SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

NOW THAT'S A WWWWWWWINNING STREAK: With a win on Wednesday night, the Shuckers won their ninth straight game, one away from tying the franchise record... The record was originally set at 10 straight wins between July 12-22, 2019 and tied again later in the year from August 5-16, 2019... Over the nine-game win streak, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 58-25 [+33] and have scored at least five runs in seven of the nine games.

The Shuckers also enter today with a nine-game road winning streak, the longest in franchise history... Since August 15, the start of the Shuckers' series against the M-Braves, Biloxi has won 13 of their last 14 road games.

A NEW BEST: INF/OF Isaac Collins set a new career-high with four RBI on Wednesday, breaking his previous high of three that he set and tied eight times... Collins previously tied his career-high on July 16 with three RBI during a 3-4 day against the Rocket City Trash Pandas at MGM Park.

ONE AWAY FROM MORE HISTORY: OF Jackson Chourio enters today with 21 home runs and 39 stolen bases, one stolen base away from becoming the first Double-A player since at least 2005 to record a 20/40 season and the 12th player in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat since 2005.

Since the All-Star Break (July 14), Chourio is among the Southern League leaders in average (2nd, .326), stolen bases (3rd, 16), home runs (T-4th, 10), OPS (6th, .939) and on-base percentage (10th, .381).

WALKING THE WALK: Entering today, 1B/C Wes Clarke has reached base in 22 consecutive games, the longest active streak in both the Southern League and Double-A... During the 22-game streak, Clarke owns a .459 on-base percentage and has drawn a walk in 23% of his plate appearances... Clarke has drawn at least one walk in 17 of his last 22 games.

<u>BEST IN CLASS</u>: Baseball-America released their Double-A Best Tools and Prospects Awards on Tuesday, as voted on by league managers... The Shuckers took home several Southern League honors, including; **OF Jackson Chourio** - Best Batting Prospect and Most Exciting Player, **INF Tyler Black** - Best Strike-Zone Judgment and **RHP Jacob Misiorowski** - Rest Fasthall

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division

The Shuckers are a half-game behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with 10 games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ [8-5, 2.75]</u>: RHP Carlos Rodriguez is set to make his 24th start of the year, and his first since setting a new career-high with 105 pitches on September 1 at Tennessee... Entering today, Rodriguez leads all Double-A pitchers in ERA (2.75) and average (.181) and is among the leaders in strikeouts (5th, 141) and WHIP (5th, 1.10).
