**LAST OUTING:** Gasser worked five innings against Norfolk in his last start, dealing with a bit of traffic (6 H, 3 BB) but allowing just two earned runs. The southpaw did not factor into the decision of Nashville's 5-3 loss.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Gasser has one career start against the Bulls, which came on May 19 of this season. He won that start, allowing two earned runs in 6.2 innings (2.69 ERA) and striking out eight.
