TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game set with Bowie on Tuesday night. Altoona has won 12-of-20 against the Baysox this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Jase Bowen hit a walk-off three-run homer to lead Altoona to a 4-2 win on Thursday night.

SEND US HOME: The Curve picked up their fifth walk-off win of the season on Thursday, August 15 against Bowie when outfielder Jase Bowen hit a three-run homer with 2 outs and 2 strikes in the bottom of the ninth inning. Bowen has homered three times in his last 10 games and is batting .273 since July 30.

FATHER ABRAHAN: Catcher Abrahan Gutierrez has caught fire in August. Gutierrez has picked up a hit in 8 straight games since August 2, during which he's batting: .333/.351/.417 with 1 2B, 1 3B, 6 RBI. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 27-of-36 games played with Altoona this year.

PROVIDING RELIEF: Altoona's bullpen has had a revolving door of talent this year, though of late Cy Nielson and Emmanuel Chapman have performed the best. Nielson has struck out 15 batters in 9.0 innings since his call-up from Greensboro and Emmanuel Chapman has a 1.78 ERA (35.1 IP / 7 ER), 39 strikeouts and a .139 batting average against in his last 14 appearances (3 starts).

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Entering play on Friday, August 16, infielder Kervin Pichardo is hitting .359/.423/.641/1.064 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR and 13 RBI during a 17-game on-base streak. Pichardo's streak is the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League and recorded his third career 5-RBI game on Sunday, August 11 at Portland.

SOME KNOCKS: Altoona has collectively built a solid stretch of offense entering the August Dog Days. The Curve's 146 hits and .280 batting average in their last 15 games are 2nd among all Double-A teams. Altoona has recorded at least 8 hits in 9-of-15 games since July 30 during which they've recorded a 6-9 record.

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 33 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .423 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 3rd in BA (.307), 3rd in OBP (.412), T-5th in 3B (3) and T-5th in SB (14).

THIS IS NOT A CIMULATION: First baseman Nick Cimillo has reached base safely in 14-of-16 games since July 30. During the stretch, he hit .281/.388/.386/.774 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 10 BB and 1-1 SB. Cimillo ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers in HR (19), 3rd in RBI (58) and 3rd in OPS (.949) among players who have taken 150 MiLB PA's this year.

GENERATION Z: Since July 23 (17 games) Tsung-Che Cheng has recorded a .395 on-base percentage. 10 times in his last 17 games, Cheng has reached base safely in a game twice. Cheng swatted Altoona's third Grand Slam of the season on Wednesday, August 7 at Portland.

THE MEN OF THE BAY: Roberto Mercado leads the Baysox after two seasons managing the Orioles High-A affiliate in Aberdeen. Mercado led the Ironbirds to a playoff appearance in 2022 and took home the organization's Cal Ripken Sr. Award given to the minor league instructor with the most dramatic impact during the season. The typically loaded Baysox are a bit light in the prospect department this year, but OF Dylan Beavers, C/DH Samuel Basallo and OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. Runs Scored..... highlight the position player group.

THE FIRST TO PULL ON THEIR SOX: Trace Bright matches the bright colors on the jerseys with his presence on the mound for Bowie on Friday night. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 4.15 ERA against the Curve in 4 starts this season. Bright is 1 of 21 pitchers this season to lose 10 games this year, he is 1 of 3 to not have yet earned a win this year (Ernesto Mercedes, St. Lucie - NYM and Tanner McDougle, Carolina - CWS). Bright was Baltimore's 5th rounder in 2022 out of Auburn and is known for working at a lightning-quick pace on the mound. Bright hails from Mongomery, Ala. and attended Trinity Prebyterian high school where he was one of the most decorated amateurs in the state.

Features a four-seam fastball, slider and change-up

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 6th round in 2019 out of Vanderbilt... Traded to the Pirates in the 3rt earn deal between San Diego, the New York Mets and Pirates that netted RHP David Bednar, LHP Omar Cruz, OF Hudson Head and C Endy Rodriguez that sent RHP Joe Musgrove to San Diego and LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego to New York...

CURVE CUTS: Drake Robert Fellows... Went 13-2 with a 4.09 ERA in his final season for the NCAA Champion Vanderbilt Commodores Majored in sociology at Vandy... At the time of the draft MLB Pipeline wrote: "His pitches may be better, but Fellows hasn't harnessed them as well as he had previously. He has been hit harder and battled his control more than in his first two seasons. He'll need to regain his previous command to reach his ceiling as a No. 4 starter, but teams do value his competitiveness and long track record of success in the Southeastern Conference"... Was diagnosed with anaplastic large cell lymphoma in the summer of 2019 after winning the National Championship with Vanderbilt, was declared cancer-free after treatments that summer and fall... Underwent Tommy John surgery in August of 2021 and missed the entire 2022 season and much of 2023... Attended Joliet Catholic Academy in Joliet, Ind... Grew up on the south side of Chicago competing with Pirates OF Jack Suwinski and Guardians INF Owen Miller... Was ranked as Perfect Game's top pitcher in the state of Indiana in their 2016 High School class... Son of Robert and Annie Fellows, has two brothers, Carter and Jaden... Signed with the Padres for a bonus of \$260,000, slightly under the slot recommen-dation of \$289,000... Shared a clubhouse with several future major leaguers at Vandy, including RHP Kyle Wright '17 (Braves/Royals), C Jason Delay '17 (Pirates), JJ Bleday '19 (Athletics) and RHP Collin Snider '17 (Royals/Mariners) as well as RHP Kumar Rocker... Claims that he can solve a rubix cube... Listed his favorite players at age 10 as Carlos Zambrano and David Ortiz...
