STARTING PITCHING PIPELINE: Over three games in this week's series, Somerset starters Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz (NYY No. 6 prospect), Trystan Vrieling (NYY No. 24 prospect) and Carlos Lagrange (NYY No. 2 prospect) have combined on a 1.62 ERA (3 ER / 16.2 IP) with 10 H, 6 BB and 20 K. Yankees No. 13 prospect Brock Selvidge takes the mound on Friday.

ROAD RAGE: Each of the first six games of Somerset's nine-game road trip have been decided by three runs or less, while four games have been decided by one run. The Patriots had lost each of their first three one-run games of the road trip, all consecutively from 7/19-22. During the first half of the season, the Patriots were 3-10 in one-run games. Since the start of the second half, they are 5-4 in one-run games. In the second half of the season, 13/24 games the Patriots have played have been decided by three runs or less.

SECOND HALF PATS: Brendan Jones' game-winning home run in the ninth inning on Thursday marked Somerset's second go-ahead home run in the ninth inning or later this season (5/16 vs. POR, Dylan Jasso walk-off HR). With the Patriots trailing 3-1 at the start of the inning, the win marked Somerset's third of the season when trailing after eight innings. Entering July 4, the Patriots were 0-35 this season when trailing entering the ninth inning. Since that day the Patriots have won three games when trailing entering the ninth inning, going 3-3 over their last six such games.

JONES JAMMING IN JULY: Over Brendan Jones' last 12 games, dating back to 7/8 vs. NH, he is 12-for-42 (.286/.400/.667) with 9 R, 7 XBH (2 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR), 12 RBI, 8 BB, 6 SB and a 1.067 OPS. This season, Jones ranks second among Yankee minor leaguers in SB (33), fourth in BB (49), fifth in R (55), tied for sixth in RBI (51) and eighth in TB (121).

ROC AND ROLL: Since Roc Riggio debuted with Somerset on 6/3 @BNG, he ranks among the Eastern League leaders with 9 HR (2nd), 19 XBH (T-2nd), .526 SLG (4th), 71 TB (T-4th), 25 RBI (T-4th), 23 R (T-6th) and .853 OPS (8th).

LIVIN' AVINA LOCA: During the month of July, Jace Avina ranks among the Yankees' minor league leaders with 11 BB (T-2nd), .438 OBP (3rd), 6 HR (T-3rd), 14 R (T-3rd), .322 AVG (4th), .644 SLG (4th), 1.082 OPS (4th), 14 RBI (4th), 19 H (T-4th) and 38 TB (5th).

HOUSE OF HORRORS: In four seasons as the Yankees' Double-A affiliate (including the playoffs), the Somerset Patriots are 8-15 all-time against the SeaWolves at UPMC Park in Erie, where they have been outscored 80-116 (-36 run differential). Somerset's all-time regular season record against Erie is 21-29.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Broke camp on Somerset's 60-day IL. Following three rehab starts during May between the FCL Yankees and Single-A Tampa, Selvidge was reinstated off the IL on 6/7.

Started for the Yankees in their inaugural Spring Breakout game on 3/16 vs. TOR and was named MLB Pipeline All-Spring Breakout First-Team for going 4 IP, H, BB, 8 K. Broke camp with Somerset and made 16 starts, before being shut down in July due to a season-ending injury. Overall during the season with Somerset, Selvidge went 7-6 with a 4.25 ERA and 83 K to 40 BB over 84.2 IP. Selvidge was selected to represent Yankees in MLB All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, alongside Spencer Jones, but did not attend due to his injury.

Began with Tampa: 15 appearances (14 GS), 3.38 ERA with 91 K, 21 BB in 77.1 IP. On 7/18, was assigned to HV and ended regular season with 9 GS, going 4-1 with a 3.58 ERA and 46 K and 14 BB in 50.1 IP. Postseason: Selig was the WP for Hudson Valley in the team's decisive third game of the SAL Division Series on 9/15/23. Following the season was named an MiLB.com Yankees Organization All-Star // Florida State League All-Star

Spent all of 2022 with the FCL Yankees: in 11 games (9 GS), going 3-1 with a 2.95 ERA and 53 K (T-5th in FCL) in the regular season. Helped the Yankees to win the 2022 FCL Championship, including a post-season start vs. the FCL Rays on 8/26/22 in which Selvidge began the game with three hitless IP.

Made pro debut in 3 appearances (2 GS) in September for the FCL Yankees, going 3.2 total IP and allowing 1 ER with 4 K and 2 H.

Full name is Joshua Brock Selvidge. Attended Hamilton High School (Chandler, AZ), the same school as 2019 NL MVP Cody Bellinger, Ravens LB Terrell Suggs. During his senior year he went 5-2 with a 2.41 ERA in 11 appearances as a pitcher and hit .304 with 17 R, 6 HR and 21 RBI in 23 games as a batter. His Junior year he was the 2020 Arizona High School Baseball Player of the Year. Ranked by Perfect Game as the top pitcher in AZ and the No. 2 overall prospect in AZ. Committed to play college baseball at LSU prior to being drafted by the Yankees. Born in Carrollton, TX, spent his youth in Castle Rock, CO, went to HS in Chandler, AZ.

Selected by the Yankees in the 3rd round of the 2021 MLB Draft (No. 92), his \$1.5 Million signing bonus was T-60th highest in Draft, he was 92nd pick. Higher signing bonus than NYY 2nd round pick Brendan Beck.
