# San Jose Giants (33-21)

RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (33-21)





LHP Greg Farone (2-1, 3.13 ERA) vs. RHP Christian Zazueta (5-1, 2.09 ERA)

**TODAY'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field, as the Quakes continue this home stand with game four of a sixgame series against the San Jose Giants (SFG). Tonight is Family RV Family Feast Night, with \$2 hot dogs, \$1 Pepsi products and \$1 ice cream sandwiches. Tonight is also Scout Night and First Responders Night, as we celebrate the men and women who protect and serve our community. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the tenth of 18 games against the Giants and the tenth of 12 here at home. Last night's loss is the third straight in the series and drops the Quakes to 4-5 against the Giants in 2025, after winning four of six in a mid-April series here at home. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field. **LAST GAME:** The Quakes rallied from two back, but dropped an extra-inning affair to the San Jose Giants on Thursday night, 6-4 in ten innings at LoanMart Field. Jakob Christian singled home the game-winner to lead off the tenth, then later scored on a throwing error, as the Giants took a two-run lead against Dilan Figueredo (0-1). Rancho went 1-2-3 in the bottom of the tenth against Giants' closer Cade Vernon, who earned his second save. Giants' reliever Evan

Gray (4-1) worked two scoreless innings for the win. Rancho finished with just seven hits, with Eduardo Guerrero and

Roger Lasso each collecting two. Eduardo Quintero blasted his league-leading tenth of the year. The loss for Rancho is their fourth straight, a season-high. They've also dropped 11 of their last 16 overall.

**CLEAN SWEEP OF MONTHLY AWARDS:** The Quakes have continued their dominance of California League awards in 2025, as a pair of Quakes were honored on Thursday. OF Eduardo Quintero was named the Player of the Month, while RHP Christian Zazueta was named Pitcher of the Month. Quintero's May was outstanding, as he batted .391 and led all of minor league baseball in hits (43). He led the league in doubles (10), triples (4), RBIs (28), stolen bases (15), slugging (.718) and OPS (1.195). Zazueta went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA in six starts. His 31 strikeouts over 30 innings led the league. Sean Paul Linan was named April's Cal League Pitcher of the Month, before heading to High-A **HOW TO WRAP IT UP:** Last night's loss, a fourth straight for Rancho, means there are only 12 left to play in the first half, with the Quakes having a six-game lead over Lake Elsinore and seven over Visalia. Rancho's magic number is eight against Lake Elsinore and seven against Visalia. After this series, the Quakes will head to last-place Inland Empire for six, before finishing the half at home with three against second-place Lake Elsinore. This week, the Storm are in Modesto, while the Rawhide are home against Inland Empire. Next week, the Visalia Rawhide travel to Lake Elsinore for six. Meanwhile, there's real drama up north, as San Jose now has a one-game lead on Modesto. CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: 20-year-old right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his 11th start of the year and his second against San Jose. In one game against San Jose, he allowed four hits over five scoreless innings in a win on April 19th. In his last start, Zazueta allowed just one run on four hits over six innings in a no-decision at Modesto on May

30th. Last year in Rancho, Zazueta went 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA over 14 games (11 starts) and 52.1 innings. Zazueta, who was named this past Thursday as the Cal League Pitcher of the Month for May, signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 in the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees. **GREG FARONE:** 23-year-old lefty Greg Farone makes his tenth start of the year and second against Rancho. In his only game against the Quakes, he allowed just one hit over five scoreless innings in a win on April 18th. In his last

outing, he allowed one unearned run on one hit over four innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on May 30th. Farone played college ball at Alabama and was drafted by San Francisco in the seventh round of the 2024 draft. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
