**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds and Bats open a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. They faced off in Louisville at the end of April with Louisville taking four of the six games. Right-hander Jakob Junis gets the start for Nashville in a rehab appearance tonight. Right-hander Connor Phillips will be on the bump for Louisville.

**Jakob Junis:** The 31-year-old right-hander will make his first start of the season for the Sounds in a rehab appearance. He had one outing with the Brewers on April 2 before being placed on the injured list with a right shoulder impingement. In his MLB career, Junis is 38-45 with a 4.63 ERA (717.1 IP/369 ER) in 169 outings (111 starts). He made his MLB debut in 2017 for the Royals and pitched for them through the 2021 season. He then spent two seasons with the Giants before being signed by the Brewers in February. Last season for the Giants, Junis went 4-3 with a 3.87 ERA (86.0 IP/37 ER) in 40 appearances (four starts). Junis was born in Jacksonville, Arkansas but attended Rock Falls High School in Rock Falls, Illinois. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 draft by the Royals. His younger brother, Noah, is the bullpen coach for Triple-A Worcester.

**Connor Phillips:** The 23-year-old right-hander will make his 11th start for the Bats this season. He is 2-2, with an 8.42 ERA (41.2 IP/39 ER) with 35 strikeouts. In his last outing at Iowa on May 29, Phillips went 3.2 innings, allowing three earned runs, six walks and striking out three. He pitched against Nashville on April 26 and allowed eight earned runs and 11 hits across 4.0 innings. The 11 hits allowed was a career high and the eight earned runs tied a career high. He had his only five outs in the big leagues with the Reds 2023. He is 1-1 with a 6.97 ERA (20.2 IP/16 ER) and 26 strikeouts in the MLB. Phillips was traded to the Cincinnati Reds before the 2022 season. He was twice named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week and won the International League Pitcher of the Week award in July of 2023. He was named a Southern League Post-Season All-Star in 2023 with the Chattanooga Lookouts. He was drafted 64th overall by the Mariners in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft from McLennan Community College in McLennan, TX.

**Grand Salami:** The Sounds salvaged a series split with a 9-2 victory against Memphis on Sunday. Tyler Black powered the way with a grand slam on an 0-2 pitch and totaled five RBI in the game. It was the first grand slam by a Nashville player since Heston Hiura on July 28, 2023, and was the third time this season that a Nashville player had five RBI in a game. Additionally, it was Black's first grand slam of his professional career. In the Memphis series, Black had two home runs and 11 RBI. His eight home runs and 35 RBI trails only Brewer Hicklen in both categories for the team lead and leads the team with a .815 BB/K ratio.

**Dynamic Duo:** Taylor Clarke got the start on Sunday and went four scoreless innings with four hits allowed and four strikeouts. He was relieved by Evan McKendry who picked up his first win of the season. In similar fashion to the series opener at Memphis on May 28 the duo dominated with a combined eight innings with two earned runs allowed. Clarke and McKendry combined for 14 innings pitched and just two earned runs allowed in the Memphis series.

**Clutch Factor:** Isaac Collins went 3-for-5 with three RBI singles in Sunday's game with two of the three hits coming with two outs. Nashville was 5-for-15 with runners in scoring position and left 10 runners on base on top of the nine runs that they scored. In Collins' last 13 games, he has 13 RBI, two doubles, a triple and a home run. Collins has been excellent batting with runners in scoring position this season, hitting .380 (19-for-50) which trails only Francisco Mejia at .412 (14-for-34). He ranks among the Sounds' lead in RBI (3rd), and batting average (3rd), and leads the team in runs scored (38) and walks (30).

**Bullpen Beat:** The Nashville pen dominated in May by posting a 2.96 ERA (115.2 IP/38 ER) with 128 strikeouts. Collectively, the unit leads all of Triple-A with a 3.32 ERA and a 1.33 WHIP. They also are second in Triple-A in opponents batting average with a .216 clip ranking behind only Omaha's pen at .203. Ryan Middendorf posted his third consecutive scoreless outing with a clean ninth inning to cap off Sunday's win. Middendorf leads Nashville with 23.1 innings in relief this season and is second in strikeouts with 31.

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 713-610 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,305-2,130 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

### Most Wins by Minor League Managers

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

**LAST OUTING:** Junis made his Brewers debut in game four of the season on April 3 vs. Minnesota. He held the Twins to a run over four innings on 47 pitches (34 strikes). Junis was placed on the injured list with right shoulder impingement on April 6. During Milwaukee's batting practice on April 22, Junis was hit in the neck with a batted ball on the warning track and taken to the hospital. Junis was moved to the 60-day injured list on May 6.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Junis' only prior outing against the Bats came on June 17, 2021 at Werner Park in Nebraska. He struck out five and held Louisville to two hits over three scoreless innings in the start. It was his second start with the Storm Chasers after being optioned by Kansas City on June 7.

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 4-3 with a 3.87 ERA and one save in 40 games (4 starts) with San Francisco
- Struck out 96 batters in 86 innings
- Did not allow an earned run in any of his starts (12.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 BB, 14 K)...team went 3-1 in those outings

- Is married...wife's name is Brianne...the couple has a daughter named Nelly and two sons, Jones and Jett

**LAST OUTING:** Patrick picked up his third straight win and fifth quality start on May 29 at Memphis. The right-hander held the Redbirds to three runs, scattering seven hits and four walks across six innings. After striking out 12 in his previous start, Patrick only fanned one on 93 pitches.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Patrick's second time facing Louisville. He got the win in 5.1 innings of five-run baseball on April 26 at Louisville Slugger Field earlier this season.

- Tossed three scoreless innings in Sounds debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul
