PAPILLION, NEB. – A five-run second inning helped the Omaha Storm Chasers to a 6-5 win over the Columbus Clippers Friday at Werner Park.

- ❑ The Chasers struck for the first runs of the game in the bottom of the 2nd inning as **Nick Pratto** walked and **Devinn Mann** singled to put two on for **Brian O'Keefe**, who homered to right center field to take an early 3-0 Chaser lead ... **Tyler Gentry** and **Cam Devanney** followed with back-to-back doubles, then Devanney moved to third base on a wild pitch and scored on an **Austin Nola** ground for a 5-0 lead.
- ❑ **Anthony Veneziano** started the bullpen game for Omaha and retired the first five batters he faced and 8 of his first 9 before running into trouble in the top of the 3rd inning ... a single and two walks loaded the bases in the top of the 3rd, but **Jonah Dipoto** replaced Veneziano and stranded the bases loaded to keep the Clippers off the board.
- ❑ An error, single and two-run triple for Columbus in the top of 4th inning led to a pair of unearned runs for Dipoto, bringing the score to 5-2 in favor of the Chasers, but Dipoto struck out two over 1.1 innings of work.
- ❑ **Walter Pennington** worked a scoreless 5th inning behind Dipoto and got the first two outs of the 6th before four straight walks ended his day and brought home another run for the Clippers to move the score to 5-3, still in Omaha's favor.
- ❑ **Dan Altavilla** stranded the bases loaded in the sixth behind Pennington and pitched a scoreless seventh before handing the ball off to **Steven Cruz** for the top of the 8th inning ... Cruz got the first two outs of the eighth before surrendering a game-tying two-run homer to José Tena as Columbus tied the score at 5-5.
- ❑ After a five-run 2nd inning, the Chasers were held quiet in five straight innings as they mustered only one hit in that duration and had a stretch of 12 in a row retired from the second through the fifth ... in the bottom of the 8th inning, Omaha retook the lead 6-5 as Mann singled to left field and brought Loftin home from second base for a 6-5 advantage.
- ❑ **Will Klein** came in for the 9th inning and retired the side in order to secure his seventh save of the season and drive home the Storm Chasers' third straight win.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

- ❑ Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, with a 31-15 record (.674 winning percentage), a season-high 16 games over .500.
- ❑ Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (NYY Triple-A) sits a half game behind Omaha in the International League standings, at 32-17 and a .653 winning percentage.
- ❑ 17 wins in the month of May is tied for the most in Minor League Baseball, with the 17-4 Cedar Rapids Kernels (Minnesota High-A)
- ❑ Last year, Omaha did not win its 30th game until June 14, what was a 6-1 win over Columbus in the team's 62nd game of the year and the 7th game of an 11-game winning streak ... this year, Omaha's 30th win came in its 45th game, 17 games sooner.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- ❑ Omaha has won 4 straight series and 17 of its last 21 games... 15 of those 21 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 12 of the team's 17 wins in this stretch.
- ❑ After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 10 of the last 15 wins have had a save awarded ... **Will Klein** has 4 saves in that span, while **Walter Pennington** and **Sam Long** have 2 saves each.
- ❑ In total, 32 of Omaha's 46 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (70%), including 12 of 15 losses this season.

COMEBACK KINGS

- ❑ Two of Omaha's three wins this week have been comeback victories, something the team has become accustomed to this year.
- ❑ The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in 14 of their 31 wins this season (45%), including 7 of 17 wins in the month of May and 2 of this week's 3 wins.
- ❑ 4 times, Omaha has overcome a 4-run deficit to go on and win the game and trailed for as much as half the game (4.5 innings) but still won 8 times.
- ❑ Last year, the Chasers had 33 comeback wins representing nearly half (49%) of the team's 67 total victories.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

- ❑ Omaha has outscored its opponents 282 to 215 this season, a +67 run differential.
- ❑ A +67 run differential ranks as not just best in the International League, but tied with Oklahoma City (Dodgers AAA) for the top mark at the Triple-A level and tied 3rd in Minor League Baseball ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +106 (288 to 182).
- ❑ Omaha has had a positive run differential after 39 of 46 games this year, including 37 straight games, since April 9 ... last year, the Chasers only had a positive differential after 28 of the team's 145 games and never more than 15 days in a row.

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

- ❑ Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.
- ❑ When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 16-3 record, compared to 14-13 when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- ❑ When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 21-4, while the team is just 10-12 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starter.

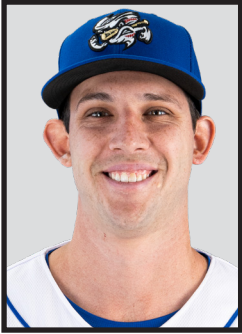

TODAY'S START

- Lynch is making his 11th overall appearance, 10th overall start and 9th Omaha start this season ... after 6 starts in Triple-A, he was called up to Kansas City on May 5 and appeared in 2 games (1 start) before being optioned back to Omaha May 10. Has improved his walk rate in each of his first three seasons in the Majors since debuting in 2021, lowering his BB% from 10.0% in 2021 to 8.7% in 2022 and 7.2% in 2023 ... walk rate in Triple-A this year is 7.1% (12 walks in 169 batters faced). Added the 'IV' to his surname before his July 18, 2023 start vs. Detroit to honor his father, Daniel Lynch III, and grandfather, Daniel Lynch II.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, MAY 19 @ ST. PAUL

After lasting just 4.0 innings in the opening game of the series, compiled his best/longest start of the season with a quality start ... became the first Omaha pitcher this year to pitch into the 7th inning ... two runners that scored in the second inning both reached on errors, two unearned runs for Lynch were the only runs he allowed ... after the pair of 2-out singles, retired 13 in a row through the end of the 6th inning ... a double and hit batter opened the 7th inning, but a double play got him two outs and ended his start.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 5 Cactus League games (3 starts) and went 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER in 13.0 IP), with 9 strikeouts ... held opponents to a .196 average (9-for-46) ... optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20.
