ELMER'S EXCELLENCE: Yankees No. 5 prospect Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz faces the Binghamton Rumble Ponies today for the third time in a span of five starts. On 8/5 and 8/10, he started the bookends of Somerset's home series against Binghamton, outdueling Jonah Tong in both games by going 2-0 with 13.0 combined scoreless innings with 5 H, 4 BB and 15 K for a 0.69 WHIP and .119 BAA. Rodriguez-Cruz enters today ranking among the Yankees' minor league leaders with 126.1 IP (1st), .187 BAA (1st), 2.28 ERA (2nd) and 146 K (2nd).

PLAYOFF PRESSURE: With 16 games remaining in the 2025 regular season, the Somerset Patriots lead the Hartford Yard Goats by 0.5 game for the second half playoff berth in the Eastern League's Northeast division.

GOING, GOING--GONE? Jace Avina's seventh inning two-run homer on Saturday night snapped the Patriots' longest homerless drought of the season at 39.2 innings. That home run continues to be Somerset's only long ball in the last eight games. In spite of this drought, the Patriots continue to lead the Eastern League with 120 HR.

TOO CLOSE TO CALL: In Somerset's 35 games since the All-Star break, 30 have been decided by three runs or less, with the Patriots going 15-15 in those games. In that span, 17/35 games have been decided by one run, with the Patriots going 6-11 in those one-run games. Dating back to 7/10, 16 of the Patriots' last 19 wins have been decided by three runs or less.

BRENDAN'S BRINGING IT: Brendan Jones reached base five times on Wednesday in a perfect night at the plate, going 3-for-3 with 3 R, 1 RBI, 1 3B, 2 BB and 1 SB. The performance marked the first time this season Jones reached base five times, but his ninth time reaching base 3+ times in a game.

JASSO JAPPENINGS: On Wednesday night, Dylan Jasso extended his hit streak to six games, the longest active streak of any Patriot. During the streak (since 8/21 vs. HFD), Jasso is 7-for-20 (.350/.391/.400) with 2 R, 1 2B, 8 RBI, 2 BB and a .791 OPS. After his seventh 3 RBI game of the season, Jasso leads the Patriots and ranks 3rd in the Eastern League with 66 RBI on the season.

WHAT THE FRICK: Saturday night, Tomas Frick collected his fifth multi-hit game at Double-A, all having come within his last 11 games. Over this 11 game stretch, Frick is 11-for-31 (.324/.385/.382) with 2 R, 2 RBI, 4 BB and a .767 OPS.

KELLY AWESOME: Over his last 14 appearances dating back to 7/4 vs. REA, Kelly Austin has allowed one earned run. During this stretch, Austin has thrown 14.0 IP over which he has allowed 10 H, 8 BB and recorded 14 K. In this span, Austin has a 0.64 ERA, a 1.29 WHIP and a .189 BA.

HAPPY HARDMAN: Tyler Hardman belted a double on Tuesday night, making for his team-leading 42nd extra base-hit of the season, ranking 5th in the Eastern League. His .438 SLG ranks 9th in the league. In 21 games during August, Tyler Hardman is 20-for-77 (.260/.352/.429) with 8 RBI, 13 R, 2 HR, 10 BB and a .781 OPS.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.
