TIME AWAY: The Renegades are in Wilmington for an eight-game series, as DIVISION RACE: The South Atlantic League North division continues to be very a two-week road trip to Aberdeen and Wilmington, Hudson Valley hosted Jersey Shore. Following six games last week at Maimonides Park in Brooklyn, Hudson Valley played six games vs. Aberdeen in Wappingers Falls last week. These eight games at Wilmington concludes a period where Hudson Valley plays four out of six series away from Heritage Financial Park.

HE WENT TO JARED: Jared Serna continues to display his power in recent games, homering for the South Atlantic-leading 11th time this season on Tuesday. Last Wednesday vs. Aberdeen, the 22-year-old launched two home runs, a grand slam and a three-run shot, driving in seven runs. His seven RBIs tied the Renegades single-game franchise record, becoming the first Renegade to record seven RBIs since Aaron Palensky on April 26th, 2023. After three hits and two RBIs on Wednesday, Serna ranks second in the SAL in RBIs with 43, and is tied for second with 38 runs scored. Finshing May with 29 RBIs, Serna set a new the South Atlantic League. Renegades record for RBIs in a month.

Rafael Flores launched his second home run of the series in the third, continuing to stay very hot at the plate. In Wednesday's matchup, Jared Serna and Flores thrived yet again with two RBIs apiece. On Tuesday, eight Renegades had at least one hit in the game, and the team launched four home runs in a 10-2 victory. Home runs from Serna, Flores, Tyler Hardman, and Garrett Martin propelled the Renegades to a win.

NY SLUGGERS: The Renegades currently have the second-highest team OPS mark in High-A. With 98 doubles this season, only Everett (A+, SEA) has more doubles than Hudson Valley in High-A. Four Renegades have 10 or more doubles, and eight players have five or more two-baggers.

DAILY DOUBLE: Hudson Valley split its first of two doubleheaders with Wilmington on Thursday, after the second half of Wednesday's doubleheader was postponed due to rain and game one was called in the seventh inning. It was the third doubleheader played by the club this season, and the first since April 14 at Rome. The Renegades have split each of their two doubleheaders this year. Since the start of the 2024 season, the Renegades are just 9-17 (.346) in doubleheader Atlantic League, despite the Renegades playing less games than other teams, games, sweeping one, being swept five times and splitting seven. Hudson Valley and his batting average is third. His OPS ranks seventh in the SAL. has gone 12 straight doubleheaders without a sweep.

Hudson Valley faces off against the Blue Rocks 30 times this season, the most of any teams in 2024. In their final 83 games of the season, the Renegades will play the Blue Rocks 26 times.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Cam Schlittler continued his strong pitching on Sunday DEFENSIVE ISSUES: The Renegades have the most errors in High-A and sixth-afternoon vs. the IronBirds, allowing just three hits in five innings and striking most in MiLB, and their .960 fielding percentage is fifth-worst in the minors. After out six. He did not allow a hit until the fifth inning. His performance continues a great run of success in Sunday games. In six Sunday starts, Schlittler has allowed just seven earned runs in 31.2 innings, good for a 2.04 ERA. His ERA now sits at 2.17 this season through nine starts, the second-best mark in the South Atlantic League, while his 0.94 WHIP is third.

The bullpen has only been charged with thirteen earned runs in its last 45.1 frames, good for a 2.59 ERA. In the last eight games, Hudson Valley's pen has allowed just six earned runs in 271 innings. In his last five appearances, Cole Ayers has not allowed an earned run in 12 innings. His 19 appearances lead

OFFENSIVE ASSISTANCE: Rafael Flores has been one of the best hitters in CONSISTENCY: Baron Stuart continued his strong stretch of pitching on the South Atlantic League since being reinstated off the IL on May 10. > STELLAR STARTERS: Starting pitching continues to be excellent for the Renegades. In the team's last nine games, seven of nine starters have gone at least five innings. All nine starters have also allowed three earned runs or less in their outings. On Tuesday vs. Wilmington, Jackson Fristoe tossed a career-high six innings, allowing just two hits and no runs.

