RIDERS TAKE TIGHT OPENER IN ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were unable to overcome a late surge by the Arkansas Travelers on Wednesday, falling 6-2 at Dickey-Stephens Park. Frisco (18-22) took a one-run lead on two occasions but Arkansas (26-15) canceled out both leads in the bottom half of each inning. The Travelers scored four runs in the bottom of the sixth to take their first and only lead of the game. **Ryan Garcia** delivered another strong start for Frisco, posting his second-consecutive game with just one earned run. He struck out a season-high eight batters and gave up just two hits. Garcia allowed a double to the first batter of the game on a pop-up that was lost in the sky. Garcia then did not allow a hit to the next 16 batters he faced. He walked two batters in the fourth inning and let a run come home on a sacrifice fly, but came back out for the fifth inning and ended his night with a scoreless frame. **Michael Brewer** (0-1) replaced Garcia and allowed three runs in the sixth inning. Travis Kuhn (3-0) recorded two innings for Arkansas with one run allowed to collect the victory. The first lead for the RoughRiders came in the fourth inning, using a two-out rally with a **Dustin Harris** walk and a **Thomas Saggese** single. Harris scored on a balk. Two innings later, Frisco broke a 1-1 tie when **Kellen Strahm** doubled to the right field wall and later scored on Saggese's sacrifice fly.

STRENGTH IN ARMS:

After the RoughRiders had the worst ERA in the Texas League over a two-week span, over the last eight games, Frisco had the best ERA in the Texas League at 2.38 while going 5-3. The Riders have ceded a league-low three home runs and 33 hits (.140 BAA) with a 0.92 WHIP.

BROKEN BATS:

While the RoughRiders pitching staff has been fantastic over the last week and a half, the Riders offense has taken a step back over the same span. In the last three games, Frisco has just scored five runs while hitting .138 (12-for-87)/.260/.172/.432 with three extra-base hits (all doubles). In the last five contents, the Riders have scored a league-low 14 runs with a .195/.305/.258/.563 slashline.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**). Frisco also has a 1.213 OPS with the bags full, which is second in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.445).

TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 22 games, he is hitting .367 (33-for-90)/.414/.544/.958 with five doubles, a triple, three homers, 16 RBIs and 16 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .359/.393/.513/.906 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .296/.406/.457/.863 with five doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking 15 times. Over the last 21 games, he has raised his average 108 points and his OPS 294 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .307 (51-for-166)/.376/.440/.816 through the first 39 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (51), sixth in average (.307), tied for sixth in doubles (11) and tied for first in stolen bases (18). Over his last 35 games, he is batting .324/.399/.473/.872. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (120).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 202 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** is second in the league with 30 walks while **Evan Carter** is fourth in OBP (.422) in the league and third in the league with 28 walks.

ABOUT OWEN

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school offers at QB).

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MiLB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player candidate if he went to South Carolina.

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvila (40, 1199).

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

-Threw first quality start for RoughRiders pitchers on April 25th at Amarillo, allowing three runs over six innings. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one baserunner on a single through five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one run until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no-hitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starter before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From *The Athletic*: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.

2018-2019 SEASONS

-Did not see action in the 2018 season after being drafted as part of Rangers "de-load program".

-Missed the entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.
