CARDS BACK IN WIN COLUMN WITH 5-1 VICTORY OVER SOD POODLES:

Alex Cornwell and Ian Bedell combined to limit the Amarillo Sod Poodles to just one run on six hits and the Cardinals evened their six game series at HODGETOWN with a 5-1 win on Wednesday night. **Cornwell** picked up his first win of the season allowing just one run on five hits over 5.0 IP, while **Bedell** earned his first career save with 4.0 innings of shutout ball allowing just one hit while striking out six. The Cards scored four times in the top of the fifth. **Jacob Buchberger** and **Jeremy Rivas** each had two hits, and **RJ Yeager** extended his hitting streak to 10 with a ninth-inning single.

OPPOSING STARTER:

Right-hander **Luke Albright** makes his third start of the season for Amarillo... Last pitched on Friday, April 12 in Midland and allowed 4 R on 7 H with 3 BB and 3 K in 3.2 IP... Took the loss against San Antonio in his only start and HODGETOWN, surrendering 8 R on 5 H with 4 BB in just 2.1 IP... Made 25 starts with the Sod Poodles in 2023, going 8-5 with a 5.46 ERA... Made two starts against Springfield last season going 0-0 with a 5.06 ERA with 13 K and 6 BB in 10.2 IP... The Cards hit .268 against him... Made 26 starts for High-A Hillsboro in 2022 and went 6-10 with a 5.49 ERA... 2-0 with a 3.47 ERA with Low-A Visalia in 2021... Selected in the 6th round of the 2021 Draft by the Diamondbacks out of Kent State... Went 6-4 with a 3.40 ERA, earning 2nd team all-MAC as a junior in 2021... Won Indiana state title in high school... 24 years old

RED-HOT CARDS HEAD TO LONE STAR STATE TO TAKE ON DEFENDING CHAMPS: The Cardinals make their first trip of the season to Texas, starting a six-game series against the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks) starting on Tuesday at HODGETOWN. Springfield went 5-7 in 12 games against the Sod Poodles in 2023.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS SET NEW FRANCHISE MARK: With their come-from-behind 8-7 win over the Wichita Wind Surge on Sunday at Hammons Field, the Cardinals ran their season-opening winning streak to 9 games, a new franchise record for consecutive wins. Springfield had won three straight previously, from June 9-16, 2007 and from September 2-10 last season during a 17-6 run over 23 games to claim the North Division 2nd half crown.

The comeback win on Sunday also ran the best start in franchise history to 9-0, easily eclipsing the previous record of 2-0 which was done twice: 2016 & 2017.

The Cardinals' 6-0 start at Hammons Field is also their best start ever, as is their 3-0 start on the road. The Cards' previous record for best start to a season at home was 5-0 in 2019, while they won their first two games on the road twice (2014 & 2017).

CARDS WERE LAST TO FALL, OWN TOP WINNING PERCENT-AGE IN MiLB:

Going into Tuesday night's loss to Amarillo, the Cardinals were the final undefeated team in all of affiliated professional baseball. Both the Cardinals and Spokane Indians (High-A, Colorado Rockies) of the Northwest League were 8-0 going into Sunday's game. The Cardinals defeated Wichita in comeback fashion 8-7 while the Indians fell to Tri-Cities 4-2.

With Wednesday's win, Springfield is the only team below Triple-A to have 10 wins, and are one of only two clubs below MiLB's highest level to have one loss. The Eugene Emeralds (High-A, San Francisco Giants) are 9-1 after no-hitting the Vancouver Canadians on Wednesday night. The Cardinals' .909 winning percentage is tops in Minor League Baseball.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE EARLY: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 11 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .306 batting average. The Cards are the only club at the Double-A level with a team average .300 or over; the New Hampshire Fisher Cats are next with a mark of .278. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.406), OPS (.827), RBIs (67) and runs scored (73). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with a league-high 8 sacrifice flies this season.

The Redbirds' bat-to-ball skills have been impressive. With just 68 total K's, the Cardinals have struck out the fewest times in all of Minor League Baseball.

YEAGER BOMBS: Through his first 10 games, **RJ Yeager** finds his name littered across the league leaderboard in several run production categories. The Mississippi State product's 12 RBIs leads the Texas League and **Yeager** finds himself tied for 3rd in home runs (3), one longball behind **Emmanuel Rodriguez** (WCH) and **Colby Thomas** (MID). **Yeager's** 1.028 OPS and 23 total bases both rank 5th in the circuit. He has opened the season with a team-high 10 game hitting streak.

TORRES LEADING HITTER, THIEF IN TEXAS LEAGUE: With 2 SB on both Saturday night and Sunday afternoon, Cardinals OF **Bryan Torres** took the lead in the Texas League with 7 SB. He has been caught just once. **Torres** racked up 71 bags for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association in 2023.

Torres also leads the Texas league in hitting, batting .412 over his first 9 games, and his .500 OBP also ranks top in the Texas League in a tie with two other players.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs. **Redmond** also sits two home runs shy of Springfield's franchise career record of 59 by **Xavier Scruggs**.

Cardinals skipper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.