LIMITING HITS: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 345 hits through 52 games. The Renegades have allowed the third-fewest hits in MiLB, three more than Modesto (A, SEA) and four more than Carolina (MIL, A). Incredibly, Lansing in the South Atlantic League just behind Greensboro, and have the fourth-best (OAK, A+) has allowed a staggering 483 hits through 54 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

> OLD RELIABLE: Jesus Rodríguez has been tremendous in 2024, reaching base safely in 43 of his first 49 games. Over his last 32 games, Rodríguez is hitting .345 with 16 extra-base hits, 18 RBIs, a .555 slugging percentage, and a .988 OPS. On the season, the Renegades infielder is currently batting .326 with 25 RBIs, 12 doubles and a .908 OPS. He already has eighteen multi-hit games, the most on the team. On Wednesday vs. Wilmington, Rodríguez had an RBI triple, two walks, and three runs scored. His 58 hits are tied for the most in the South

MIDWEST REINFORCEMENTS: Jace Avina debuted with the Renegades on BACK TO FRAWLEY: The Renegades and Blue Rocks are playing their second April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. The 20-year-old has quickly made a big impact for the Renegades. Avina is hitting .297 (46-for 155) with 15 doubles, 26 RBIs, 24 runs scored and a .878 OPS in 40 games. His 15 doubles are the most in the South Atlantic League. On Thursday night vs. Aberdeen, Avina was 3-for-4 with a sacrifice fly and two RBIs in a 11-1 Renegades win.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: Baseball America - NYY #10; MLB Pipeline - NYY #12

LAST TIME OUT: Carr had his best start of the season last Friday against the Aberdeen IronBirds, allowing three runs on four hits and three walks across 5.2 innings while striking out five. The southpaw faced the minimum through five innings thanks to a caught stealing, a pickoff and a double play, but in the sixth the Birds got one run against him while he was in, and two more bequeathed runners came in to score in the frame against Luis Arejula to tie the game a 3-3 and take Carr out of line for his first professional win.

INJURIES IN SAN DIEGO: Carr spent two years playing at the University of San Diego before transferring to Palomar for 2023. During that time he struggled with injuries including Tommy John surgery in October 2020, and a broken hand and torn right shoulder labrum in 2022. Carr to the San Diego Union-Tribune: "I struggled with injuries and school at USD. And they were related. As I fought my way through the injuries, I let my schoolwork slip. And you can't do that in college. You have to stay on top of your classes. I didn't do that. I loved the coaches and players at USD. [USD head coach] Brock Ungricht is one of the really good guys, my favorite all-time coach. I felt I let him down."

POWER PITCHING: Carr opened eyes at Palomar with a fastball that touches 97 mph, a sharp-breaking slider and a mid-80s power changeup. Scouts registered his velocity as continuing to sit at 95 late into games. Carr: "The biggest thing for me is that I'm finally healthy ... That hasn't always been the case. I've always been able to throw hard, but now as I've matured, I've been able to keep my stuff late into games."

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Kyle Isiah Carr.
- Pitched one season at Palomar College (2023) after spending two seasons at the University of San Diego (2021-22).
- Underwent Tommy John surgery in October 2020 after graduating from high school, also broke his hand in February 2022 while at San Diego, then tore his right (non-pitching) labrum in March 2022 while swinging a bat.
- Had committed to play at TCU following his graduation from Palomar, but signed with the Yankees instead. TCU had
 recruited him out of high school, but he decided to stay home in Southern California. When he transferred to Palomar,
 TCU was one of the first schools to reach out.
- Was named ABCA West Region Pitcher of the Year and the ABCA Pitcher of the Year after going 12-1 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER) in 15 games (14 starts) for the Palomar Comets in 2023.
- At San Diego was a two-way player who mostly pitched, going 2-for-14 at the bat in 2022.
- Graduated from San Marcos HS in 2020, where as a two-way player he hit over .400 in his last two seasons.
