WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg scored 11 runs for the second-straight night last night, beating Wilson (MIL) 11-3...3B **AVERY ORTIZ** picked up four hits and went deep twice, driving in three while scoring three runs of his own.

ON TO THE NEXT: In a game that featured nine extra-base hits, six going for home runs, it was the Syracuse Mets who fended off the first-place Rochester Red Wings 7-4 in a slugfest...2B **CAYDEN WALLACE**, LF **PHILLIP GLASSER**, and 1B **LIOVER PEGUERO** all hit home runs while four of five Red Wing relievers threw scoreless innings in the losing effort...looking to get back into the win column and even the series at a game apiece tonight, RHP **JACK CEBERT** will take the mound for his second Triple-A start...Syracuse will counter with RHP Xzavion Curry.

SEA TO SHINING CE(BERT): RHP **JACK CEBERT** will take the mound tonight for his second Triple-A start, coming off a no-decision in his debut on 8/27 vs. BUF...in the outing, the Florida native allowed three runs (1 ER) on four hits across 3.0 full innings, while striking out a pair and walking one...he crossed 100.0 innings of work in his professional career in the outing...across eight starts with Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg & Somerset (NYY) since the start of July, Cebert logs a 2.14 ERA (8 ER/33.2 IP) with 39 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP and .183 BAA.

WALL(ACE) TO WALL: 2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** extended his hitting streak to nine consecutive games with a fourth-inning solo homer that came off the bat at 109.1 MPH and traveled 375 feet and over the left field wall...he now has nine Triple-A homers since making his debut with Rochester on 7/4, and 27 overall between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg...27 homers are the second-most among all Nationals Minor Leaguers behind **TREY LIPSCOMB** (29), and T-15th most among any hitter at the Double and Triple-A levels combined this season...over the course of his nine-game streak since 8/22, which is T-3rd-longest active streak in the International League, the former Kansas City farmhand leads all of Triple-A and ranks second in Minor League Baseball (min. 25 AB) with a .485 batting average, leads MiLB in OPS (1.553), leads Triple-A (5th in MiLB) with a .553 OBP and 1.000 SLG (3rd in MiLB)...

Wallace is now one hit shy of 450 in his MiLB career, and three hits shy of 50 with the Red Wings.

RAISE A GLASS(ER): LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** went deep for the second time this season last night, a two-run shot in the seventh that carried over the right field wall...Glasser finished 2-for-4 at the plate out of the second spot in the order, earlier adding a single in the third...across 16 games played against Syracuse this season, the 26-year-old carries a .360/.459/.460 slash line with 18 total hits, most by any Red Wings hitter against the New York Mets top affiliate since Darren Baker (28) and Jack Dunn (23) in 2024...a .360 batting average is the fifth highest of any Red Wing in a single season against Syracuse (min. 50 AB) since at least 2004, and highest since Jake Noll (.363) in 2021...

The Canton, OH native now has exactly 150 RBI in his professional career since making his debut in 2023.

GAME (LI)OVER: 1B **LIOVER PEGUERO** was one of three Red Wings hitters to go deep in last night's losing effort, going 1-for-4 with a solo shot in the fourth following **CAYDEN WALLACE'S** blast...he has now homered twice in 14 games since joining the Red Wings on 8/14, surpassing his total with Lehigh Valley in 53 fewer games...he is now one homer shy of 25 at the Triple-A level in his professional career...he also extended his hitting streak to six-straight games (since 8/26) with the homer, the second-longest active streak on the team (Wallace, 9 G)...over those six games, Peguero is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with four XBH (2 HR, 2 2B), seven RBI, a .478 OBP and .800 SLG.

IF YOU LIKE PINEDA COLADAS: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** lined an eighth-inning single to left Tuesday at Syracuse, extending his on-base streak to 21 games, the longest active streak by a Red Wing...Pineda has reached safely in 28 of his first 29 Triple-A games (8/6 at SWB)...during the streak, which began on 8/7, he is batting .318 (21-for-66) with seven home runs, 15 RBI, 20 runs scored, 14 walks and a .318/.459/.667 slash line...among International League hitters with at least 60 at-bats over that span, he ranks fourth in OBP and OPS, sixth in SLG and tied for fifth in home runs...Pineda owns a .429 batting average (6-for-14) with a 1.815 OPS across four Wednesday games with Rochester coming into game two of the series tonight.
