Exhibition Series: The Delmarva Shorebirds take the field for the first time at Perdue Stadium in an exhibition against the Baltimore Orioles' Double-A affiliate, the Chesapeake Baysox. The series will now consist of just one game instead of the originally scheduled two, after Friday's contest was canceled due to bad weather.

Leader of the Flock: Adonis Smith takes over as the skipper for the Shorebirds in 2026 after Collin Woody, their manager for the last two seasons, was promoted to High-A Frederick to assume the same role. Smith joins Delmarva as their 19th manager in team history after spending last season on Aberdeen's coaching staff. This is Smith's second year in the Orioles' organization, and he previously spent time in the MLB Draft League with the Trenton Thunder and Williamsport Crosscutters. He is joined by Pitching Coach **Bailey Vuylsteke**, Hitting Coach **Collin McBride**, and Fundamentals Coach **Aritz Garcia Goñi**, all in their first season with the team, while **Casey Buckley** returns for his second year as the Development Coach.

Roster Makeup: The Shorebirds' preliminary roster for the 2026 season includes 29 players: 19 of whom appeared in at least one game for the team last season, 15 signed as international free agents, and 9 were drafted by the Orioles. The roster is highlighted by right-handed pitcher **Esteban Mejia**, who debuted for the Shorebirds on August 3 last season and made three starts for Delmarva during the final stretch. He enters 2026 as the third-best pitching prospect in the Orioles' organization and was a Postseason All-Star for the FCL Orioles in 2025. He is joined by fellow top-30 prospect, outfielder **Jordan Sanchez**, who played only four games with Delmarva in 2025, but made a quick impact by hitting two home runs in the final game of the regular season on September 6 against Lynchburg. He was the only Shorebird to hit two home runs in a game in 2025. Sanchez was named the MVP of the Florida Complex League last season, posting a .293 batting average with 5 home runs, 45 RBIs, 24 extra-base hits, and an OPS of .950 across 54 games.

Special K: Delmarva's pitching staff aims to carry their momentum from the end of the 2025 season, when they finished with the most strikeouts as a team in the Carolina League. The staff totaled 1299 strikeouts (averaging 9.9 per game), which was 58 more than the next closest team, Hickory. The Shorebirds' staff saved their best for the second half of the season, where they struck out 693 batters for a league-leading average of 11.18 per nine innings. Right-handed pitchers **Yeiber Cartaya** and **Chase Allsup** tied for the team lead with 96 strikeouts each, ranking sixth among all Carolina League pitchers.

Kids From the Tar Heel State: The Shorebirds' break camp roster includes three players who played high school baseball in North Carolina. INF **Cobb Hightower**, INF **DJ Layton**, and OF **Braylon Whitaker** were the only three high school players from North Carolina to sign with professional teams in the 2024 draft class, with Layton and Whitaker being selected by the Orioles in the 6th and 19th rounds, respectively. Hightower was picked in the 3rd round by the Padres and was acquired by Baltimore during last year's trade deadline.

About the Baysox: The Shorebirds will host the Chesapeake Baysox at Perdue Stadium, where they will face several top Orioles prospects, including some who have previously worn a Delmarva uniform. Chesapeake's break camp roster features 21 former Shorebirds, with five of their six top 30 Orioles prospects having played for Delmarva in the past. Notable players include LHP **Luis De León**, ranked as Baltimore's 3rd best prospect by MLB.com, and INF **Aron Estrada**, who broke out with the Shorebirds in 2024 and is now the No. 8 prospect for the Orioles.

TODAY'S STARTER: Right-hander Esteban Mejia draws the start for Delmarva in their exhibition contest against the Chesapeake Baysox.

TOP PROSPECT: Esteban Mejia is currently the No. 7 prospect for the Baltimore Orioles, according to both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. He is the third-best pitching prospect in the organization, behind only RHP Trey Gibson (AAA) and LHP Luis De León (AA).

2025: Mejia spent most of the 2025 season in the Florida Complex League, where he made 11 starts, posting an ERA of 2.45 over 40.1 innings with 53 strikeouts and 25 walks. His impressive performance in the FCL earned him honors as a Postseason All-Star and a Rookie All-Star by Baseball America, while also establishing him as one of the top prospects in the Orioles system. He was promoted to Delmarva in August and made three starts there, including a 4.1-inning appearance on August 10, during which he struck out seven batters while allowing one run on a hit.

2024: Made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League, where he made ten starts, pitching 27.2 innings, striking out 44 batters, issuing 15 walks, and posting an ERA of 3.25. Opposing batters hit just .182 against him.
