FROM THE CROWS NEST

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION: The Bradenton Marauders fell 5-1 to the Lakeland Flying Tigers Thursday night. Lakeland provided the majority of their damage in the top of the second when they pushed across four runs on three hits and two walks. The Marauders lone lone came on an RBI single off the bat of **Braylon Bishop**, who now has driven in six runs over the previous two nights. Lakeland now leads the series 2-1 and the season series 5-4.

TEJADA TAKES THE BALL: Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will make the start for the Marauders tonight, marking his seventh of the season. Tejada's last start came on Saturday at Clearwater, where he allowed three earned runs over 2.2 innings. He mixes in a sinker, slider, changeup and splitter. His fastball sits at 90-92 miles per hour and topped out at 94.4 last week.

RECAPPING CLEARWATER: The Marauders dropped two of three over the weekend at the Clearwater Threshers. They took game one 7-2 after launching three homers. On Sunday, the Marauders dropped a heartbreaker 2-1 in the eleven innings. Bradenton held a 1-0 lead with two outs in the ninth, but Clearwater rallied, securing the tying run on a bases-loaded walk and the winning run two innings later on a walk-off single. Throughout the weekend, **Eddy Rodriguez** finished with two homers and reached base six times. Bradenton's pitching was strong, allowing nine runs over the weekend's three games, while limiting Threshers hitters to a .208 average.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS: The Lakeland Flying Tigers come to town, becoming the first opponent the Marauders will see for a second time this year. The two previously split their six-game series two weeks ago in Lakeland, with Bradenton finishing strong by taking three of the last four. Lakeland currently sits tied for first place in the FSL West with Dunedin and Clearwater. Since their series with Bradenton, they're a league best 5-1. Over the six-game stretch, they're posted a 1.50 team ERA and have allowed just one homer. This series also features the two top highschool selections in last year's draft in Bryce Rainer and Konnor Griffin.

GETTING IT DONE ON THE BUMP: Over their last 14 starts entering the series, the Marauders rotation has dominated. Jonawel Valdez (2), Clevari Tejada (2), Carlos Castillo (2), Matt Ager (3), Peyton Stumbo (3), Victor Cabreja and Dauri Moreta have combined for a 3.32 ERA over 43.1 innings of work. Over that stretch, they've allowed just three home runs, 19 walks, and limited opponents to a .245 batting average. The only Florida State staffs ahead of them include Palm Beach (1.59 ERA), and St. Lucie (2.18 ERA).

FINISHING APRIL STRONG: Despite a slow start to the month and a 9-14 finish, the Marauders generated momentum at the end of the month. They took four of their last six games, outscoring opponents 33-25. During that stretch, Bradenton scored 33 runs (5.5 R/G) and produced a .713 OPS - both the second best in the FSL. Their six homers and 55 hits were the most in the league during that span. As a pitching staff, they also limited opposing hitters to 4.1 runs per game. Last May, Bradenton followed a 5-17 April with a 16-10 May, their winningist month during the 2024 season, which featured a franchise-best 11 game winning streak.

TEENAGE TITAN: MLB.com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick **Konnor Griffin** finshed the week strong. Since he turned 19 on 4/24, he is 12-for-40 (.300), with three home runs, seven RBI and seven extra-base-hits (9 GP). Moreover, he has registered elite-level exit velocities early on in his first pro season. Of his first 27 hits this year, 13 have left the bat at over 100 mph including a 114.2 mph single versus Palm Beach on 4/8. The top mark is the highest recorded by a Single-A player this season and would place in the top 50 in all of MLB. The only players to hit a ball harder at the big-league level this season include: Riley Greene, Pete Alonso, **Oneil Cruz**, Aaron Judge, Ketel Marte, Ryan Mountcastle, Vladamir Guerrero Jr., and Kyle Schwarber among others. Moreover, is second in the FSL league in stolen bases with 11.

MAKING HISTORY: Pirates No. 30 ranked prospect **David Matoma** was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on 4/26, and made his team debut tossing 1.1 innings while allowing one earned run with one punchout. The 19-year-old right hander was born in Kasana, Uganda. If he makes it to the big leagues, he would become the first player from Uganda and second from Africa (Gift Ngoepe). On Saturday, he featured a fastball that sat between 96-98 miles per hour and touched 99 multiple times. Last year, he reached 101 mph in an FCL game. In 24 prior outings before 2025, Matoma allowed just two earned runs over 38.2 innings. Over that stretch, he fanned 42 and walked 17.

ANOTHER FIRST: After starting starting 11 games at shortstop and two as DH to begin the year, top prospect Konnor Griffin made his season debut in centerfield on Wednesday night at Lakeland. The start marked his first "technical" pro-start in the outfield, but the 18-year-old did appear in eight big-league Spring Training games for Pittsburgh, all in center. Griffin always played outfield during his amateur career, and started playing shortstop in 9th grade. He is poised to cover plenty of ground in the outfield, as his quickest sprint speed this season registered at 30.8 feet per second, one of the fastest in all of Single-A.
