PAPILLION, NEB. – The Omaha Storm Chasers kept within striking distance Tuesday night, but dropped the series opener to the Gwinnett Stripers Tuesday night 4-1, the first ever meeting between the two clubs.

- Four of the five total runs scored in the game came home on sacrifice flies, beginning in the first inning as the Stripers promptly jumped ahead 1-0 after a leadoff triple and sac fly two batters into the game.
- Gwinnett stayed ahead 1-0 until the seventh, as starting pitchers **Mike Mayers** and **Michael Soroka** went pitch-for-pitch into the back half of the game.
- For Omaha, Mayers held the opposition to just the one run on three hits over 6.0 innings with a pair of strikeouts, his first quality start and the second thrown by a Chasers pitcher this season.
- For Gwinnett, Soroka fired 6.0 scoreless frames, holding Omaha to four hits with five strikeouts. The Storm Chasers got onto the board as soon as the Stripers went to the bullpen, as **Angelo Castellano** plated **Logan Porter** with a sacrifice fly for the club's lone run of the game, following Porter's first of two doubles in the game.
- While **Jackson Kowar** worked out of trouble in the seventh, he surrendered one run in the eighth on a single and sac fly to give Gwinnett the lead back, then a pair of Kowar's runners inherited by **Evan Sisk** scored in the ninth for insurance.
- After a double from Porter and walk by **Freddy Fermin**, Omaha brought the tying run to the plate with one out in the bottom of the ninth but could not score any more, falling in the series opener.
- Fermin reached base in 3 of 4 plate appearances, with two singles and a walk, while designated hitter **Tyler Gentry** reached twice, with a walk and hit by pitch.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

MY OH MAYERS

Right-hander **Mike Mayers** threw the second quality start of the year for an Omaha starting pitcher last night, allowing 1 earned run on 3 hits over 6.0 innings ... but for the 3rd time in 4 starts, did not receive run support.

- A lack of run support has been a common theme for Omaha starters this year, who are receiving an average of 2.21 runs of support per game.
- Omaha hitters have provided multiple runs of support to their starting pitcher in 5 of 14 games this season and won all 5 of those games ... when providing no support or just one run of support, the team is 2-7.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER

Much of Omaha's offense this season has come in the late stages of games, with over half of the runs the team has scored this year coming between the 6th and 9th innings.

- Between the 1st and 5th innings this year, Omaha has scored 45 runs over the first five innings of games ... in contrast, the team has scored 49 runs in the last four, between the 6th and 9th.
- With the late offense comes comeback victories ... 3 of Omaha's 7 wins this season have come with trailing after the 7th inning.

HOMER HAPPY

Omaha's 24 home runs through the first 14 games of this season have combined to account for 40 runs, or 42.6% of the team's total scoring (94 runs scored).

- 24 homers are tied for the 3rd-most of any International League team and tied for the 6th-most in all of the Minor Leagues.
- Logan Porter** and **Nick Loftin**'s 4 home runs lead the Storm Chasers, are tied 11th in the league ... Porter has not homered since Friday, April 7 vs. Toledo, in his last 23 plate appearances.
- After not homering on Opening Day (3/31 @ Indianapolis), Omaha hit at least one home run in 11 straight games (4/1 to 4/13), the longest streak in the Minors this year.
- Neither Omaha or Gwinnett homered in yesterday's game, the first game Omaha has played this year without a home run on either side ... generally considered a hitter-friendly stadium, only 6 of 74 games played at Werner Park last season saw neither team hit a home run.

SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor has led off all 14 games this season for the Omaha Storm Chasers and gone 20-for-64 at the plate, with 7 extra-base hits and 14 runs batted in.

- Taylor has collected multiple hits in 7 different games this season, including each of the first 4, with hits in 12 of the 14 games he's played.
- His 20 hits rank tied 6th in the International League, while and 14 runs batted are tied 9th in the league and he ranks tied 11th with 32 total bases.



MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHOLE • 23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • 59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • 33

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.
