### FRISCO DROPS SLUGFEST AGAINST SOD POODLES:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Amarillo Sod Poodles 10-7 on Thursday evening from HODGETOWN. Frisco (37-29, 81-54) started the scoring against Amarillo (28-37, 58-76) starter Joe Elbis in the top of the first inning when **Sebastian Walcott** plated **Alejandro Osuna** and **Maximo Acosta** with a single that gave the Riders a 2-0 lead. The RoughRiders tacked on two more in the second inning, using an RBI double by **Keyber Rodriguez** and an RBI single by Acosta to make it a 4-0 game. In the bottom of the second inning, Amarillo used solo homers by Ivan Melendez and Kristian Robinson against **Mitch Bratt** to cut the deficit to 4-2. Frisco added a run in the top of the third with a sacrifice fly from **Aaron Zavala**, pushing the lead to 5-2. A **Josh Hatcher** solo homer in the fourth made it a 6-2 game and kept the Riders scoring streak alive. Neyfy Castillo cut the deficit to three with an RBI groundout in the bottom of the fifth inning. Amarillo added two more in the sixth inning on an RBI triple by Gavin Conticello and an error, making it a 6-5 game. Bratt finished after 6.0 innings, surrendering five runs (four earned) on eight hits and two walks while striking out three. Back-to-back doubles in the top of the seventh from **Luis Mieses** and Rodriguez gave the Riders some insurance at 7-5. In the home half of the seventh inning the Sod Poodles evened the game against **Ryan Lobus** on a two-run homer by Gino Groover. Tied at 7-7 in the bottom of eighth inning, Gavin Collyer allowed the first three batters to reach. Robinson put Amarillo ahead with an RBI double and later scored on a two-run double by Castillo that pushed the Sod Poodles in front 10-7. Offensively, Walcott led the way with three hits as the Riders picked up multi-hit games from Acosta, **Abimelec Ortiz**, Mieses and Rodriguez.

### PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .323 (54-for-167)/.391/.503/.894 over his last 43 games. Since July 10th, in those last 43 games, he is third in the league in average (.323) and fifth in OPS (.894). In his last 30 games, he is hitting .339 (40-for-118)/.412/.534/.946. He has hits in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .395/.519/.744/1.263. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

### CHASING RECORDS:

The RoughRiders are within reach of the franchise record for the best winning percentage (.607, 2007). The Riders need to finish 3-0 in their last four games to get the winning percentage record. On the pitching side, they are on pace to allow the fewest hits in a full season (not including the 119-game 2021 season), with 1,036 and the lowest batting average against in a full season (.231).

### HATCHIN HOMERS:

**Josh Hatcher** has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .325/.384/.475/.859 over his last 40 games with nine doubles, four home runs and 22 RBIs. In his last 13 games, he is hitting .340 (18-for-53)/.386/.547/.933 with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBIs, seven runs scored.

### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 45 games, Ortiz is hitting .298/.391/.520/.911 with nine doubles, nine home runs, 30 RBIs, 30 runs scored and 25 walks. Since July 10th, in those 44 games, he is sixth in average (.298), second in OPS (.911), tied for fourth in RBIs (30) and fifth in home runs (nine). In his last 26 games, he is batting .330 (32-for-97)/.440/.588/1.028 with five doubles, six home runs, 22 RBIs, 18 walks, 23 strikeouts and 20 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .287 with an .871 OPS, raising his batting average to .232 and a .712 OPS.

### HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 27 home runs in the last 24 games, with those 27 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 24 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 103 across their 135 games (on pace for 106, which would be for the 12th in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 37-30 with a 3.53 ERA, but a +23 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .664 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home as opposed to .157/.232/.263/.495 on the road.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins. Knapp is now at UNC, but will miss the whole season with Tommy John Surgery.

-2022 Draft for Rangers as RoughRiders include: RHP Matt Bosky (2023), INF/OF Josh Hatcher (2023, 2024).

### 2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

### 2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
