YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels swept a doubleheader against the Baysox, 5-1 and 2-0. In Game 1, Mason Black pitched four scoreless innings and Wil Jensen allowed one run, a ninth-inning homer. Shane Matheny gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI double. Marco Luciano extended the lead to 3-0 with a two-run homer in the third. Carter Aldrete hit a solo home run in the fourth and Vaun Brown added an RBI double in the seventh to open a 5-0 lead. In Game 2, Kai-Wei Teng worked five innings and became the first Richmond starter to pick up a winning decision this season. José Cruz worked the final six outs to finish the shutout. Brandon Martorano scored on a wild pitch in the second for a 1-0 lead and Simon Whiteman brought in a second run in the fifth with a sac fly.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth game of a six-day, seven-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today is the 9th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-1 at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29. The Sunday finale of that series was rained out. The Baysox will come to The Diamond for six-game sets from July 4-9 and August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five-of-their-last-eight games dating back to June 7. In that stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has posted a 2.51 ERA (19 ER/68.0 IP), which is the best in the league. In that stretch, Richmond starters have combined for a 1.82 ERA (7 ER/34.2 IP/9 BB/44 SO). The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 13-25 since May 3. For the year, Richmond starters have thrown 210.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 296.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.25 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is tied for the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSDX are in last place in the Southwest Division but have won six-of-nine, including five-of-six last week in Erie. Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including INF Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), INF Cesar Prireto (No. 16), RHP Justin Armbruester (No. 22) and OF John Rhodes (No. 26). MLB. com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including Mayo (No. 8), Povich (No. 11), Prieto (No. 16), McDermott (No. 17), Rhodes (No. 19) and Armbruester (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 11th start of the season and his second against the Baysox. He last pitched on Saturday at The Diamond against the Curve and threw four scoreless innings, his first scoreless start of the year. In his last two starts, Murphy has posted a 1.13 ERA (1 ER/8.0 IP). He pitched against the Baysox on April 29 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed two runs over four innings. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR BDWIE: Left-hander Cade Povich makes his 12th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he allowed four runs over four innings in a no-decision against the SeaWolves on Friday in Erie. After going 4-3 with a 3.79 ERA in his first eight starts of the year, Povich is 0-2 with a 11.12 ERA (14 ER/11.1 IP) in his last three starts since May 28. He last faced the Flying Squirrels on April 29 in Bowie and picked up a win, working five scoreless innings with a season-high 10 strike-outs. Povich was selected in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Nebraska by the Minnesota Twins. He was traded to the Orioles at the deadline last August along with three other pitchers for RHP Jorge Lopez. He was promoted to Bowie two weeks later and went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in six games. He faced the Flying Squirrels on Sept. 6 following a rehab start by Grayson Rodriguez, his only Double-A relief outing to date, and allowed four runs while recording two outs. Povich is rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 Orioles prospect and No. 11 by MLB.com.

LUVE LUC!: On Saturday night, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot on Wednesday at Bowie. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his nine home runs are tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League. He leads all Richmond hitters in home runs for the year. Luciano is riding a five-game hit streak dating back to Saturday, during which he is batting .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, one double, five walks and 10 RBIs (.682 OBP, 1.353 SLG, 2.035 OPS).

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered in each of the first two games in this week's series at Bowie. On Tuesday, he hit a solo shot in the third inning. In the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader, he clubbed a solo homer in the fourth. Since his promotion to Double-A on July 23, 2022, Aldrete has the most home runs (14), RBIs (52), hits (82), doubles (19) and extra-base hits (33) of any Flying Squirrels player. His eight homers this year are tied for second-most on the team.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list on Saturday after missing 12 games. In his three games back from the IL, he has reached base six times (two hits and four walks). In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.407) and ranks 11th in OBP (.469). He has picked up 10 hits and seven walks in his eight Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17. Meckler has scored a run in six straight games played, the longest active streak in the league.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was promoted to Double-A on May 30. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. With Richmond, he has hit safely in nine-of-his-last-11 games.

QUCH!: Hayden Cantrelle has been hit by a pitch 12 times this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. He has been plunked three times so far in the three games of this week's series. Cantrelle is also tied for ninth in the league in walks (35) and leads the Flying Squirrels in OBP (.389).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for third in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for ninth in walks (35). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is third in strikeouts (68), tied for eighth in BAA (.225) and 10th in WHIP (1.23). Wil Jensen is tied for second in wins (5).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.360), sixth in OBP (.405), ninth in OPS (.882), first in hits (77) and seventh in total bases (102), Coby Mayo is fourth in OBP (.407), ninth in SLG (.522), seventh in OPS (.929), tied for seventh in hits (58), first in doubles (20), tied for ninth in walks (35), tied for second in extra-base hits (30) and tied for fourth in total bases (106).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best thitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and José Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Two former Flying Squirrels players have made their MLB debuts for the San Francisco Giants this week. On Tuesday, Keaton Winn pitched in St. Louis and allowed one run over four innings in the Giants' 11-3 win, becoming the first Giants player in franchise history to pick up a save in his debut. Last season, Winn joined the Flying Squirrels in mid-August and went 2-3 with a 4.15 ERA in six starts to close the regular season. On Wednesday, Luis Matos made his major league debut against the Cardinals and went 1-for-3. He was on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster this year and .304 with three homers in 31 games before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on May 17. On the year, six former Flying Squirrels have made their MLB debuts, all with the Giants, including Tristan Beck (2021-22 Flying Squirrels), Casey Schmitt (2022), Patrick Bailey (2023) and Ryan Walker (2021-22). On Wednesday, Matos became the 90th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the big leagues.
