#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS: After having three games effected by rain between July 17 and August 26, the Biloxi Shuckers have had each of their last two games effected by rain... Sunday's game was canceled after one batter and Tuesday was called official after six innings due to rain... It's the first time in 2023 that back-to-back Shuckers' games have been effected by rain.

<u>I HAVE A FEVER AND THE ONLY PERSCTIPTION IS MORE RUNS</u>: The Shuckers enter today with 652 runs in 2023, 13 away from breaking the single-season franchise record, set at 664 during the 2022 season... 2023 marks the second straight year that the Shuckers have scored at least 600 runs in a season after the Shuckers never score more than 600 runs in a season during their first six seasons.

**THE FIRST FOR MYERS**: Shuckers' **RHP Tobias Myers** tallied his first career complete-game shutout during Tuesday's rainshortened game... Myers tallied seven strikeouts and enters today 14 away from breaking the Shuckers' single-season strikeout record, held by **RHP Alec Bettinger** (157).

Myers' shutout was the ninth in Biloxi Shuckers franchise history (since 2015), and the first since RHP Trey Supak threw a one-hit, seven-inning complete game shutout on July 16, 2019 against the Chattanooga Lookouts.

RACING INTO THE 80'S: OF Jackson Chourio became the 11th Southern League player since 2015 and the first Shuckers player to reach 80 RBI in a season with an RBI double on Tuesday... Chourio previously broke the Shuckers' franchise record, held by OF Johnny Davis [76] with a two-run home run against Pensacola at MGM Park.

Chourio's 80 RBI have been helped by his .325 average with runners in scoring position (RISP), the third-best mark in the Southern League... Chourio ranks fifth in the league with a .924 OPS with RISP.

**BREAKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS**: **OF Jackson Chourio** enters today one home run away from becoming the first teenager with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases between Double-A and/or Triple-A since **OF Delmon Young** in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

Chourio's next home run will also make him the third teenager in Double-A/Triple-A to reach 20 home runs in a year since 2005, joining OF Delmon Young (2005, MTG) and 1B Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2018, NH/BUF).

RUNNING DOWN A DREAM: The Shuckers enter today with 194 stolen bases in 2023, six away from becoming the third Southern League team since 2005 to reach 200 in a season... The last team to reach 200 was the 2022 Montgomery Biscuits, who stole 203... The Biscuits also swiped 213 in 2019, the most by a Southern League team since 2005.

<u>PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS</u>: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division.

The Shuckers are 1.5 games behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with 17 games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK (5-4, 5.02): RHP TJ Shook makes his ninth start of the year after throwing a seasonhigh 92 pitches in his last start... Since moving back into the rotation on August 12, Shook has struck out 17 batters in 13.2 innings... Shook has worked into the fifth inning in four of his eight starts.
