Worcester Red Sox for the second time since joining the International League in 2021. Jacksonville opened the season last year with Worcester in a six-game slugfest that saw the WooSox take five of six. The Jumbo Shrimp slugged six home runs and scored 28 runs (4.7 per game) while the WooSox walloped 13 home runs against Jacksonville pitching and scored 39 runs (6.5 per game). The club's 6.17 ERA against Worcester last year was the worst amongst 2022 IL opponents in 2022.

JAX starters have gone at least 5.2 in six of their last eight games after doing so just twice in the previous 11 games. Despite having a 5.40 ERA in the month of July, Jacksonville can attribute their winning ways to the bats. They are outscoring their opponents 76-52 in the first nine games.

#### **ABOUT DEVIN**

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9–3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

#### 2023 SEASON

#### 2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in lacksonville.

#### 2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

#### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
