vs. the Louisville Bats (Cincinnati Reds) at Coolray Field. It is the fourth of nine meetings between the two clubs this year, all to be played in Lawrenceville. Tonight is Shut Out Cancer Night and Fireworks Friday. With a win, Gwinnett would be four games over .500 for the first time all year.

VS. LOUISVILLE: Gwinnett is 31-21 (.596) in 52 games vs. Louisville at Coolray Field since 2009. The Stripers have won six straight home games over the Bats dating back to 5/14/21 (outscoring LOU 33-16 in that span), and have won the season home series over Louisville in each of the last four seasons (13-3 in that span).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller logged a season-high 7.0 IP (4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO) last night, earning his first win since 5/7 vs. Charlotte. He fell just one out short of tying his career high for innings (7.1 IP on 7/20/18 with High-A Florida at Clearwater). Muller is 3-3 in nine starts with the Stripers this season, and currently ranks among IL pitching leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 64), ERA (6th, 3.47), innings (T-10th, 49.1), BAA (12th, .236), and WHIP (14th, 1.24).

• GWN Career: In 26 starts since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, Muller is 8-7 with a 3.42 ERA, .228 BAA, and 10.95 SO/9.0 IP ratio (157 SO in 129.0 IP).

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 538 in 51 games (10.55 SO per game). That's 12 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 526 SO in 51G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 64) and Touki Toussaint (10th, 48) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 6/2.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin went 1-for-3 with an RBI last night, giving him a hit in 18 of 22 games since 5/1 (.341, 28-for-82, 8 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 13 R, 14 RBI, 2 SB, .989 OPS in that stretch). He now ranks 12th in the International League with a .310 average (48-for-155, 11 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 24 R, 22 RBI, 3 SB, .874 OPS), and has reached base safely in 37 of 42 games (88.1%) overall.

- Walk It Off: Gosselin hit a two-run double in the 10th for an 8-7 win on Wednesday, his first career walk-off hit with Gwinnett in his 276th game with the club.
- GWN Career: In 277 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .297 (303-for-1,019, 62 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 137 R, 104 RBI, 10 SB, .775 OPS). He is one of six players in club history with 300-plus hits.

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Preston Tucker enters play riding a five-game hitting streak (.412, 7-for-17, 1 HR, 2 R, 4 RBI, 1.112 OPS since 5/27) and three-game RBI streak (4 RBI since 5/29), both the longest active on the club. Braden Shewmake has scored a run in four-straight games since 5/29 (5 runs total), batting .250 (4-for-16, 1 HR, 1 RBI) in that span. John Nogowski has a five-game on-base streak (.313, 5-for-16, 1 2B, 1 R, 2 SB, .389 OBP since 5/26).

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game four of a six-game series **TROMP TAKES THE LEAD:** Chadwick Tromp tallied his first two RBI of June last night (2-for-4, 1 2B), raising his total to a team-best 27. He also leads the club in homers (9).

• Mashing in May: In May, Tromp ranked among IL leaders in homers (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), SLG (T-7th, .632), extra-base hits (T-10th, 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48). He was named the IL Offensive Player of the Week for 5/2-8 after batting .471 (8-for-17) with league highs in homers (4), extra-base hits (7), RBI (12), SLG (1.353), and OPS (1.879). Tromp's monster month included a Gwinnett-record nine-game extrabase hit streak from 5/1-12 (4 2B, 7 HR).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on Wednesday (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19for-89, 22B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

WATERS WATCH: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .267 (20-for-75, 5 2B, 2 HR, 12 R, 7 RBI, 1 SB, .717 OPS) in 18 games. The switch hitter is batting .478 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.283 OPS) from the right side and .173 (1 2B, 1 HR, .468 OPS) from the left side.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .249 (146-for-586, 32 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 99 R, 55 RBI, 32 SB, .711 OPS) in 148 games.

THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder set a new single-game career high for innings pitched on Monday, working 8.0 IP (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) in the 2-0 win over Louisville. He carried a no-hit bid through 6.1 innings before Cristian Santana singled to center in the seventh. Elder's previous career high had been 7.0 IP, accomplished eight times.

• Cool(ray) Customer: In six career home starts with the Stripers, Elder is 2-1 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER in 35.0 IP), 0.89 WHIP, .146 BAA, and three quality starts.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) .. In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Tucker Davidson makes his sixth Triple-A start of the year in game four of a six-game series vs. the Louisville Bats.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 14th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 4-4 with a 2.90 ERA (22 ER in 68.1 IP), 1.10 WHIP, .211 BAA, 23 walks, and 74 strikeouts since 2019.
 <u>At Home:</u> Makes his eighth career start at Coolray Field ... Is 2-3 with a 3.89 ERA
- (16 ER in 37.0 IP), 1.22 WHIP, .234 BAA, 13 walks, and 39 strikeouts.

PROSPECTING: Davidson is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 7 prospect by MLB.com. He is the third-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP **Kyle Muller** (No. 3) and RHP **Bryce Elder** (No. 4)
