**ALLOW US TO RE-INTRODUCE OURSELVES:** The Wilson Warbirds are set to take the field for the first time tonight in Fayetteville. The Warbirds #TakeFlight after the franchise played the previous 35 seasons as the Carolina Mudcats in Zebulon. The Warbirds narrative connects to Wilson native Vollis Simpson, a WWII pilot-turned-artist whose Whirligig sculptures – several stories tall and powered by the wind-tower in Whirligig Park, located directly behind left field in the new Wilson downtown stadium.

Designed to symbolize historical significance and unmatched speed, the logo celebrates community passions for baseball, aviation, and Americana. Warbird restoration is a reverential process that parallels the active revitalization of Historic Downtown Wilson and echoes a commitment to preserving cultural legacy while embracing innovation.

**NEW LOOK CAROLINA LEAGUE:** The Wilson Warbirds are one of three Carolina League teams that re-branded prior to the 2026 along with the Hill City Howlers (previously Lynchburg Hillcats) and the Salem RidgeYaks (previously the Salem Red Sox).

**OUR FEARLESS LEADER:** The Wilson Warbirds will be led by a new field manager in 2026 as Eddy Morgan was named the team's manager in the offseason. The 2026 season will be Morgan's first year in professional baseball after spending the previous 19 seasons as a head coach at the NCAA Division III level including the last 12 years at Concordia. Overall in his 19 seasons, Morgan compiled a career record of 353-380(.431). From 2013 to 2017, Morgan served as the manager of the Lakeshore Chinooks in the Northwoods League, a summer collegiate league where he was named the league's Manager of the Year in 2014 after guiding the club to a championship. Morgan coached over 65 players who were later selected in Major League Baseball First year Player Draft including future major leaguers, Harrison Bader, Brian Anderson, Zack Granite and Andrew Stevenson.

Nick Stanley who managed the club for the previous two seasons was promoted to A+ Wisconsin to serve as the manager.

**ABOUT THE ROSTER:** The Milwaukee Brewers released the Warbirds initial roster earlier this week and the roster is littered with returning players and prospects. Of the announced roster, 18 players spent time with the Carolina League franchise at some point during the 2025 season. The roster also features two of the Brewers draft picks from the 2025 First-Year Player Draft: Brady Ebel (32nd overall (Corona HS (CA)) and Andrew Healy (9th Round, Duke University).

**BIG LEAGUE BASEBALL FAMILIES :** The Warbirds initial roster includes a pair of players who have family ties to the Major Leagues. Brady Ebel's father, Dino, is the longtime third base coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers and threw batting practice to Brady on the field at Dodger Stadium after he signed with the Brewers last year.

Outfielder, Jady'n Fielder, makes his full-season professional baseball debut after spending the 2025 season in the Arizona Complex League. His father, Prince, is a member of the Brewers Walk of Fame and played 12 years in the big leagues (7 with the Brewers) with 319 career home runs and over 1,000 RBI. Jady'n's grandfather, Cecil, played 17 seasons in the Major Leagues and compiled more than 1,300 career hits.

**APRIL SUCCESS:** Early season success is nothing new for the Brewers Carolina League affiliate, especially to start the season. Over the last two seasons (plus Opening Day on Friday), the franchise has posted a record of 34-12 in the month of April.

Friday night continued a recent trend of Opening Day success, with the 2-0 win on Friday, the franchise has now won eight of their last nine contests to open the season.

**A GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION:** It was announced on Monday, March 30 that the Warbirds have sold out their home opener on Tuesday, April 14 vs. the Hill City Howlers. Limited tickets remain for the rest of the homestand which includes Wilt-son Wednesday, Thirsty Thursday, Fireworkds after Friday and Saturday home games and Pups in the Park Sunday. Additionally, kids can run the bases after every Warbirds home game.
