### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox fell to the Erie SeaWolves on Saturday night by a final of 8-4. Bowie mustered just one run and went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position through the first eight innings. Defensively, the Baysox committed a pair of errors and the pitching staff walked a season high eight batters in the defeat. Erie never trailed during the game and after taking an early 2-0 lead, the SeaWolves scored runs in the 4th, 5th and 6th innings along with three in the 8th. Anthony Servideo collected a game-high three hits and two RBI, including his third homer of the season.

### SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Lael Lockhart makes his fifth start of the season and his 17th career start with Erie. The 26-year-old pitched three innings and gave up three runs on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts over 64 pitches in a no decision on Tuesday in the series opener. It was the first time this season that he had given up runs in a start after previously not allowing a run in three straight. The Friendswood, TX native is in his second season with the SeaWolves after debuting with them in 2023. The southpaw struck out 89 batters over 73.2 innings to a 2.69 ERA last year with Erie.

### BASALLO HITS BOMBS

C Samuel Basallo has enjoyed his best week of the season, thus far, in 2024. After driving in another run in the ninth last night, the Orioles No. 2 prospect now has four home runs and 10 RBI over his last five games played. Basallo has three multi-hit games and three 3 RBI games over his last five played. The 19-year-old leads the Baysox in home runs and is tied for fifth in the league in home runs with five.

### ON-BASE BOWENS

After doubling last night, 1B TT Bowens is currently on an 8-game hit and on-base streak, which is the longest active hit and on-base streak on the team. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is tied for second in the Eastern League with 20 RBI, along with New Hampshire's Josh Kasevich and Portland's Matthew Lugo. The undrafted free agent is fifth in the league in AVG (.324), fourth in SLG (.577) and fifth in OPS (.972).

### SERVIN' IT UP

IF Anthony Servideo has enjoyed arguably his best series so far at the plate this season. Last night, Servideo delivered his first three hit game of the season and homered for a second straight game. He was a triple shy of the cycle. In the series, the 25-year-old is 6-for-12 with two homers, three RBI, and eight runs scored. Servideo now has four career three-hit games.

### HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox are one of just five teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 10 games at home, thus far, and have won six of their last eight here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (90), first in home runs (21), and first in OPS (.827). A win today would clinch Bowie's third consecutive home series win.

### SHOULDERING THE LOAD

The Bowie bullpen has carried a large load so far this year. Baysox relievers lead the Eastern League in innings pitched (122) and strikeouts (156). The bullpen has also recorded the fourth-lowest WHIP (1.21) in the circuit. Bowie starters have thrown the third-fewest innings in the league (101.0) and the Baysox are the last team remaining in the league that has yet to have a starting pitcher receive a win.

### READY FOR PHAM

RHP Alex Pham makes his sixth start of the season and his 15th career start at Double-A. Pham lasted just 3.2 innings on Tuesday in the series opener vs Erie, allowing four runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in a no decision. All four runs were given up in the first inning, including surrendering two homers. The Orioles No. 24 prospect put up a 2.68 ERA at home last season over 23.2 innings pitched but so far this season, he has put up a 10.13 ERA over 10.2 innings at Prince George's Stadium. This will be Pham's third time facing the SeaWolves.

**2023:** Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. In most recent start on 4/30 vs ERI, gave up four first inning runs, including two homers, but did not give up any more runs after first inning and pitched into fourth. Has a 10.13 ERA at home in three home starts. Looking for first career Double-A win.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach
