LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (13-12) defeated the Midland RockHounds (17-8), 3-1, on Saturday night at Momentum Bank Ballpark. The RockHounds struck first in the third after a Cole Conn leadoff walk and stolen base allowed him to score on Jared Dickey's double. Any other offense was hard to come by on both sides. CD Pelham opened the eighth inning on the mound for Midland and walked the first two batters he faced before handing the ball to Stevie Emanuels with one out in the frame. Pinch-hitter Danny Serretti loaded the bases with a single, which allowed Amarillo tied the game on the second RockHounds wild pitch of the inning and later took the lead on a Manuel Pena sac fly. Ben McLaughlin added insurance for the Sod Poodles with a leadoff home run off the right field foul pole in the ninth on the way to Amarillo's 3-1 win over Midland.

I'M McLAUGHLIN IT: Ben McLaughlin extended his on-base streak to 21 games and hit streak to 11 games with a base hit in the top of the second...both active stretches are the longest in the Texas League after previous hit streak leader Joshua Kuroda-Grauer went 0-for-3 for Midland on Saturday.

MENENDEZ AT WORK: Antonio Menendez turned in 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen and now holds the longest scoreless innings and games streaks by Soddiess relievers in 2026...he has not allowed a run over his most recent five appearances and 8.2 innings pitched dating back to April 16.

SWIPER, NO SWIPING: Midland baserunners stole five bases against Amarillo on Saturday...it was the eighth time in team history that an opponent has swiped 5+ bags against the Soddiess in a game...the team improved to 2-6 when it occurs, with the only other victory occurring on August 28, 2024 over Arkansas by a score of 11-6.

YES SERRETTI: Danny Serretti returned to the Sod Poodles from a three-game stint with Triple-A Reno and made an immediate impact on Saturday with a pinch-hit single in the eighth inning that moved the tying- and go-ahead runners into scoring position...in his first taste of Triple-A competition, he batted .273 (3x11) with a home run and double...in 22 total games in the minors this year, he has reached base safely in 19 of them.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The success of the Sod Poodles bullpen has been a huge factor in the 8-2 road trip for Amarillo...they have been credited with all eight wins and completed six saves, the most in the Texas League since April 20...Soddiess relievers have also combined to allow the fewest home runs (2) and walks (14) while their 0.92 WHIP as a unit trails only Arkansas over the span.

LETS PLAY TWO!: Amarillo is 1-1 in doubleheaders in 2026...the Soddiess swept three doubleheaders last season.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Christian Cerda had one of his best days at the plate with Triple-A Reno as he continued his hot start to the season with the Aces...he hit a two-run home run and drove in three runs as he reached base three times in an 8-7 loss to Sugar Land.

- ▶ Selected in the Diamondbacks in the 12th round (362nd overall) of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Southport High School in Indianapolis, IN...agreed to a \$922,500 signing bonus.
- ▶ Signed a one-year contract with Arizona in the 2025-26 offseason after fulfilling six years of minor league service.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Tossed a season-high 4.1 innings, throwing his most pitches (73) in 2026 so far.
- ▶ Has yet to earn a decision this season as the Sod Poodles would go on to win 5-4 in extra innings.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Began 2025 in Amarillo and had a strong month of May, going 2-1 in five starts with a 1.17 WHIP, tallying three quality starts.
- ▶ Put together two more quality starts to begin June before his promotion to Triple-A Reno on June 15.
- ▶ Made one start with the Aces before being sent down to Amarillo and would be placed on the injured list shortly after.
- ▶ Threw a gem on July 18, shutting out the San Antonio Missions over seven frames on one hit, walking and hitting one batter each in his longest outing of the season.
- ▶ Eight of his 22 starts were quality starts.
- ▶ In 21 starts with the Sod Poodles in 2025, he allowed one run or fewer in nine of them.

A-VERY NICE 2024

- ▶ Had a breakout campaign where he got off to a hot start at the beginning of the season with High-A Hillsboro...through his first nine appearances (eight starts), he went 2-3 with a 1.69 ERA (9 ER/48.0 IP), 1.15 WHIP and 31 strikeouts.
- ▶ Three of his final four starts in this stretch saw him tally seven or more innings pitched.
- ▶ Tossed 7.2 innings of one-hit shutout ball on May 23 against Vancouver (Toronto Blue Jays), fanning eight batters in the contest.
- ▶ Threw eight shutout innings in is next start on May 30 against Eugene (San Francisco Giants), setting a new career-long start that he has yet to surpass.

SUMMARY

- ▶ Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a free agent to a minor league contract on July 27, 2022.
- ▶ Played in college at Pittsburgh from 2019-2022.
- ▶ Was previously drafted by the Texas Rangers in the 36th round (1079th ovr.) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Malvern Prep School in Pennsylvania, but did not sign.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Rebounded from a rough first outing of the season with Amarillo... tossed 2.1 innings of relief as the first pitcher out of the bullpen on April 25 at San Antonio.
- ▶ Set season-highs with the Sod Poodles in innings pitched and strikeouts...only allowed one run on a solo home run by Albert Fabian.

THE WAY TO AMARILLO

- ▶ Spending his second season with the Sod Poodles after he went 6-8 with a 4.92 ERA (58 ER/106.0 IP) in 20 starts with the team in 2024.
- ▶ Earned his first win in Double-A on May 22 at Northwest Arkansas... tossed seven shutout innings and allowed four baserunners while striking out five.
- ▶ Was the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 2 after two starts against the Arkansas Travelers on May 28 and June 2...went 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA, and tossed a pair of quality starts.
- ▶ Matched a career-high 7.0 innings pitched in back-to-back starts on June 15 at Frisco and June 21 against San Antonio...went 1-1 and as he allowed five unearned runs in the loss to the RoughRiders while he gave up just two earned runs in the win over the Missions.
- ▶ June was his best month of the season, as he logged 5.0+ innings pitched in all five starts, going 2-1 with a 1.74 ERA (6 ER/31.0 IP).
- ▶ Threw the most pitches in his career (97) on August 1 in Corpus Christi, striking out a season-high eight batters in a six-inning outing that resulted in a no-decision.

NOT IN THE CARDS

- ▶ Began 2025 with Triple-A Reno, but his campaign was cut short after five games...was transferred from the 7-day injured list to the 60-day IL on May 29, where he remained for the rest of the season.

HAIL TO PITT

- ▶ As a freshman at Pittsburgh, he appeared in 20 games and made 11 starts...finished the season with a 3.80 ERA (29 ER/68.2 IP) with 54 strikeouts...had the second-best ERA on the team while having the most innings pitched, and fourth on the team for strikeouts.
- ▶ Made just four starts in 2020 and 2021, but led the Panthers with a 0.95 WHIP.
